

A38 Cross Keys Roundabout Improvements

Bulletin 2 – 24 May 2019

Progress since 13 May

We set up our traffic management around the island with a new solid white line and cones around the roundabout and barriers along the approach from the M5 (previously the B4008). We have been monitoring the traffic levels and adjusting management accordingly, which has seen an improvement in flows.

During this time, we have begun work within the Cross Keys Roundabout island, excavating to allow us to build the new inside lane.

Over the next two weeks we will be carrying on with work within the roundabout, laying the new kerb line and surface to allow us to move to the outside lane, whilst still maintaining traffic flow.

Traffic Management

On **Tuesday 28th May** we will be shutting one lane on the A38 approach to Cross Keys Roundabout from the M5 (Previously the B4008).

In the week commencing **Monday 3rd June** we will have partial night-time closures of the Cross Keys Roundabout to install ducting. Works are restricted to 20:00 – 06:00 and diversion routes will be signposted.
