Mathtastics in the Early Years - Ben Kingston-Hughes


Ben is an Early Years and Child Development subject expert and a published author for this sector.

Sensory Integration Occupational Therapy (SIOT L1)

At the request of providers we have organised additional Sensory Integration Occupational Therapy training sessions designed to stimulate learning for all children. NEW! Sensory Integration Occupational Therapy Training (SIOT Level 2) – Practical Strategies: sensory processing in the Early Years

Following on from the Level 1 course, these sessions explore how sensory differences in children can significantly impact their daily functioning, leading to difficulties in learning, social interaction, focus, emotional regulation, sleep, transitions and managing adult led expectations as well as impacting their physical abilities such as coordination, balance, and body awareness.

Also led by Anthea Bailey from Bravo OT this is an experiential and skills development session for practitioners to support children with sensory processing differences and participants will learn how to use sensory regulation strategies and how to create a sensory friendly space and calming corners. Get ready to explore and have fun!

Total Communication Training in the Early Years

This training is provided in house at your setting.

Exciting news to all providers! You can now book Total Communication in the Early Years through GCC+. To do this you will need to log into your setting's GCC+ account. Go to the **search bar** on the **home page**, and type in Total Communications and **press the search key**. You will then see the link for the Total Communications for you to book. (**Please note** -

if you search in the 'training section' or the 'services' section, you won't find it. It must be searched for in the home page search and the search key pressed). NB - If you just press enter, it won't find it.

The training will help your staff to develop their skills by exploring:

- How children develop their communication skills
- How to provide good quality adult:child interactions
- How to provide a communication friendly environment, using a range of communication methods including signs
- Why and how to use visuals

This session will also enable you to add resources to your practitioner communication tool kit and each delegate will receive a certificate for their CPD.
