



The scheme to improve the capacity of the A40/A417 Over Roundabout has commenced. Initial works over the first two weeks have included:

- Site set up in Hereford and Gloucester Canal trust complete.
- Night time sheet piling commenced Monday 14th May. The works are being undertaken at night due to the size of equipment required to install the piles.
- At the A40 Western Approach splitter Island, the area has been cleared of soils and repairs to existing drainage are on going.
- At the A417 Southern Approach splitter island, bulk dig is underway for carriageway widening.
- A40 Eastern Approach splitter island bulk dig is underway for carriageway widening, with traffic signal ducting extensions complete.
