

Metz Way/Abbeymead Avenue Corridor Works

Progress update 21 August – 12 September

Eastern Avenue & Metz Way Junction (Site 2)

All road crossings are complete for the new traffic signal system at the Eastern Avenue junction. Kerbing to the traffic islands is also complete and the new paving will start going down soon.

Road closures will be needed this October; to carry out resurfacing works through the junction and provide new road markings. Closure dates will be published in due course.

ASDA & Metz Way Junction (Site 1)

Works to install new ducting for signal cables and tactile paving are ongoing as we prepare to install new traffic signals.

Junction of Abbeymead Avenue & North Upton Lane (Site 5)

Works have commenced and the pedestrian crossing here will be closed until completion. A temporary traffic system will be set up for the works to be carried out safely, as we widen the southern side of Abbeymead Avenue and install new drains.

Works to the Northern side of Abbeymead Avenue have been delayed due to the discovery of another badger set. We will be installing a one way gate to the entrance of the set so they stay safe during these works.



Junction of St Lawrence Road & Metz Way (Site 3)

Works have now started at site 3. The crossing here will be closed while we upgrade it. A temporary crossing is in place 30 metres away.

17 Sep Metz Way / Coney Hill Roundabout (Site 4) works start

ASDA junction installation of new traffic signals

These works will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.

Access to and from Asda will be maintained at all times but it may be necessary on certain nights to follow a diversion route.

27 Sep Eastern Avenue Removal of Hi tower Lighting

Lane Restrictions will be in place over two days. The junction will remain open in both directions

Oct Metz Way / Eastern Avenue Resurfacing

Night time closures will be in place, dates to be published soon
