



GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE) (PROHIBITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND SUSPENSIONS)
A46 COLLEGE ROAD AND 490347 KEYNSHAM ROAD
(COLLEGE WARD) CHELTENHAM BOROUGH

Gloucestershire County Council has by this Notice under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and under all other enabling powers including The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 temporarily suspended the prohibitions and restrictions on the roads described in Schedule 1 below and temporarily implemented the prohibitions and restrictions on the roads described in Schedule 2 below. All roads fall within the College Ward, Cheltenham Borough, Gloucestershire.

The reason for the prohibitions, restrictions and suspensions is to assist the NHS staff at Cheltenham General Hospital with COVID related support.

This Notice comes into force on 8th February 2021 and will continue for up to 5 days. However, as the COVID pandemic pressure on the NHS is unlikely to cease by the end of the 5 day period, it will be necessary to extend the prohibitions, restrictions and suspensions by making an Order. This legal Order will authorise the prohibitions, restrictions and suspensions for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice.
