(CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE) (PROHIBITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND SUSPENSIONS)
A46 COLLEGE ROAD AND 490347 KEYNSHAM ROAD
(COLLEGE WARD) CHELTENHAM BOROUGH

Gloucestershire County Council has made an order to restrict temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and under all other enabling powers including The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 the roads described in Schedule 1 below and temporarily implemented the prohibitions and restrictions on the roads described in Schedule 2 below.

All roads fall within the College Ward, Cheltenham Borough, Gloucestershire.

The reason for the prohibitions, restrictions and suspensions is to assist the NHS staff at Cheltenham General Hospital with COVID related support.

The roads were originally restricted for 5 days by Urgent Notice commencing 8th February 2021. However, the Coronavirus Guidance and Regulations which led to the restrictions are still in force and so it is necessary to extend the restriction by and Order which will authorise the restriction of the Road for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice. The roads are expected to be
