

Safeguarding for Educational Settings 2021/2022

To ensure all children attending school/educational settings are safe from harm by ensuring that all staff are appropriately trained. To ensure that schools and educational settings are Ofsted compliant for safeguarding.



Core Services – available without purchase

- Allegations Management
- Critical Incident Support (e.g. suicide or sudden death of a child and issues involving the media)
- Facilitating Schools/settings in order to aid compliance with Section 175/157 of the Education Act 2002 (sending out of the Section 175 Audit annually and collating trends etc. but not supporting the school with their action plan)
- Access to Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership website and alerts/newsletters

Traded Services

- Single agency whole school staff training in safeguarding (all staff every 3 years)
 - Inter-Agency Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) training (up to 5 staff in each setting every 2 years)
 - Support and Guidance on Single Central Record, training, changes to legislation
 - A half day face to face setting visit to assist with the Section 175/157 Audit, to support self-evaluation and offer assistance and recommendation to ensure compliance with Ofsted expectations
 - Access to regular DSL Support Hubs, webinars, bulletins/updates concerning local and national developments
 - Access to disseminated learning from Safeguarding and Child Death Reviews
 - Access to research, policy development or guidance produced by the Education and Learning Forum of the Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership (GSCP)
 - Information and guidance on safeguarding recruitment issues and the Disclosure and Barring Service
 - Virtual drop-in sessions held to assist with Single Central Record queries
 - In the Net – theatre performance (aimed at Year 4)
 - Chelsea’s Story – theatre performance (aimed at Year 8)
 - Access to a suite of Child Protection e-learning training courses
