

PUBLIC NOTICE
GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON C87 ROAD FROM NATTON TO HOMEDOWNS
(ASHCHURCH RURAL PARISH) (TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) 2026

Notice is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council in exercise of its enabling powers under Sections 81, 82 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to:

1. Replace the existing 50mph and 40mph speed limits on the C87 with a 30mph speed limit, which is detailed in Schedule 1 below, and a 30mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting as per Schedule 2 below.
2. Introduce a 30mph speed limit on Homedowns and Natton.

Schedule 1 - 30mph Speed Limit to be Introduced by Order

Road Name & Number	Description
Road from Natton to Homedowns (C87)	From a point approximately 30 metres north of its junction with Homedowns (40290) to a point approximately 5 metres south of its junction with Homedowns (50269).
Homedowns (50269)	For its entire length.
Natton (50268)	For its entire length.

Schedule 2 - 30mph Speed Limit to be Introduced by virtue of street lighting

Road Name & Number	Description
Road from Natton to Homedowns (C87)	From a point 42 metres south of its junction with Platinum Drive (72723) to a point approximately 30 metres north of its junction with Homedowns (40290).

The lengths of roads fall within the Ashchurch Rural Parish within the Tewkesbury Borough in the County of Gloucestershire.
