

## Metz Way/Abbeymead Avenue Corridor Works

Progress Update 14 November to 5 December

Works have been progressing well on site over the last few weeks, as we have completed some key milestones, including finishing Site 1 Asda Junction and the resurfacing at Site 2 Eastern Avenue. Extra crews have been working hard across all the sites to get work done, our crews will be working right up to Christmas to complete works at as many sites as possible.

### Eastern Avenue & Metz Way Junction (Site 2)

We are nearly complete here – we plan to switch on the new intelligent traffic signals on 20 December. The carriageway resurfacing is complete. Crossings will be resurfaced after the Christmas break once the new signs are in place.



### Junction of Abbeymead Avenue & North Upton Lane (Site 5)

The project team have been working hard to minimise disruption at North Upton Lane. Our crews are manually controlling the traffic lights at this junction during peak hours to minimise disruption to commuters. We are working to divert the Gas Main, and have re-designed part of the improvements to minimise the disruption to the travelling public. The badgers are still at the site and we are working to make sure they aren't disturbed.



### Metz Way / Coney Hill Roundabout (Site 4)

The footpaths up to Broadleys road are in and we will complete resurfacing here before Christmas. We plan to have all of the islands replaced and footways surfaced too.



**Abbeymead Avenue / The Oaks (Site 6)**

The new signals should be up and running by Christmas. We have a small amount of resurfacing to complete and then we will be done.



**Junction of St Lawrence Road & Metz Way  
(Site 3)**

The toucan crossing is switched on. We are aiming to resurface each approach next week, with the new white lines to follow on 17 December.

We apologise for any delays the temporary road layouts may cause, but they are essential for the works to be carried out safely, for both the public and our workforce.
