MODIFICATION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981  
GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH HBW 26) (PARISH OF BOURTON ON THE WATER)  
DIVERSION ORDER 2020

The above Order made on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 if confirmed, will divert the length of public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to a line as described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

A copy of the Order and map attached to the Order (the "Order Map") may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG and Cotswold District Council, Trinity Road, Cirencester, Glos, GL7 1PX. Copies of the Order and Order Map may be obtained free of charge (please quote reference HBW/26/TH).

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Principal Rights of Way Officer, Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG not later than 15<sup>th</sup> October 2020. Please state the grounds on which they are made. (Please quote reference HBW/26/TH).

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Gloucestershire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order. In submitting an objection it should be noted that the personal data and correspondence relating to any objection will be passed to Gloucestershire County Council in order that they can contact you directly to address the issues raised. If any person does not wish personal data to be forwarded to the Council, they should state why when submitting the objection and the Secretary of State will copy the representations to the Council with the name and address removed and if there is to be a local Public Inquiry, the representations will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.

**SCHEDULE**

Part 1

Description of Path to be extinguished

That length of public footpath numbered HBW 26 in the Parish of Bourton on the Water that commences at a point marked A at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP1703/1985 on the map attached to the order 90 metres south west of Tagmoor Hollow and proceeds in a generally north north easterly direction for 179

metres to its junction with footpath HBW 27 at a point marked B on the said map at OSGR SP 1706/2002 and being shown by a bold continuous line and of undefined width.

Part 2  
Description of Site of new Path or Way

A length of public footpath that commences at the said point A on the Order Map then extends in a north easterly direction for 49 metres to a point marked C at OSGR SP 1707/1989 and then continues in a north easterly direction for 49 metres to a point marked D at OSGR SP 1711/1992 at the junction with road number 50575 known as Marshmouth Lane and being shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map and having a width of 3 metres between points A and C and a width of 2 metres between points C and D.
