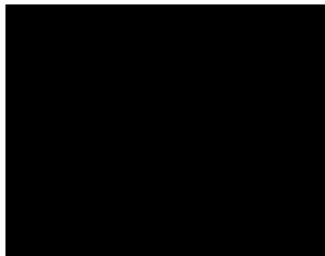

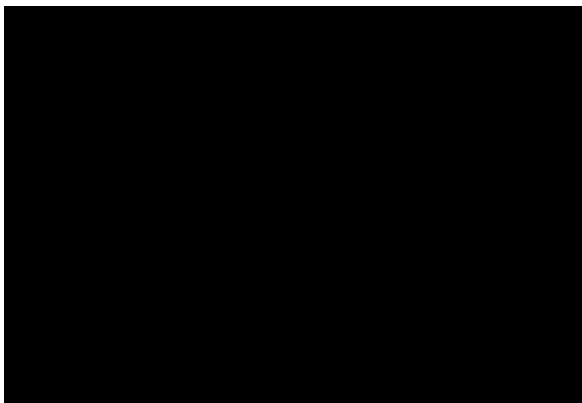

Proposed Diversion of HBW 26

I write with reference to the proposed diversion of a short section HBW 26.
[Redacted] provide supply & maintenance of electronic security systems for [Redacted] & her family.

[Redacted] dog was recently attacked in her own yard by a walker's dog that was off the lead and completely out of control - it charged at her and her dog repeatedly. I was requested to view and download the CCTV footage of the incident for [Redacted] to give to the police.
