

Metz Way/Abbeymead Avenue Corridor Works

Progress Update 9 July – 31 July

General Progress: Eastern Avenue / Metz Way

Installation of the new traffic signal ducting is under way and, where possible, is being done during daytime lane closures off peak between 9:30am and 3:30pm. We are trying to keep disruption to a minimum during these periods.

We will need to close all the lanes in certain directions sequentially to allow the remaining ducting to be installed, but these will only be in one direction at a time straight through the junction.

The widening of crossing points on the traffic islands has also started and most of these works can be done during off peak closures. Details of upcoming road closures are below.



Night Time Road closures 7pm – 7am are planned as follows:

Eastern Avenue North East bound 13/08/18 and 14/08/18

Eastern Avenue South West bound 15/08/18 and 16/08/18

Eastern Avenue South West bound 20/08/18 and 21/08/18 (One lane will remain open)

Metz Way North West bound 22/08/18 and 23/08/18

Metz Way South East bound 28/08/18 and 29/08/18.

All **left turns** at the junction **will remain open** during these road closures.

In the next two weeks works will continue on Metz Way Eastern Avenue installing ducting and altering kerblines, and work will commence imminently at the Metz Way/Asda junction to upgrade the traffic signals.
