



ASA's Swimming – Teacher's Course

National Curriculum Training Programme (NCTP)

Course Overview

The NCTP is comprised of two training programmes that use a combination of theory and practical sessions on how best to deliver school swimming.

Fundamentals of School Swimming (previously known as Module – 1) – once completed the holder will be able to actively assist and support a more qualified teacher. Candidates can then progress to the second training programme.

Aquatic Skills of School Swimming (previously known as Module – 2) – once completed the holder will be qualified to plan and evaluate sessions in line with the national curriculum and teach independently within a school swimming programme. Candidates can only undertake this Aquatics course having successfully completed the Fundamentals course.

Please Note

Once candidates have registered for this course, they will be sent a code in order to then register all their details with the Institute of Swimming (IOS) who are the training body. This IOS registration is in order for the candidate to be able to access the online resources and receive their certificate. It also holds their details online for any further information or training. Candidates have to complete their IOS registration prior to the course starting.

ASA resources and refreshments will be provided. There are elements of the pool time on both modules so delegates are "invited" to bring appropriate clothing and footwear to be around the pool area and to take part in swimming sessions.

Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Course Outline:

Fundamentals course only – (formerly known as M1), this is now an online course costing £40. Candidates undertake this course independently www.theiosonline.com Go to: 'All Training' → 'Online Learning' → Currently on page 3(though this may change as new registrations alter the listings) and is entitled 'Fundamentals of School Swimming – Primary'

Fundamentals and Aquatic Skills - Full Course: This will take the 2 full days, there will be time in the pool on both days and a teaching assessment with children on day 2. Once successfully completed candidates will receive an ASA certificate. Candidates will have online access to Aquatics in the National Curriculum Activity Cards giving fun, varied and progressive introductory activities for children learning to swim and a learner guide to support them through the training.

Aquatics Skills ONLY: Candidates must have successfully completed the Fundamentals course before undertaking this second training stage. This course will run from 13:30 on day 1 through to all day, on day 2 (1.5 days) There will be time in the pool on both days and teaching assessment with children on day 2. Once successfully completed candidates will receive an ASA certificate. Candidates will have online access to Aquatics in the National Curriculum Activity Cards giving fun, varied and progressive introductory activities for children learning to swim and learner guide to support them through training.

Audience: All courses are open to any adult working in a school swimming environment: school teachers, classroom assistants, learning support staff, nursery nurses, qualified swimming teachers, parents, PGCE students or other helpers.
