Funding Rates

This year, DfE have asked all LA's to publish their funding rates for 2025/26 by 28 February. Our proposed rates were considered by the Schools Forum group on Thursday 16 January and will be presented at the Cabinet meeting on 29 January. With this date in mind and if Cabinet accept our proposals, we are planning to issue our consultation to the Early Years sector by 31 January. The consultation will only be open for a week to allow us enough time to analyse the feedback and publish the

rates on time. Please make a note of this date and look out for the consultation.

Working Parents Entitlement - Eligibility Codes

Parents have to reconfirm their eligibility codes every 3 months in their gov.uk childcare accounts. Codes must be valid on the following dates to be eligible in the relevant terms:

31st August = for the Autumn term

31st December = for the Spring term

31st March = for the Summer term

These are also the dates by which that codes must be applied for. If these deadline dates are missed, we can only consider backdating codes in exceptional circumstances.

Providers must validate the eligibility code in the Nursery Funding Portal. This allows all providers to make instant checks for code validity and these details are fed from the DfE's Eligibility Checking Service (ECS). When validating new codes, the text will now confirm the term in which extended hours can first be claimed:

Code found - please check eligible dates

01-Sep-2024 Autumn Term is the earliest start date for working families entitlement

This eligibility code is valid from 12-Jul-2024 to 08-Feb-2025, with a grace period to 31-Mar-2025

The parent or carer must confirm the eligibility code provided by HMRC in order to retain their working families entitlement eligibility between 11-Jan-2025 and 08-Feb-2025

HMRC will notify the parent or carer when they need to reconfirm their eligibility every 3 months.

The “Review previous checks” table may show a result of “Not known” for codes that are not valid in the current term. The “Check status” result of “Eligible” relates to the parents working position confirming that they will be eligible once the code is valid in the correct term:

If there is no “EH” in the “Funding” column on your task, you will not be able to claim the extended hours. If the “EH” is red, you will also not be able to claim as the code has now expired:

Thereafter, Gloucestershire County Council is responsible for notifying a provider where a parent has fallen out of eligibility and inform them of the grace period end date. This information can be found on the “Expiration Dashboard” within the Nursery Funding Portal. We ask all providers to use this tool to support their parents with additional reminders to reconfirm their codes, which also protects your income.

Further details regarding eligibility codes and their Grace Periods can be found in Section 5 & 6 of the Local Provider Agreement.
