1. Introduction

Thank you for your interest in the Council’s work in managing parking.

The year 2015 to 2016 saw further improvements to the way the Council deploys enforcement officers around the County with a 10% increase in the number of detected acts of antisocial parking found across the area, helping residents and businesses benefit from a well-managed on-street parking environment.

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We have introduced a new permit parking scheme in the St Pauls area of Cheltenham which has significantly reduced the high levels of congestion experienced and helped the local community to park near their homes and businesses. The Parking Team have also carried out detailed surveys in other areas of the county helping us to better understand public need and respond appropriately to problems.

In the coming year we intend to bring the Councils review of parking restrictions across the county to a conclusion with any further changes being managed on an ad hoc basis when required. Further improvements are planned to the way in which legal regulations are Ordered and to public access to maps of parking restrictions across the county.

2. Gloucestershire parking review 2015/16

The Gloucestershire Parking Review is a series of projects looking at on-street parking operation in towns across the County to ensure the available parking is being best managed to provide good access for residents, local businesses and their visitors/customers.

In 2015/16, the review was focussed on the final areas of Cheltenham, the north Cotswold Market Towns, and early investigation in Stroud and Stonehouse.

In Cheltenham, a new permit parking zone in St Pauls was implemented following extensive consultation over the previous year. The scheme aims to address severe parking congestion, partly due to a high number of multiple occupancy houses, whilst maintaining access for students to attend university. Early indications suggest the scheme is working well.

Initial public consultation also began on the final stages of the Cheltenham review in the west of the town centre - Westend, Lansdown and around the Railway Station. Initial feedback showed some support for changes to be made, in the Westend area in particular. Any changes in one area is likely to have a significant impact on other areas, and therefore the

County has been considering how to balance the needs of all residents, visitors to the town and commuters before consulting local people again with a more detailed proposal. That consultation is scheduled for May 2016, and the feedback received will dictate if any changes are made.

The Cheltenham Parking Review will then be largely complete, with all areas in the town centre reviewed over the course of the parking review programme since 2011.

In the north Cotswolds Market Towns, discussions have continued with key stakeholders including local business groups and town/parish councils. Following these discussions, it was decided to cease work in all areas except for Moreton in Marsh. An initial consultation event was held in Moreton in Marsh in July 2015, the results of which showed significant support for parking to be better managed on the High Street. The Town Council own and operate part of the parking areas on the High Street, and the County/Town councils are now working together to develop complementary and coherent management of parking on this area.

The County Council has also been working with Cheltenham

Racecourse to better manage major events at the racecourse and reduce the impact on local residents. After consulting local residents, a permit parking scheme, (only active during major events) has been trialled during The Open and The Festival events in November and March respectively. The County Council are now preparing to consult local residents about using this approach for all future events. The permit scheme prevents racegoers but allows residents to park in nearby streets. A consistent approach over future events will aid operation for the Council, local residents and the racecourse, and ensure any restrictions can be properly enforced.

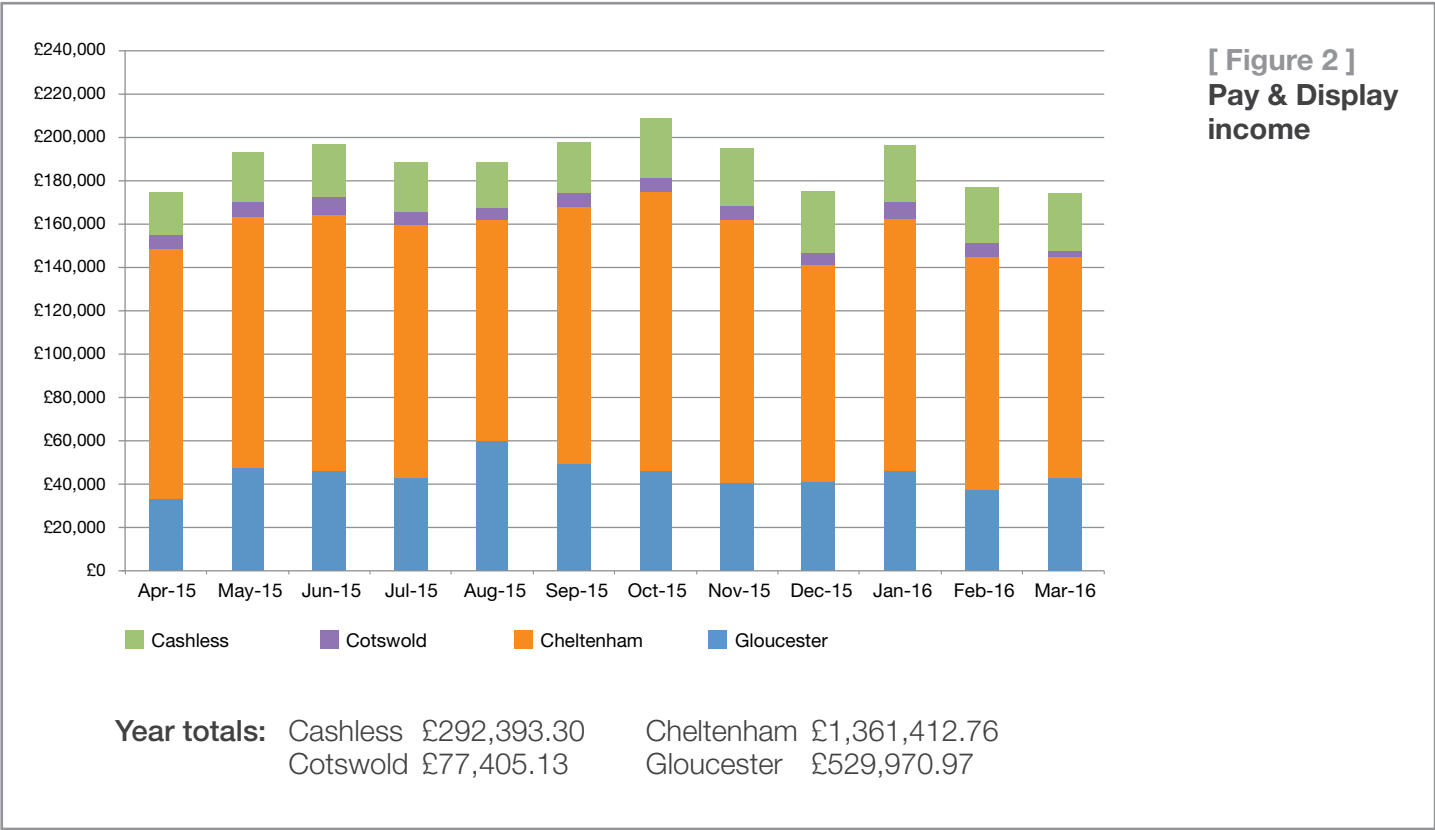
Parking surveys were undertaken in Stroud and Stonehouse, the results of which will be discussed with key stakeholders over the next year, followed by public consultation if appropriate.

Next year (2016/17) is the final year of the Gloucestershire Parking Review, after which it is likely that only small scale alterations to parking management will be required in the coming years.

3. Pay & Display income

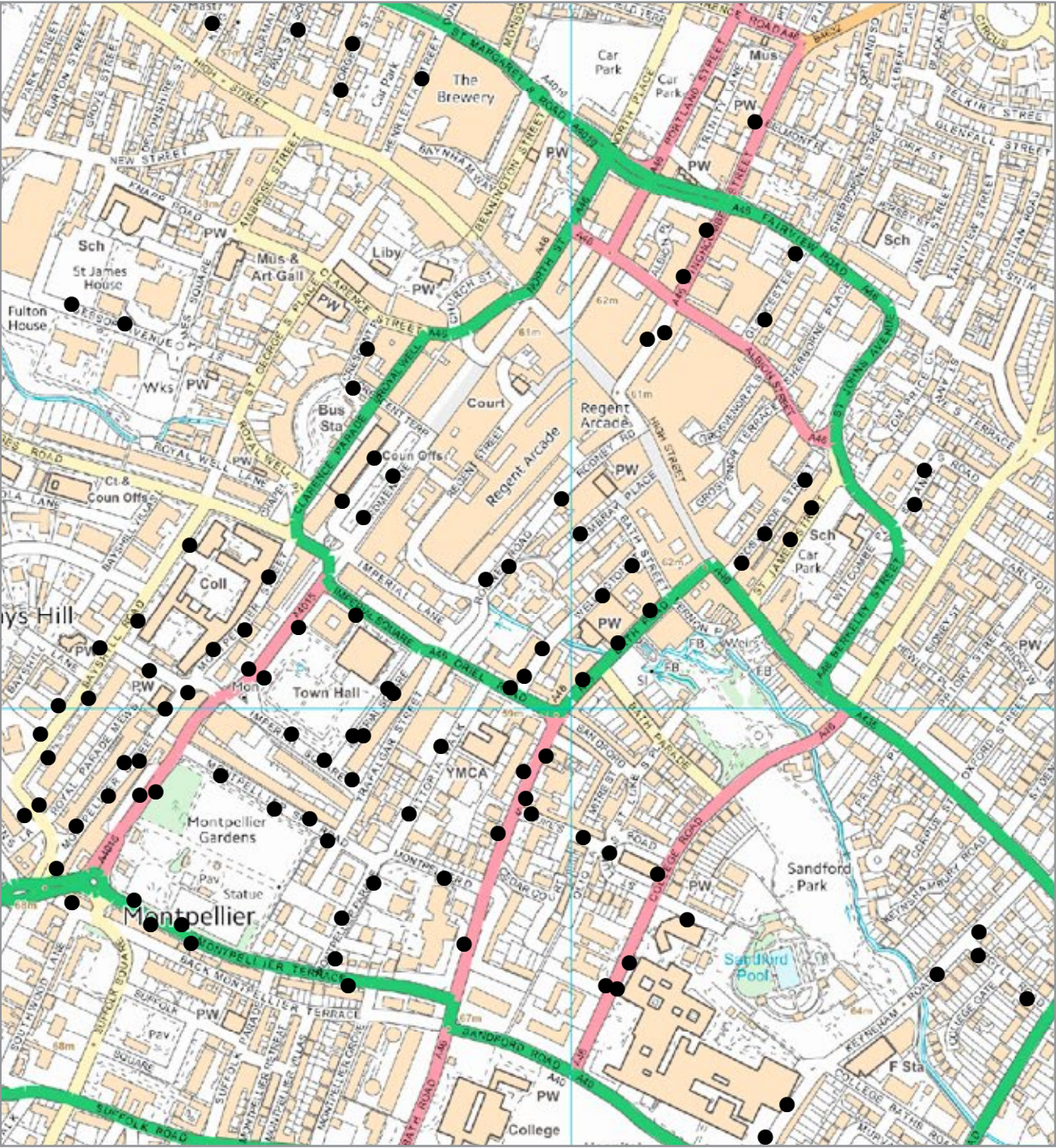
The following chart shows the income from on street Pay & Display parking in Cheltenham Borough, Cotswold District and Gloucester City Council areas.

The resulting income from on-street Pay & Display charges is approximately £160-£180,000 per month. Approximately one third of the income is collected from Gloucester, and two thirds from Cheltenham.



[Figure 3] Pay & Display machine locations in Cheltenham

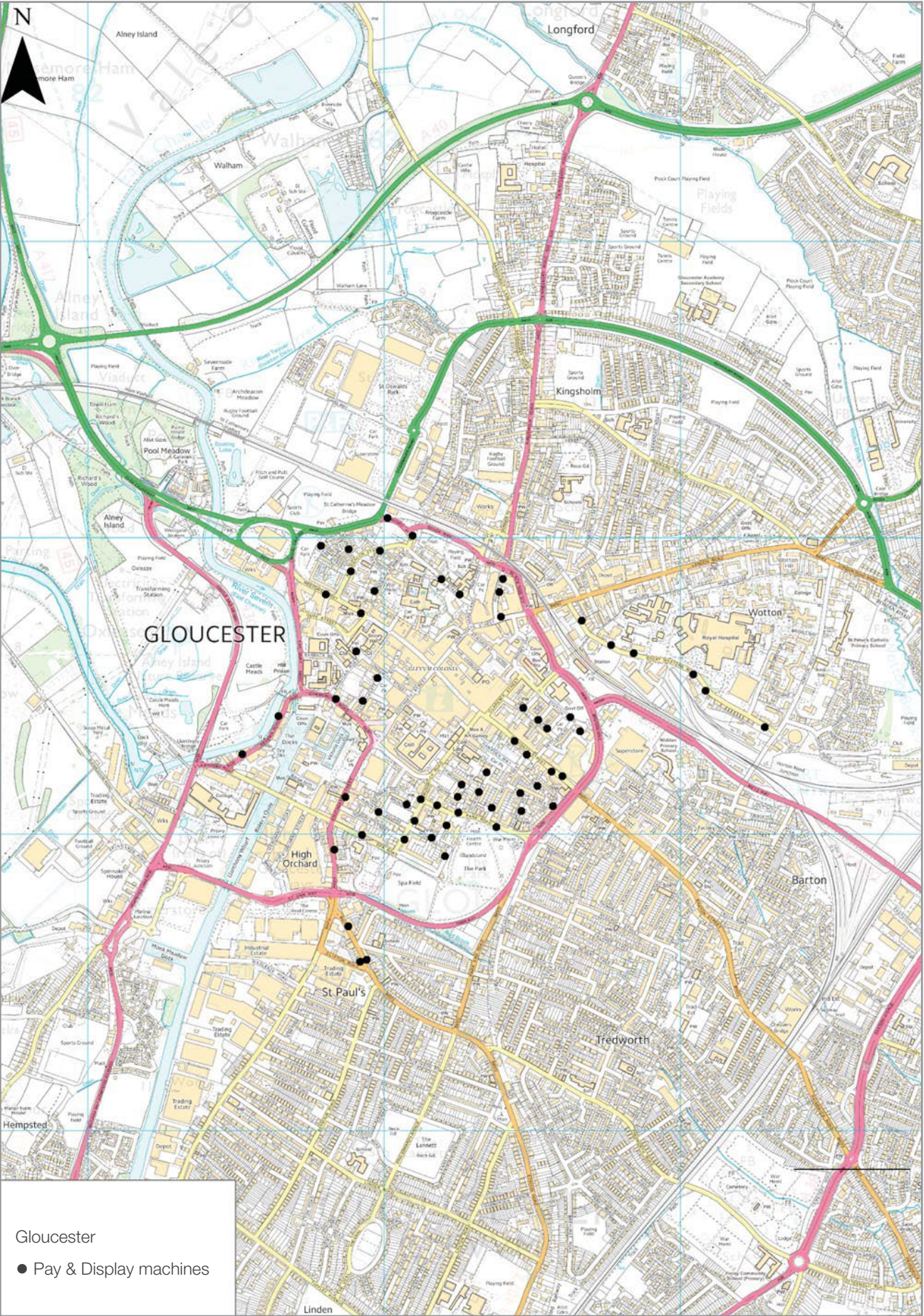

MiPermit is Gloucestershire County Council’s sole operator for cashless payments and tickets in Gloucestershire. This means that using the MiPermit location number (please see the above tariff list for the location number) to pay for parking with your debit or credit card rather than using small change. MiPermit also offers greater flexibility as you can extend your stay without returning to the Pay &

Display machine or you can book your preferred location up to seven days in advance as a part of your daily routine. To apply on line please visit the following website: <https://secure.mipermit.com/gloucestershire>

We are also trialling a new pay by minute option (highlighted on page 10) which allows you to pay for parking by the minute. For example you can opt to park Wellington

Square Cheltenham (MiPermit Location Number 705566) and pay only for the minutes you need or the change you have in your pocket. For further information please refer to the on-street Pay & Display tariff above.



4. Blue Badge Enforcement Operations

This operation was the fourth Blue Badge enforcement exercise performed in Gloucestershire following previous exercises during 15 - 24 April 2010 and 17 March - 11 June 2011.

Gloucestershire County Council carried out operations from Thursday 27 November 2014 to Tuesday 13 January 2015 and from March 2015 to March 2016.

1 badge a week was seized, so over the 9 months (35 weeks) worked of the 15-16 year 35 badges were seized and 75% prepared for prosecution (26), of which 23 cases were successfully prosecuted.

10 warning letters were issued and 45 badges were returned to the blue badge holder.

The remit was to monitor the level of compliance of Blue Badge holders in Gloucestershire and to take action against anyone found misusing or fraudulently using Blue Badges, either by prosecution through the court system or by issuing appropriate warnings.

Conclusions

Nationally it has been seen that there is a 20 to 30 percent misuse of parking cards for disabled people in urban areas. From our brief on street experience in Gloucester it appears that the level of abuse would be at the lower end of that scale and the majority of people in the county are clearly using their badges correctly.

However, from what was seen by the Blue Badge investigators

there are levels of misuse in both Gloucester and Cheltenham and further operations would be beneficial.

This scheme has now being extended and will continue through summer 2016.

5. Contract management

By working in close partnership, GCC's Parking Team assists APCOA to deliver a cost effective service. Performance monitoring enables GCC to improve delivery in areas such as:

- **Patrol routes** – to better target resources, to improve coverage throughout the county, enhance road safety, work with schools, the police, parish and district councils, residents' groups and traders' associations
- **Special events** – to ensure that they are a success. Traffic management plays a significant role in this. For example –

Cheltenham Races, Cheltenham Jazz Festival, and Cheltenham Literature Festival

- **Administration processes that deal with challenges and appeals** – to improve the customer experience after a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) has been issued, to provide guidance and recommendations on correspondence, to ensure all correspondence is correctly responded to (and in a timely manner), and to implement procedures and systems of work to achieve compliance at all stages of the PCN process

6. Enforcement

Enforcement of parking continues to produce improvements in compliance with parking restrictions throughout the county.

Gloucestershire County Council works closely with several stakeholders to deliver the management and enforcement of parking across the county.

All service and enforcement remains the sole responsibility of Gloucestershire County Council and is delivered with the close supervision and management of county officers.

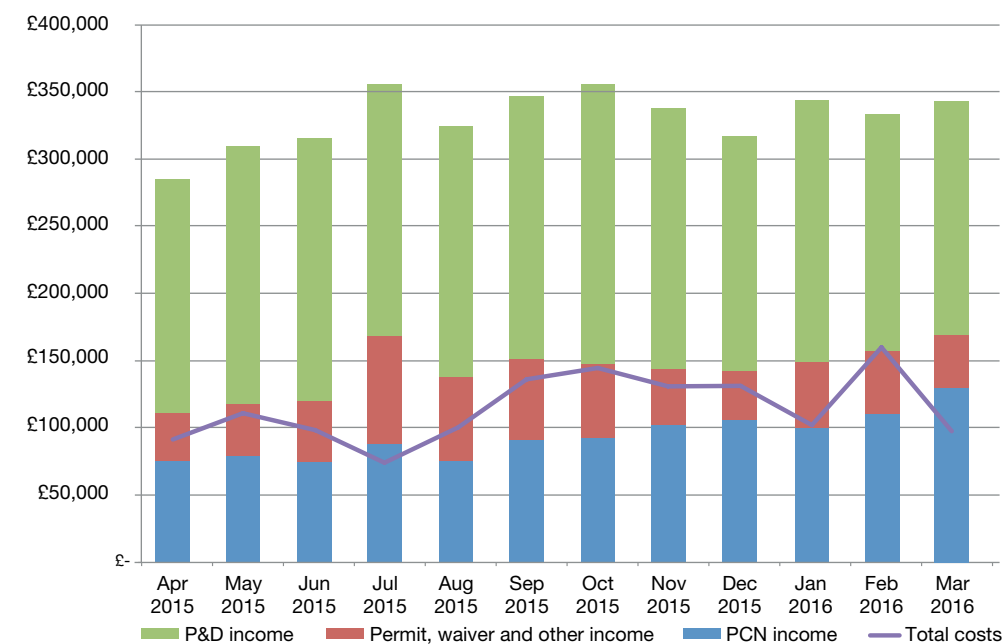
All representations against Penalty Charge Notices are considered by GCC officers.

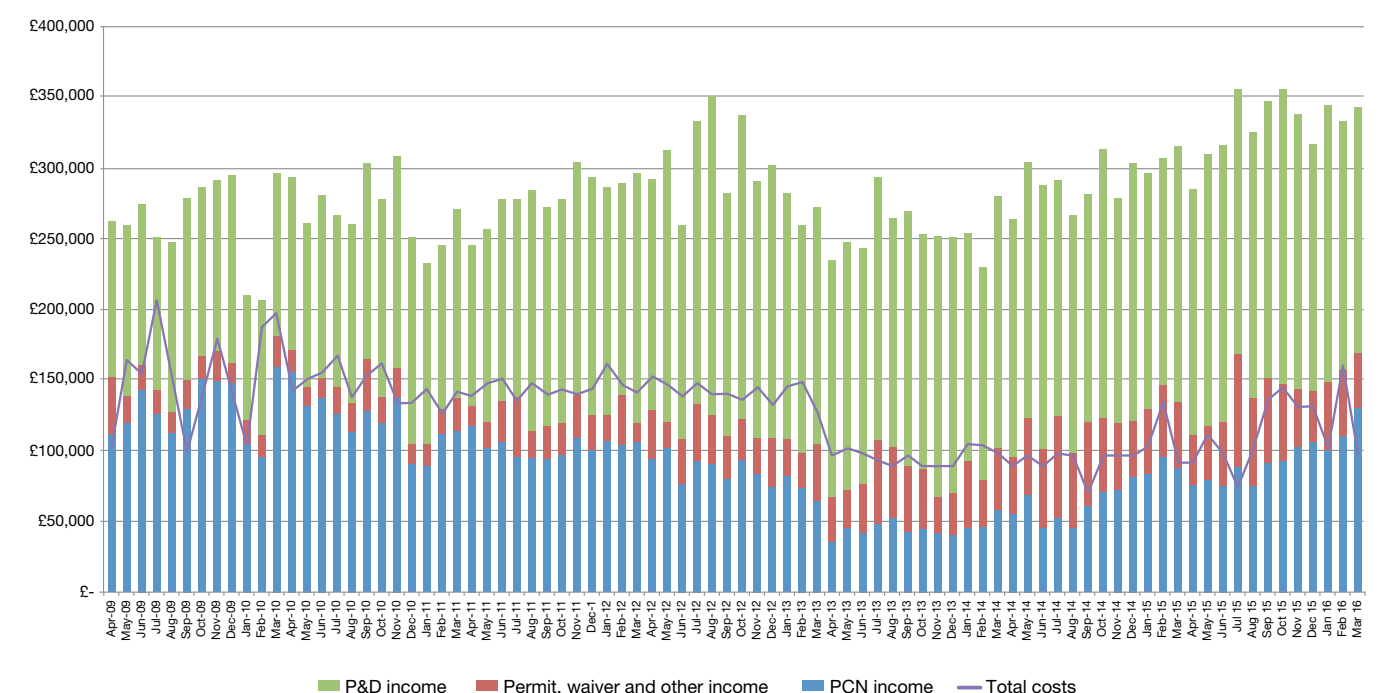
Income and costs

This year, for the first time income from Penalty Charge Notices and permits combined have occasionally exceeded the total enforcement costs. Any surplus income is reinvested in firstly the management of parking and parking assets and secondly the highways network in the county.



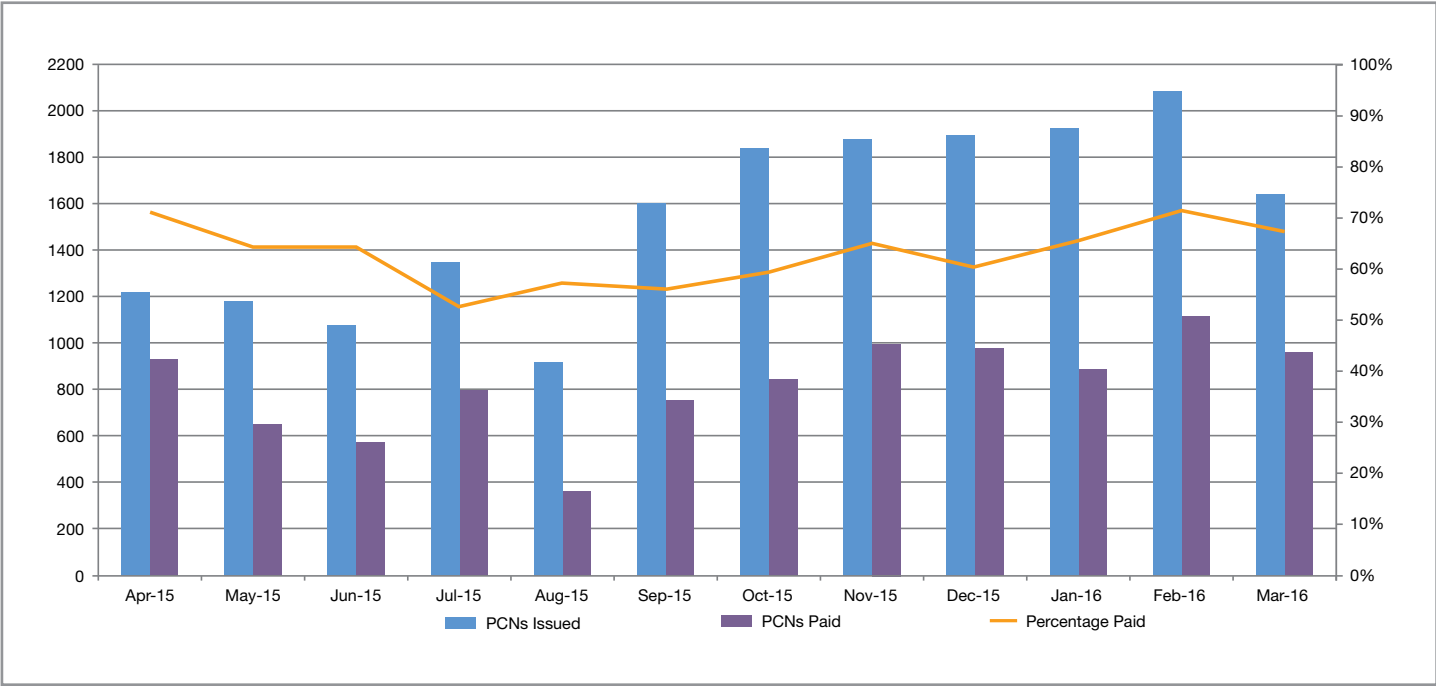

The chart below shows the number of Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) issued in each district by month. Most PCNs are issued

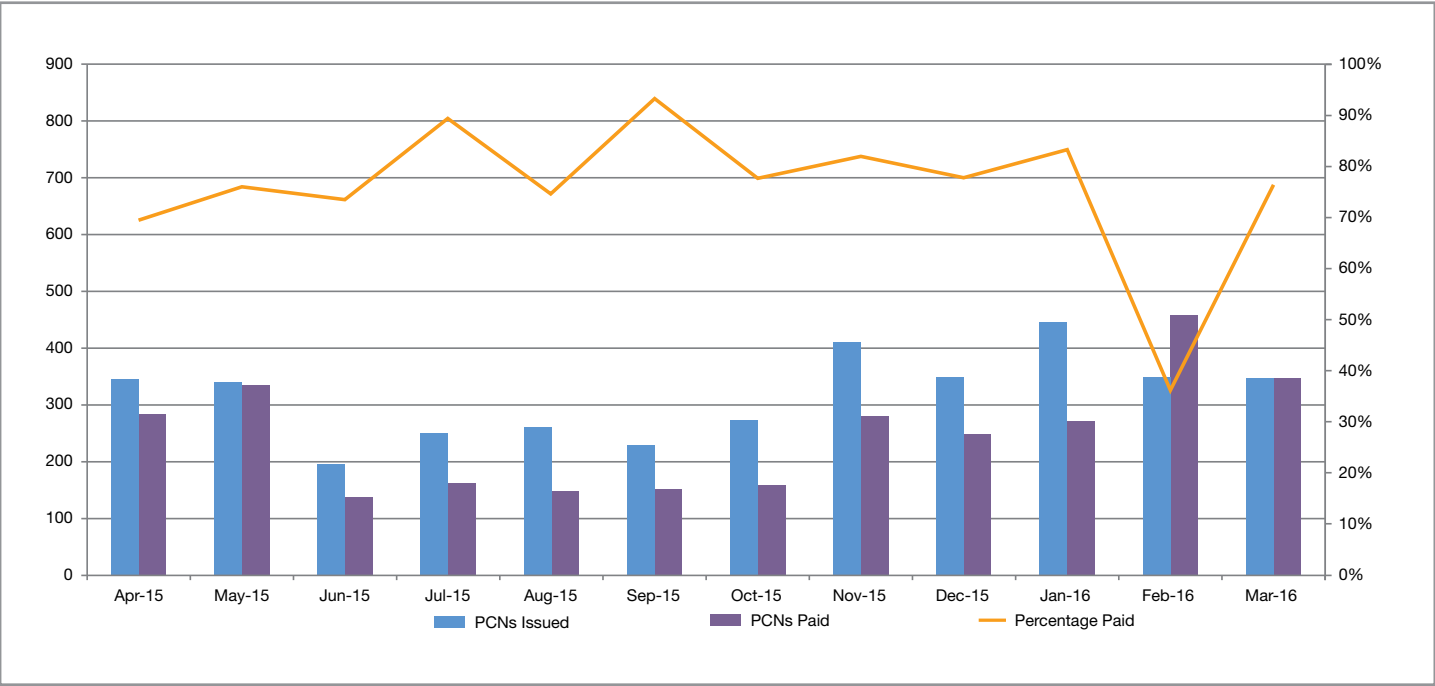
in Cheltenham and Gloucester, where there are many more parking restrictions to enforce than other towns in the county.

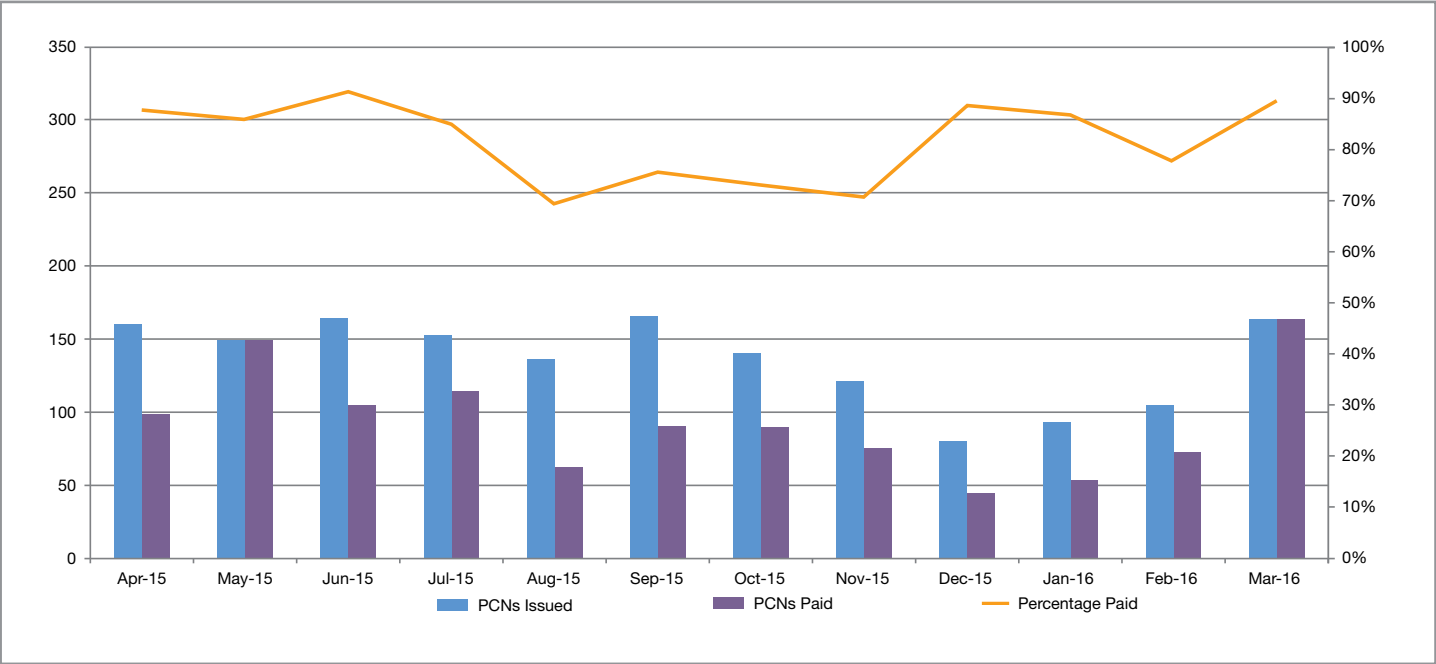

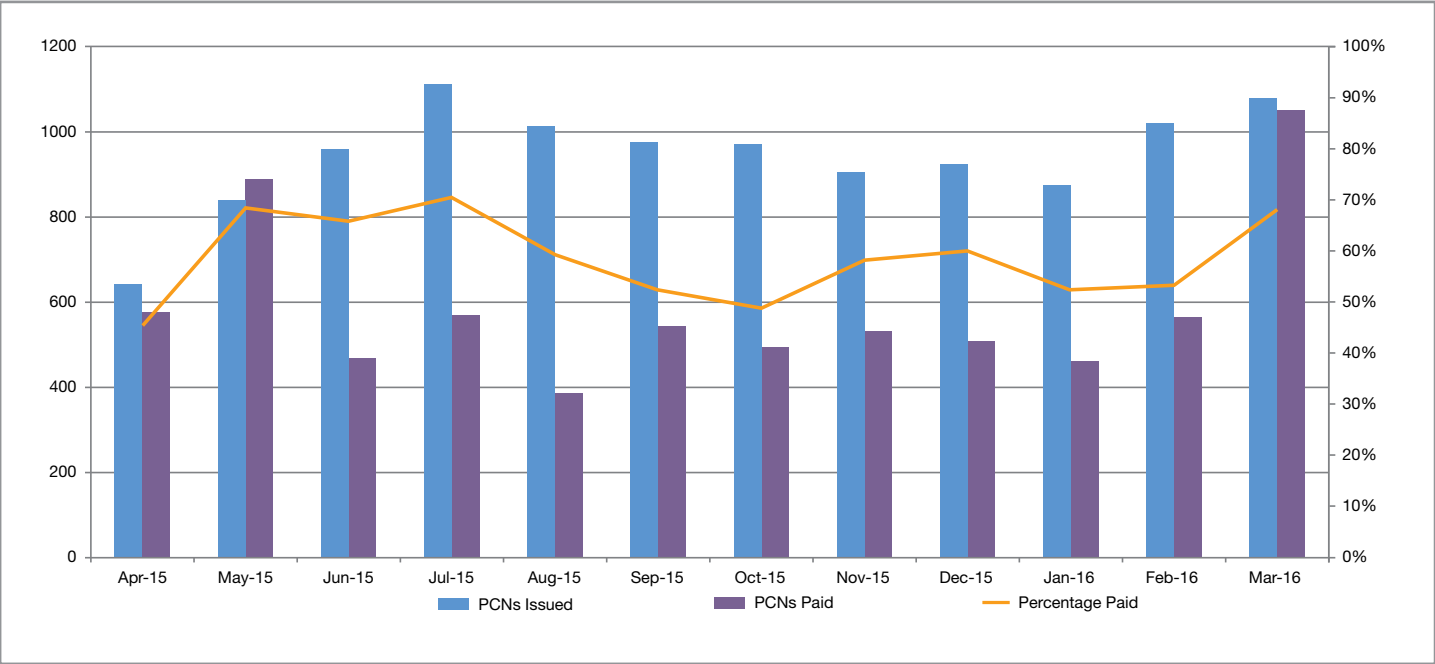

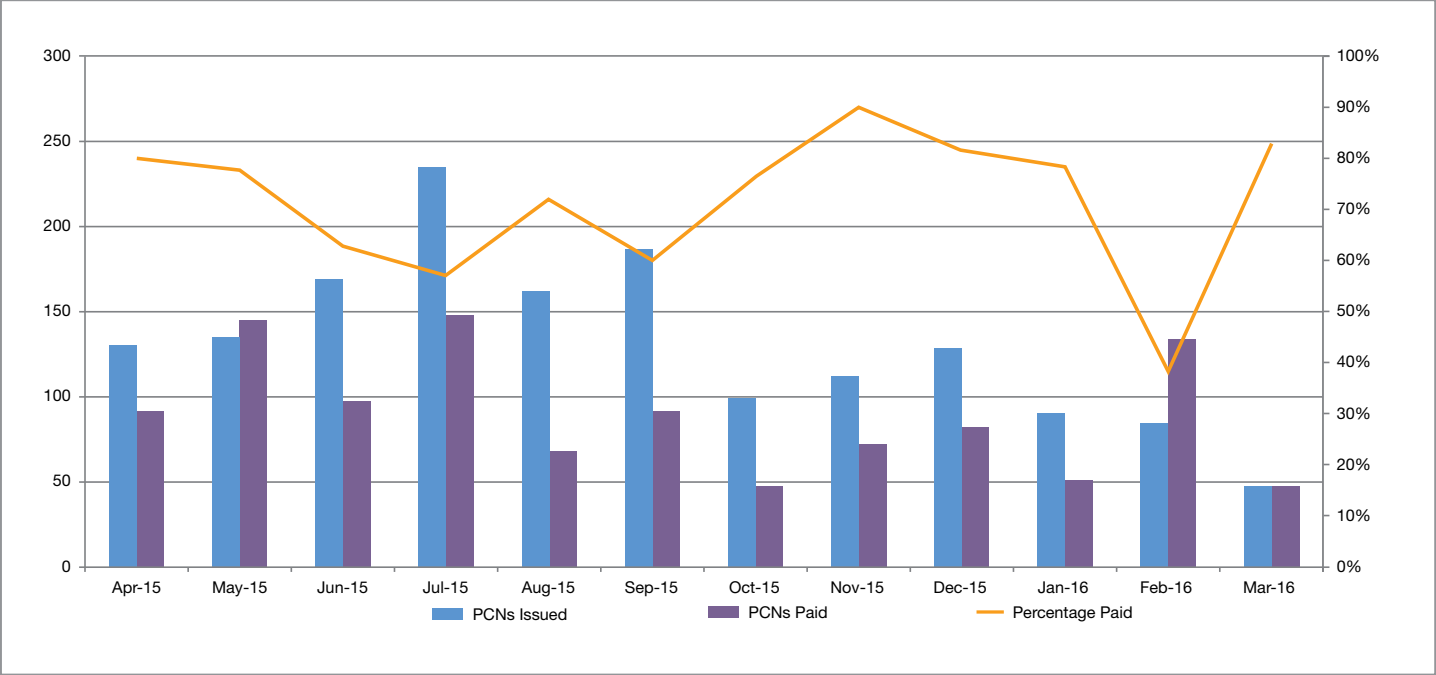

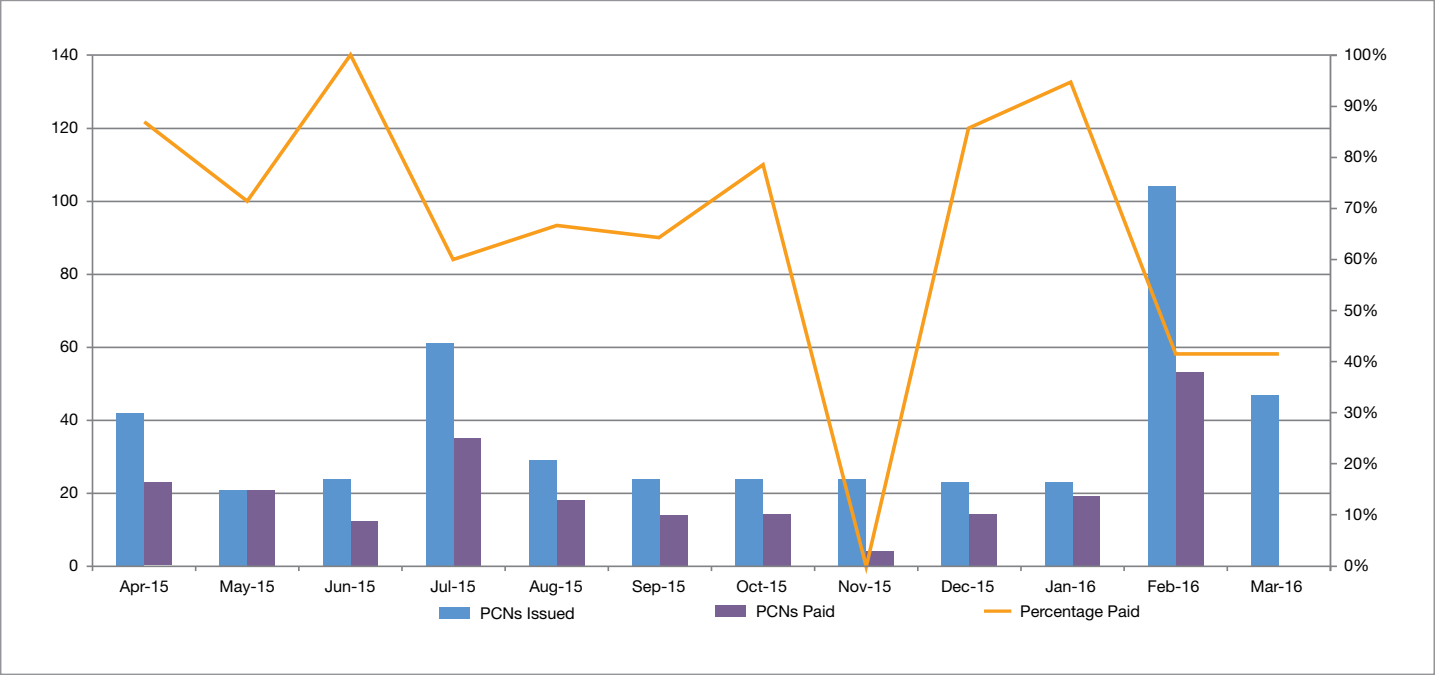

9. CCTV Bus Lane Enforcement

From September 2013 the county council took over direct management and enforcement of all bus lanes across the county.

To assist with its parking enforcement objectives, the council utilises a network of unattended CCTV cameras to improve road safety and help to prioritise the movement of local buses and reduce trip times, while enabling the county to enforce effectively and efficiently. At present four cameras are active in the county with a further three to come within the next few months.

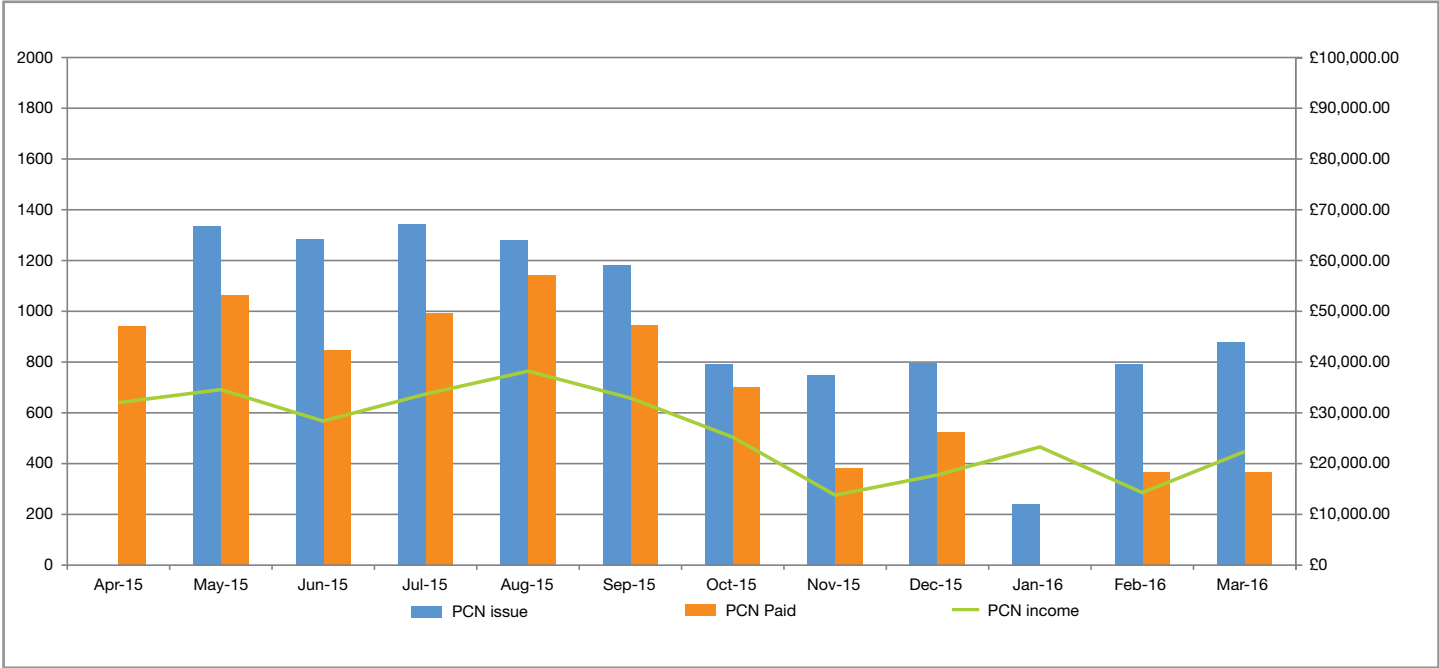
Working in partnership with developers and bus companies, the

cameras are located on bus gates (short bus only lanes) and bus lanes throughout the county.

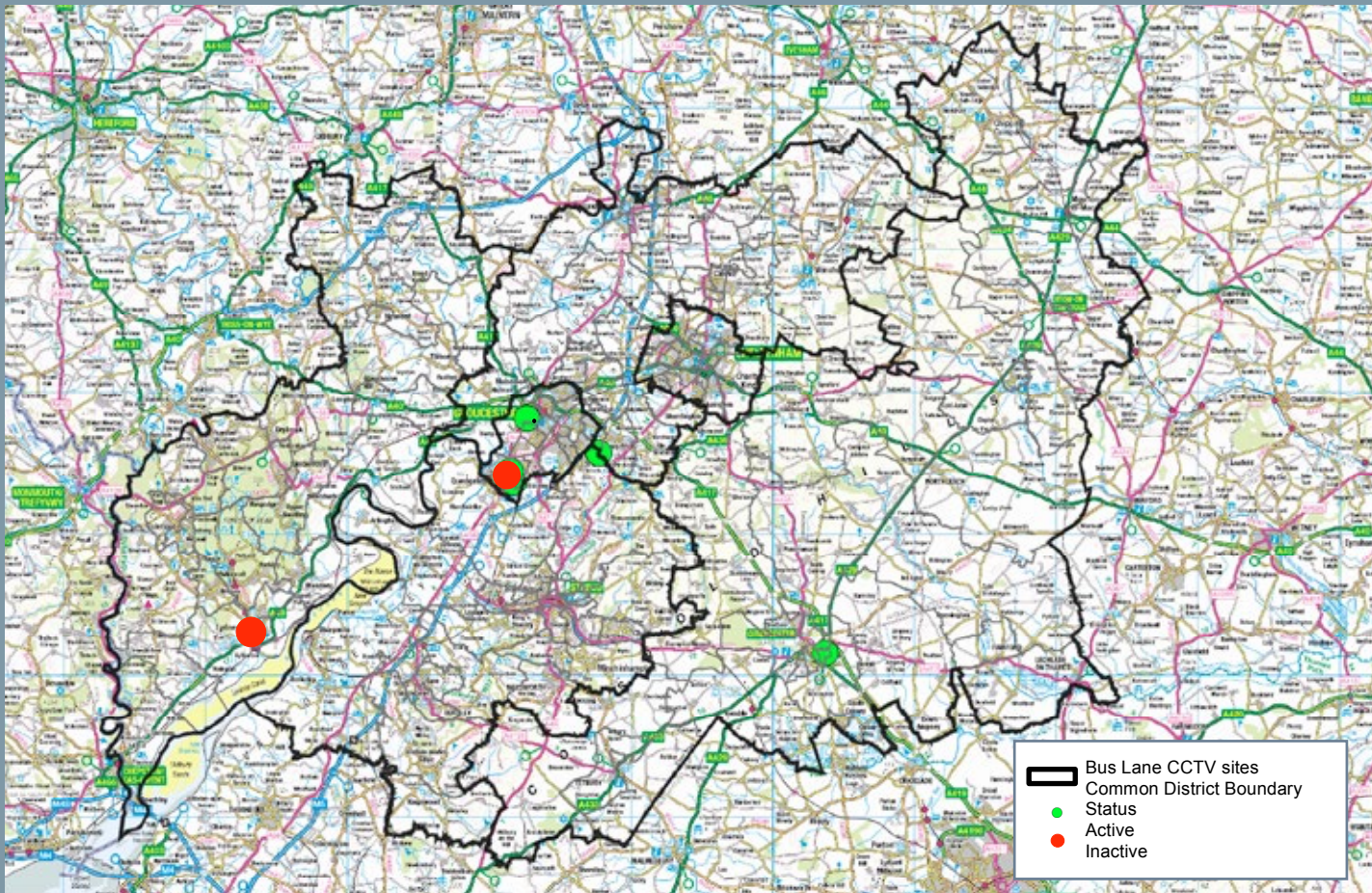
The equipment used is the Road Flow system, supplied by Systems Engineering & Assessment Ltd and is fully integrated into our parking software – Chipside. This enables seamless processing of contraventions by capturing quality evidence. All the active cameras were recently updated with 3G technology enabling improved remote access to data.

[Figure 14] Bus Lane CCTV Sites in Gloucestershire

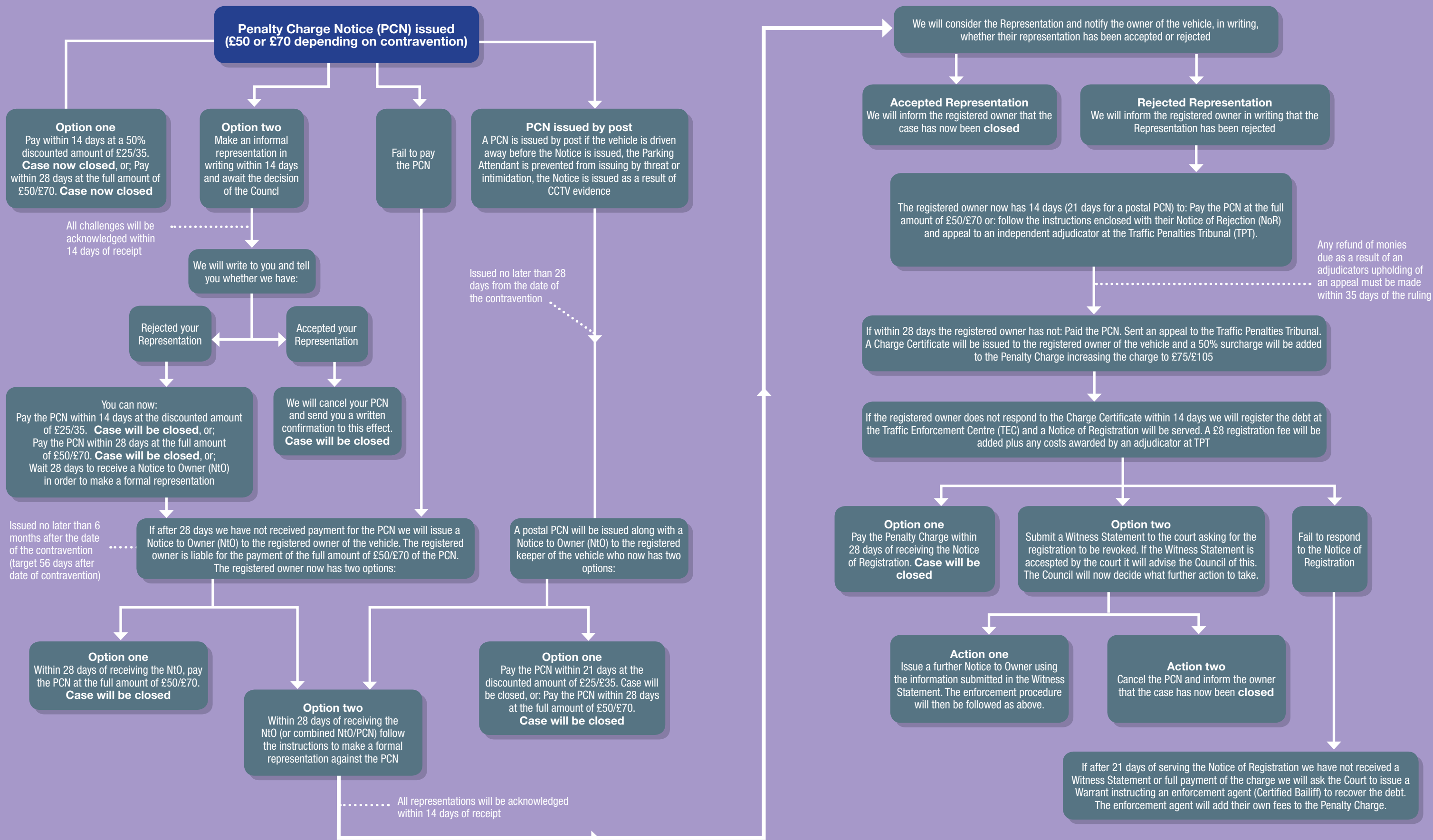

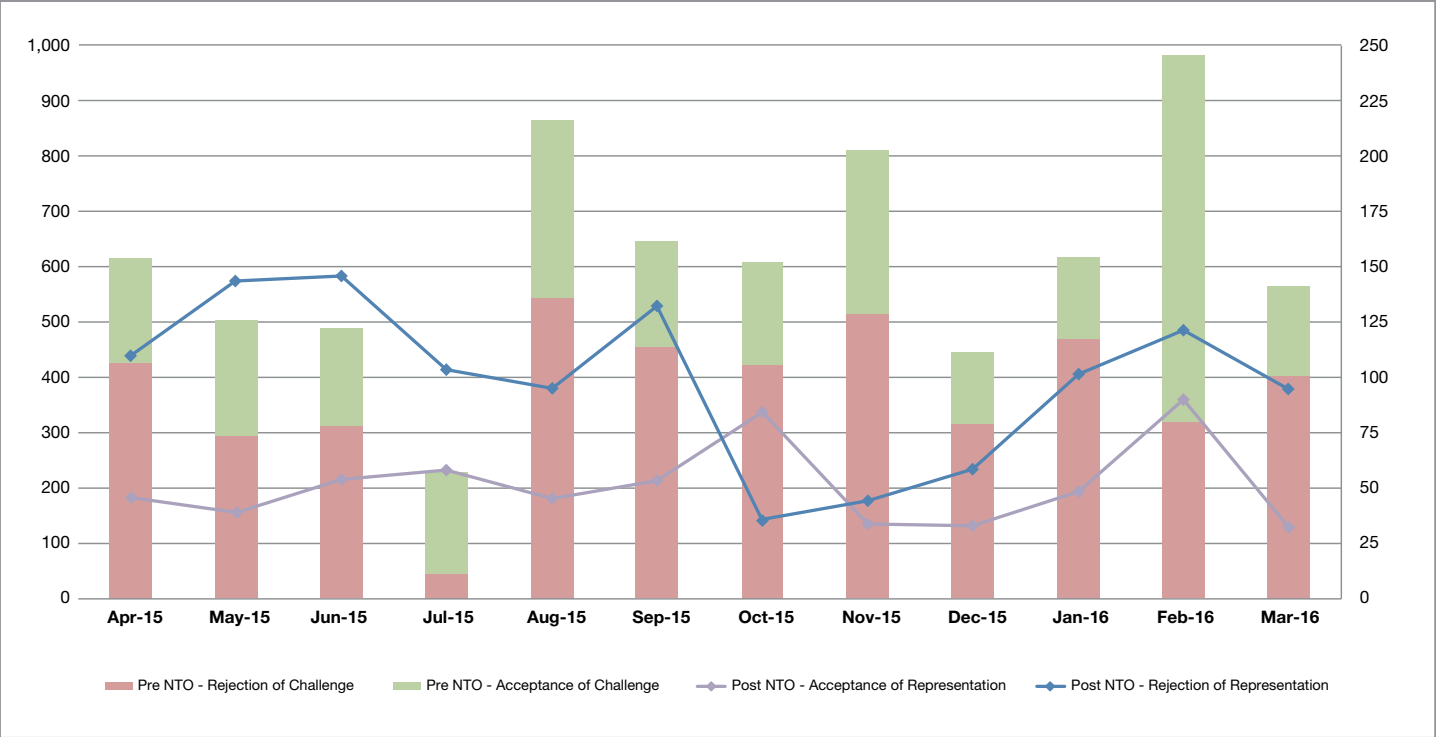

[Figure 15] PCN Life Cycle

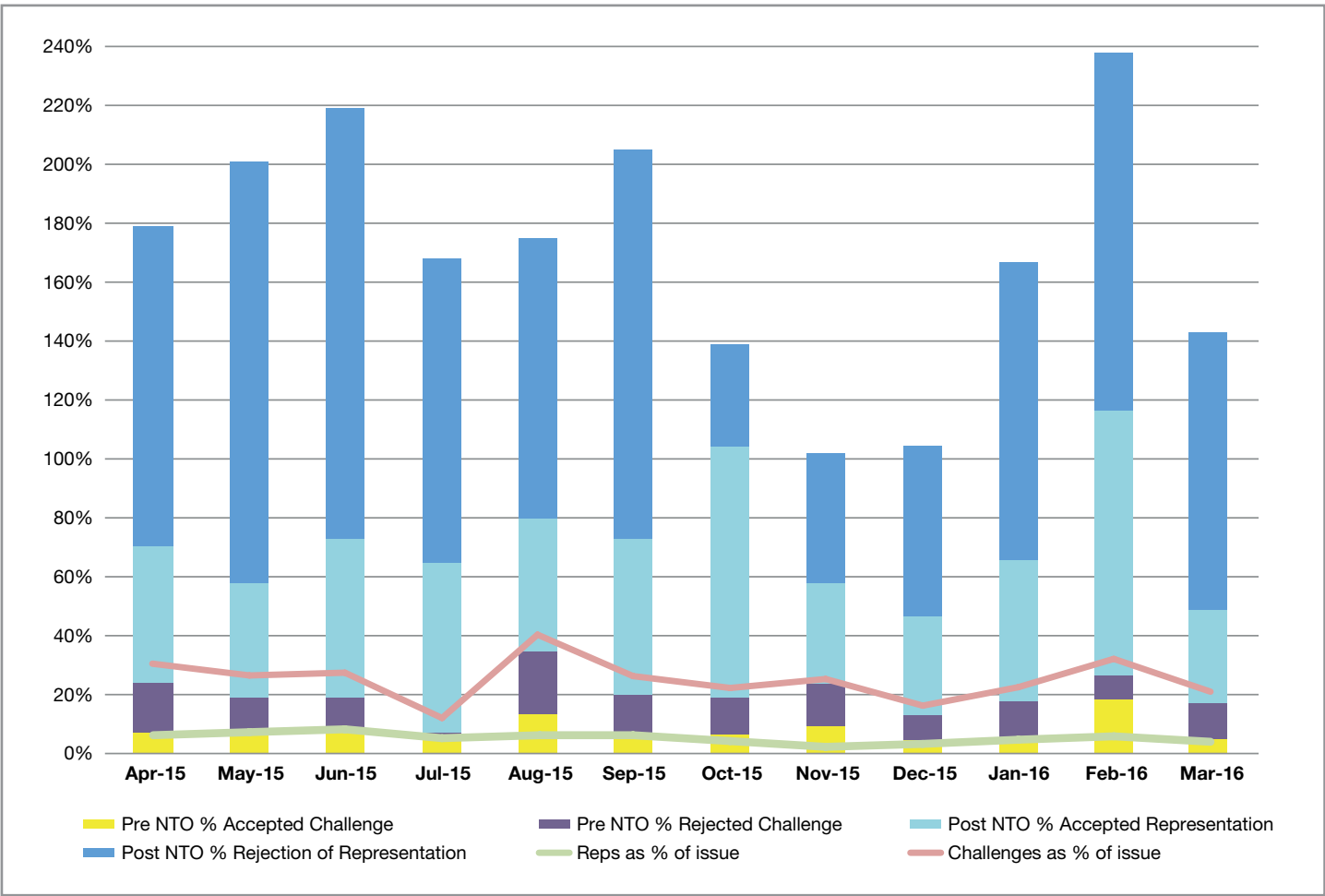

[Figure 17] Challenges and Representations as % of issue

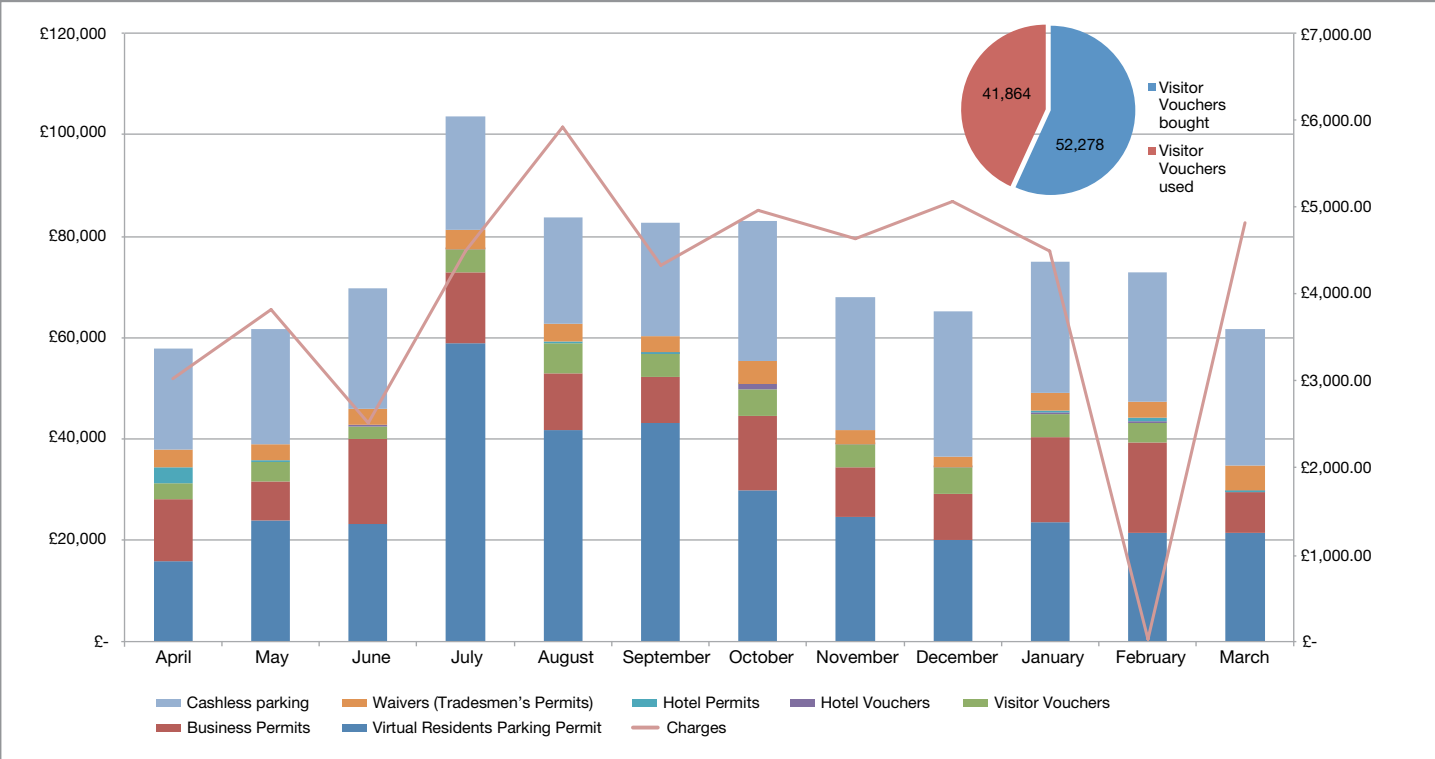

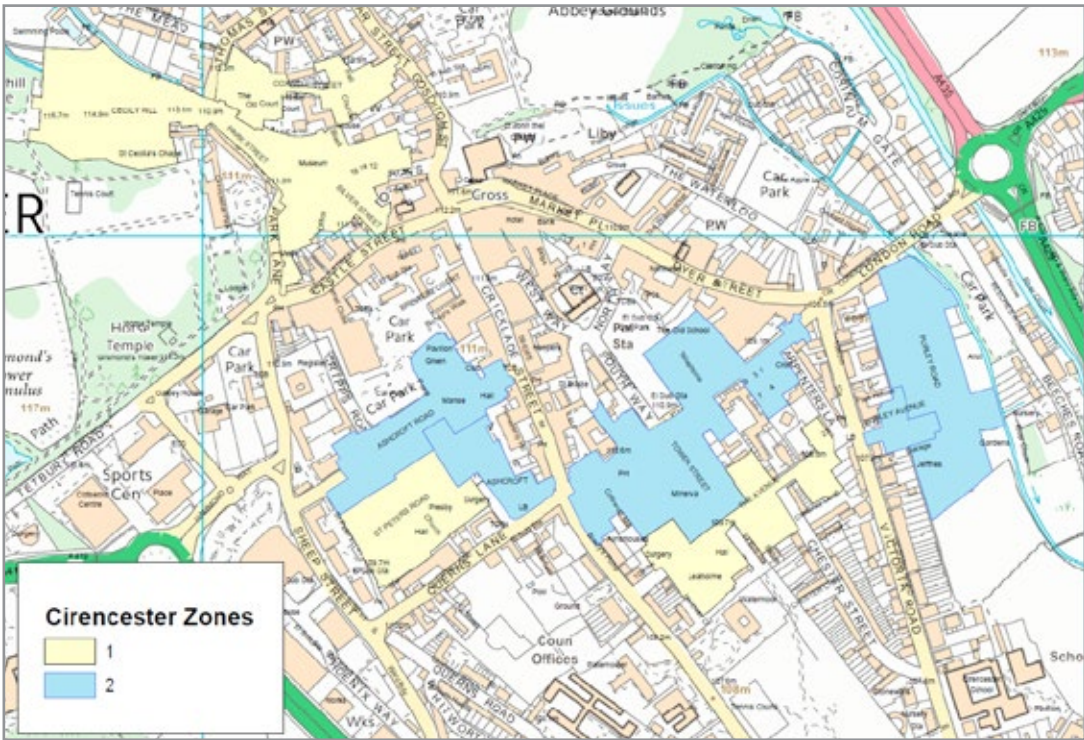

Cheltenham Zones



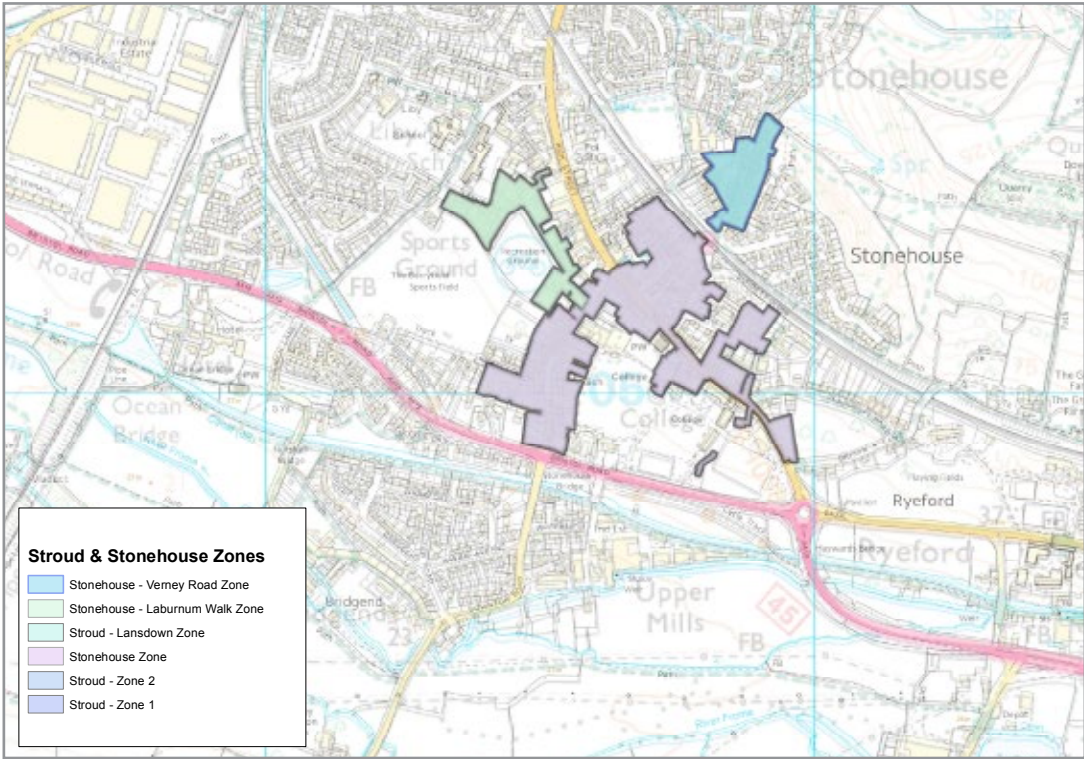

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9. Park & Ride Report (Feb 2015 to March 2016)

There are three major Park & Ride schemes now operating within Gloucestershire. Gloucester continues to be served by the Waterwells Park & Ride, based in Quedgeley, while The Racecourse and Arle Court schemes serve Cheltenham.

Apart from reducing levels of congestion the aim of any Council should be to encourage growth of commercially operated Park & Ride schemes. All 3 aforementioned Park & Ride schemes now operate on a commercial basis without GCC subsidy. In the case of Waterwells and Arle Court however the Council continues to maintain both car parks and as such works to improve customer experience and safety continue to be made.

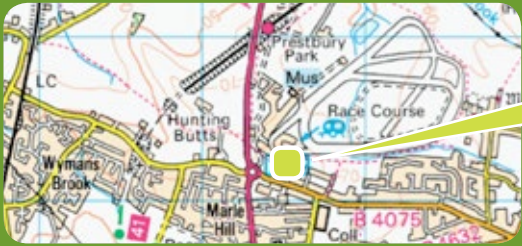

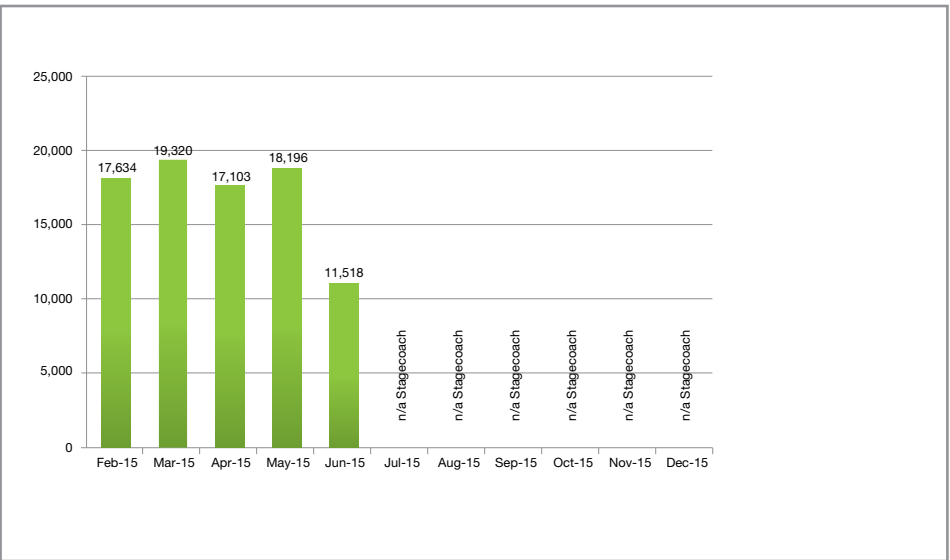

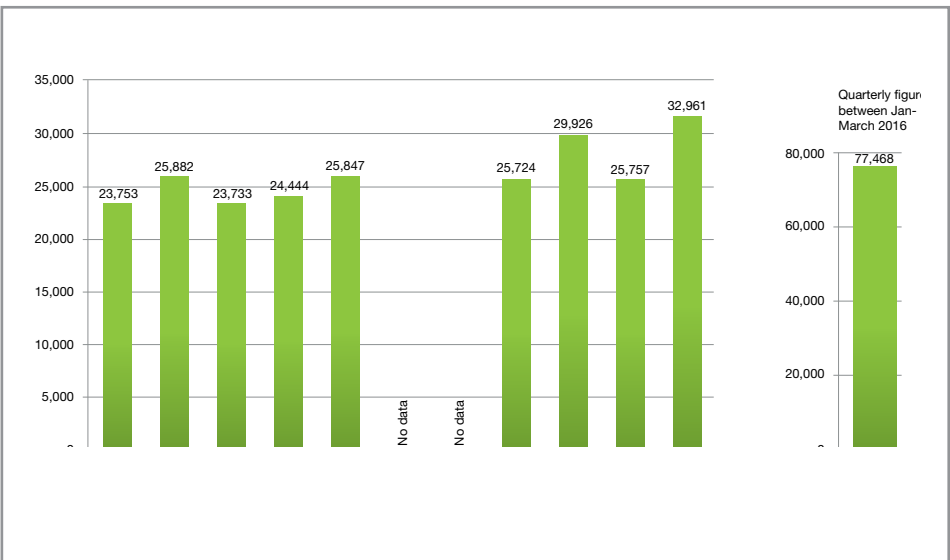
Park & Ride performance charts for Gloucester (Waterwells) and Cheltenham (Arle Court) February 2015 until March 2016
