Course Information

- ∴ This two day course provides introductory training in Video Interaction Guidance™ for those working with parents and carers who are experiencing difficulties in communication with their children, and who wish to develop better relationships with them. VIG is also relevant for staff working with children and young people in schools, special education or care settings and for staff in higher education who support others in teaching and supervision skills. VIG is used across education, health, social work and the voluntary sector.
- ∴ VIG is recommended as an evidence-based intervention for health visitors and midwives in the NICE guidelines 'Social and Emotional Wellbeing - Early Years' published October (2012), and in several other NICE guidelines (e.g. Autism 2013, Attachment 2015). VIG has been selected by the NSPCC (2011) as one of its two chosen evidence-based interventions to tackle neglect.
