

### **Does the scheme affect the historic Secunda Priory wall?**

There will be no change to the historic wall, the widening of Llanthony Road will take place on the opposite side of the road. We do intend to widen the footway to create a shared use footway/cycleway in front of the Priory wall.

### **Will the council have to purchase land to build the scheme?**

The scheme will involve the purchase of third party land and buildings to enable the widening to take place. The land in question is currently in the ownership of various owners. At this stage every effort will be made to acquire the land by agreeing mutually acceptable terms and negotiated settlements with the various land owners.

### **Are there plans to demolish any of the buildings on Llanthony Road?**

Yes the scheme will include the alteration and/or partial demolition of commercial properties currently in use. Again this will only be done after establishing and negotiating, where possible, mutually agreed terms and settlements with the landowners.

### **What is the Full Business Case (FBC)**

The FBC is a document prepared by the Project Team and issued to the GFirst LEP for approval. The FBC includes an assessment of whether the scheme is fit for purpose and meets central and local government policies, it discusses what options have been considered and how options have been developed.

### **How does this scheme accommodate the anticipated new Gloucester City AFC Football stadium and other developments in the area?**

One of the schemes primary objectives is to accommodate future growth in the area. The redevelopment of the Gloucester City AFC Football stadium does have planning permission. However, the transport assessment for the redevelopment was neutral. In other words it does not overall change traffic volumes or movements. The improvements we are planning at Sudmeadow Rd should improve access to and from the stadium

### **Where can I find out more about this scheme?**

To understand local resident's views on the scheme and to ensure that the scheme meets people's needs Gloucestershire County Council is planning to hold 2 Public Share Events.
