

The Admiral Nurse Service is now live!

Admiral Nurses specialise in dementia care, by providing support to family carers and people affected by dementia, particularly during complex periods of transition. Admiral Nurses also provide education, leadership, development and support to other colleagues and service providers.

Referral criteria:

- The person being cared for has a confirmed diagnosis of dementia, with no indication of functional mental health or physical brain injury, which could otherwise account for symptoms.
- The person with dementia has been admitted (either planned/unplanned) to Gloucestershire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust
- The carer is providing a significant level of care.
- Admiral Nurse can also be called for support on wards to:
- Enhance colleagues' knowledge and experience of working with family carers and people with dementia through supervision and supportive education
- Promote and implement best practice
