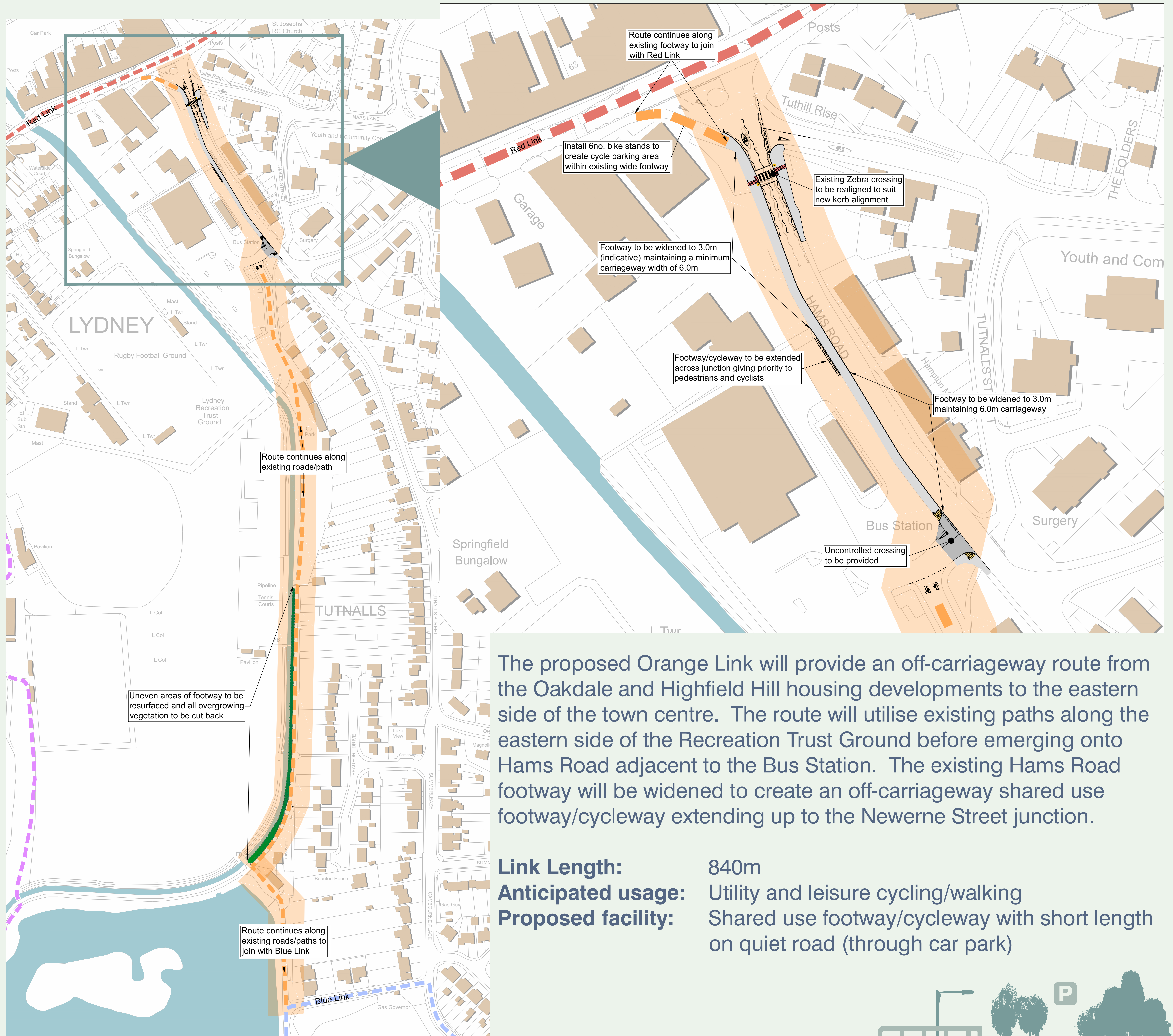


Lydney Cycle Improvements - Orange Link



The proposed Orange Link will provide an off-carriageway route from the Oakdale and Highfield Hill housing developments to the eastern side of the town centre. The route will utilise existing paths along the eastern side of the Recreation Trust Ground before emerging onto Hams Road adjacent to the Bus Station. The existing Hams Road footway will be widened to create an off-carriageway shared use footway/cycleway extending up to the Newerne Street junction.

Link Length: 840m
Anticipated usage: Utility and leisure cycling/walking
Proposed facility: Shared use footway/cycleway with short length on quiet road (through car park)



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
