The County Council must also always refer the decision of whether the land which is the subject of the application is to be registered as a Town or Village Green to a Committee and when this happens; the contents of this Evidence Questionnaire (excluding your personal details) may be available on the County Council's website, within the committee papers.

The process by which a new Town or Village Green is determined is public, therefore, the County Council will also have to disclose your Evidence Questionnaire as part of the application process and you should be aware this information will become part of public domain.
