

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(30 & 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS)
(VARIOUS ROADS IN THE VICINITY OF THE A46 SHURDINGTON ROAD)
(VARIOUS PARISHES)
(CHELTENHAM BOROUGH AND TEWKESBURY BOROUGH)
ORDER 2026**

The Gloucestershire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on **the 2026** and may be cited as the “GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30 & 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE VICINITY OF THE A46 SHURDINGTON ROAD) (VARIOUS PARISHES) (CHELTENHAM BOROUGH AND TEWKESBURY BOROUGH) ORDER 2026”.

(ii) This Order affects roads within the Town of Cheltenham and the Parish of Leckhampton with Warden Hill in the Cheltenham Borough and within the Parishes of Shurdington & Badgeworth in the Tewkesbury Borough all located within the County of Gloucestershire.

2. In this Order –

“Motor Vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 MPH.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following Orders are revoked in full:
 - (i) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (UP HATHERLEY WAY, UP HATHERLEY) (40 m.p.h) SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1988
 - (ii) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A46 SHURDINGTON ROAD, CHELTENHAM) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1993
 - (iii) GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A46 SHURDINGTON) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003

7. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following part of the GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS PARISHES WITHIN THE CHELTENHAM BOROUGH,

TEWKESBURY BOROUGH AND THE STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2004 is hereby revoked:

Schedule Part II – 40mph Speed Limit

On the Road known as the A46	From a point 160 metres south west of its junction with the 40597 (Highwood Avenue) to a point 250 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of the 3/194 (Leckhampton Lane)
