**(PUBLIC FOOTPATH GNE 208) (PARISH OF NEWENT)
EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020**

The above Order made on 15th December 2020 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed, will extinguish the length of public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule.

A copy of the Order and map attached to the Order (the "Order Map") may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG and Forest of Dean District Council, High Street, Coleford, Glos, GL16 8HG. Copies of the Order and Order Map may be obtained free of charge (please quote reference GNE/208/TH).

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Principal Public Rights of Way Officer, Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG not later than 11th February 2021. Please state the grounds on which they are made. (Please quote reference GNE/208/TH).

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Gloucestershire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections that have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order. In submitting an objection it should be noted that the personal data and correspondence relating to any objection will be passed to Gloucestershire County Council in order that they can contact you directly to address the issues raised. If any person does not wish personal data to be forwarded to the Council, they should state why when submitting the objection and the Secretary of State will copy the representations to the Council with the name and address removed and if there is to be a local Public Inquiry, the representations will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.

SCHEDULE

Part 1

Description of Path to be Extinguished

That length of public footpath numbered GNE 208 in the Parish of Newent that commences a point marked D on the map attached to the order at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 7206/2426 215 metres west of The Moat and continues

in an easterly direction for 110 metres and then in a south easterly direction for 16 metres and then in an easterly direction for 17 metres to a point marked B on the said map at OSGR SO 7220/2425 82 metres west of The Moat and being shown by a bold continuous line and with a width of 1.5 metres measured from a point 0.5 metres from the nearest edge or adjacent boundary.
