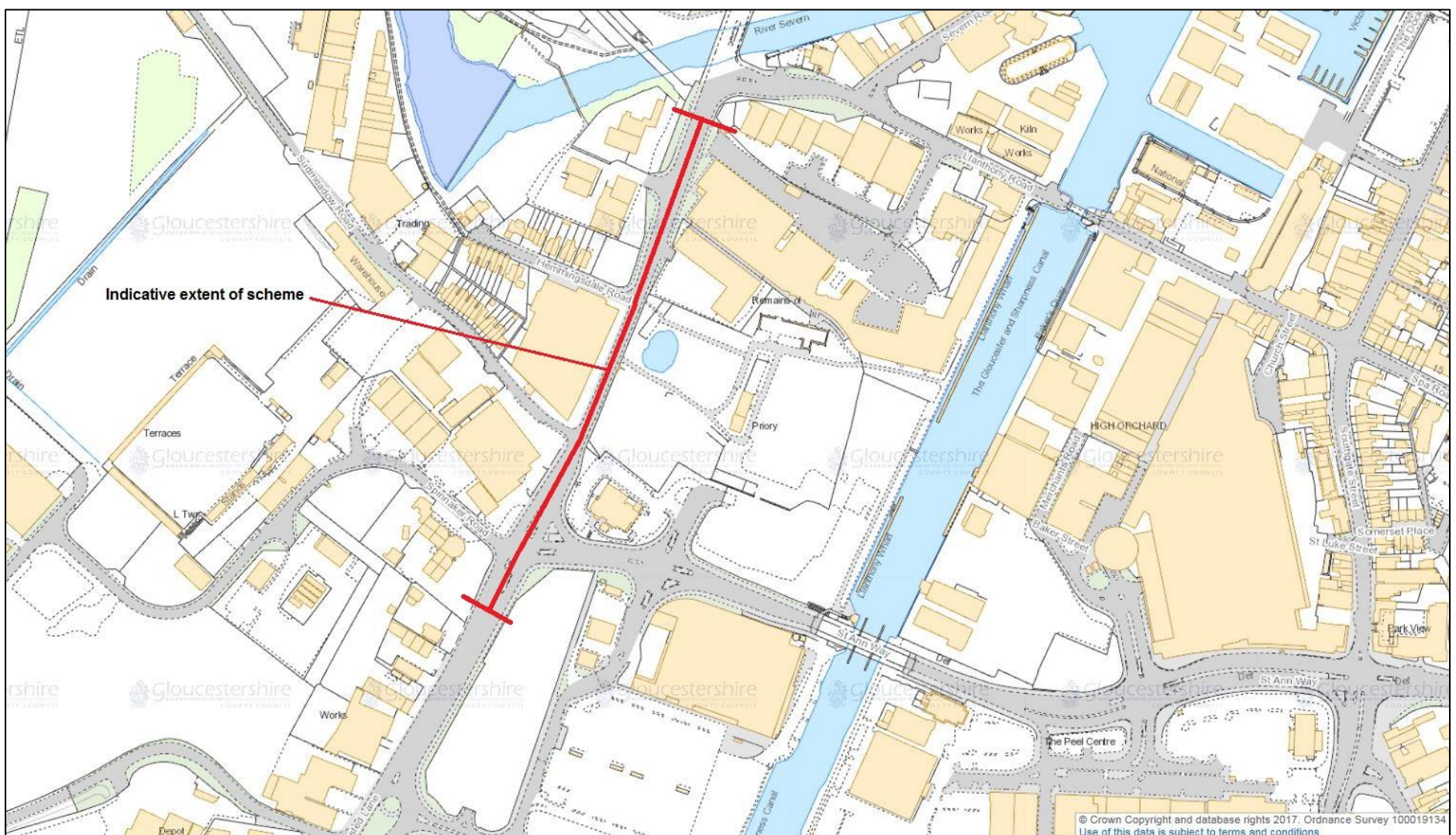

To reduce congestion at peak periods, improve journey time reliability and support growth, Gloucestershire County Council together with GFirst LEP, are proposing to undertake highway improvement works to Llanthony Road (Gloucester South West By-Pass). The scheme includes:

- Widening road and adding additional lanes in both directions, converting the road from single carriageway to a dual carriageway.
- Separate right turning lanes for motorists turning into Sudmeadow Road, Hemmingsdale Road & Llanthony Road Business Park.
- New traffic signals at Sudmeadow Road with pedestrian crossing facilities.
- Increasing the width of the footways for pedestrians on both sides of Llanthony Road.

Members of the public are invited to give feedback on the proposed scheme. Drawings detailing the proposals will be displayed at a stand in Sainsbury's (Gloucester Quays) car park, and at Gordon League Rugby Club. Representatives from Gloucestershire County Council and their service delivery partner Amey, will be on hand to capture your feedback and answer any questions you may have about these improvements.
