Unspent funds from previous years can be carried over to the next financial year.

Safety scheme	Improvement schemes	£10 +	These can include TROs that form part of highway improvement schemes that aim to improve safety in areas that have been identified as having considerable safety issues, as part of GCC County Hotspot list compiled by the GCC Road Safety and Traffic Data team.
Developer funded	S106	£10 to £100	These form part of planning agreements and schemes that are due to new developments within the county. The developer fully fund these schemes.
Externally funded	i.e. Highways England	£10 to multi million pound schemes	These TROs can be funded via external means i.e. Highways England, neighbouring authorities where the scheme crosses the county border.
