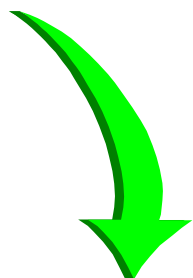


# CLAIMANT UNEMPLOYMENT DATA FOR

## April 2014

### May 14<sup>th</sup> 2014 Release



**Unemployment in the County has decreased by 271 persons to 7,243 a rate of 1.9%.**

Unemployment in Great Britain **decreased** by 52,280 persons to **1,086,293** a rate of **2.7%**.

The County rate of unemployment **has decreased** to **1.9%**.

All districts saw a decrease in the number of unemployed claimants.

The number of males unemployed in the County stands at **4,769 (2.5%)** and the number of females unemployed stands at **2,474 (1.3%)** both representing a decrease on last month.

The figures quoted above cannot be compared with:

- 1) the UK figure of **2.21 million** unemployed at a rate of **6.8%**. This is based on the International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition of unemployment. It is obtained from an ongoing national household survey and updated on a quarterly basis.
- 2) the seasonally adjusted unemployment claimant count for the UK of **1.12 million** at a rate of **2.7%**.

**NB: These figures cannot be replicated at a local level**
