Subject: Standish Phase 2 – Construction starting

We are writing to provide an update on the Standish Multi-User Path (MUP) Phase 2 scheme.

The Standish Multi-User Path forms part of the Gloucestershire Cycle Spine, a project to create a 26-mile cycling and walking corridor between Bishop's Cleeve and Stroud.

Phase 2 comprises the final 100-metre section of the route and will consist of an on-road multi-user path segregated from traffic by a buffer zone.

The works are starting on **7 September 2026**, to be completed by the **end of November 2026** by our appointed contractor Griffiths Civil Engineering.

Traffic management will consist of two-way temporary traffic signals operating during off-peak hours, alongside a 30mph speed limit through the works area. Short-term overnight closures may be required for activities such as road markings and installing road signs, if this cannot be safely done during the day. These road closures or any changes to traffic management will be communicated in advance.
