**BOROUGH) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2020**

Notice is hereby given that on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020 Gloucestershire County Council made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to experimentally introduce a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles restriction between the hours of 8.15-9.15am and 2.30-3.30pm Monday-Friday along those lengths of roads as shown in the Schedule below with exemptions.

**THE SCHEDULE**  
**School Streets Prohibition of Driving to be introduced**

**Monday to Friday 08:15 – 09:15 and 14:30 – 15:30**

Durham Close, Warden Hill (490748)	For its entire length
Rope Walk, Tewkesbury (407805)	For its entire length

The roads fall within the boundaries of Warden Hill Ward in the Borough of Cheltenham and Tewkesbury Town with Mitton Ward in the Borough of Tewkesbury all of which are within the County of Gloucestershire.

The Experimental Order is Experimental and may continue in force for a period of up to 18 months expiring on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2022. In due course the County Council will consider whether or not the provisions of the Experimental Order should continue in force indefinitely.

Within 6 months of coming into force of the Experimental Order any person may object to its indefinite continuation.
