

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ONE WAY AND BANNED TURNS) (VARIOUS ROADS NEAR
GLOUCESTER BUS STATION) GLOUCESTER CITY ORDER 2018

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the _____ 2018 and may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council (One Way and Banned Turns) (Various Roads Near Gloucester Bus Station) Gloucester City Order 2018;

(ii) The roads fall within the Wards of Hempsted and Westgate and Kingsholm and Wotton within the boundary of Gloucester City in the County of Gloucestershire;

2. In this Order –

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 ("TSRGD")

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order

3. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle except with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform from proceeding in that length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order ("the Schedule 1 Road") other than the way described;

4. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle except with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform from making a right turn manoeuvre along that length of road described in Schedule 2 to this Order ("the Schedule 2 Road");

5. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle except with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform from making a left turn manoeuvre along that length of road described in Schedule 3 to this Order ("the Schedule 3 Road");

6. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Motor Vehicle to proceed along the Schedule 1 Road against the direction referred to in Schedule 1 as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance emergency service purposes

7. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Motor Vehicle to make a right or left turn manoeuvre along the Schedule 2 Road or Schedule 3 Road as may be necessary to enable the following should there not be an alternative access or egress:-

- (a) the mechanical cleansing, maintenance, servicing, improvement or reconstruction of any of the Schedule 2 Road or Schedule 3 Road; or
 - (b) the lay, erection, alteration or repair in, or over land adjacent to any of the Schedule 2 Road or Schedule 3 Road of any sewer or any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (c) the vehicle to be used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance emergency service purposes; or
 - (d) the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties in connection with its activities at premises situated on or adjacent to the Schedule 2 Road or Schedule 3 Road.
7. Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Bus to make a right turn manoeuvre along the Schedule 2 Road.
8. Nothing in Article 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Bus to make a left turn manoeuvre along the Schedule 3 Road.
