

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CLOSURE**  
**PUBLIC FOOTPATHS CWE 32, CWE 6, CWE 7 (WOTTON UNDER EDGE TOWN)**  
**(STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2024**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of the footpaths as detailed in the Schedule below ("the Footpaths") is satisfied that use of the Footpaths should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties next to the Footpaths no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Footpaths;
2. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Footpaths;
3. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Footpaths;
4. The Footpaths fall within the Town of Wotton Under Edge in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the **6<sup>th</sup> day of January Two Thousand and Twenty-Five** and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months, after this time it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension.
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Closure Public Footpaths CWE 32, CWE6, CWE7 (Wotton Under Edge Town) (Stroud District) Order 2024".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Footpaths or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
