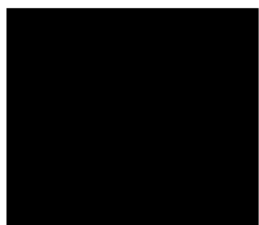

**Public Footpath HBW26 Tagmoor Hollow Diversion Order 2020**

My wife and I are members of the same walking group as [REDACTED] and have been for a significant number of years now. Therefore we are very aware of the significant and important footpath system in the Cotswolds. However we would like to support [REDACTED] in her attempt to move a footpath that passes through her yard to a more suitable location.

There is no intention here to remove a footpath or part of it, but just to make a small detour to avoid having the footpath pass through a working farm yard and the possibility of walkers encountering animals such as horses, dogs and farm animals.
