Early Years Funded Entitlements - Spring Term 2026

Children become eligible for the funded entitlement from the term after they reach the relevant age and up until statutory school age, which is the term after their 5th birthday. The table below confirms when a child is

eligible to receive funding in the Spring term:

Best Start in Life Webinar for Practitioners

As part of its [Giving every child the best start in life](#) strategy, the Government has set a national target that by 2028 at least 75% of children should be ready to start year 1 ready to learn, as measured by the Early Years Foundation Stage assessment (EYFS).

Gloucestershire has been set a GLD target of 77.2% and 60% for children in receipt of Free School Meals.

Each LA has been awarded 3 years funding to support the increase of our GLD.

Our current priorities are -

- By January 2026 we need to have identified a Best Start Family Hub site.
- By end of March 2026 we need to identify which parenting and home learning environment training programmes will be delivered in Gloucestershire to support 3 & 4 year olds.
- From April 2026 we need to start the delivery of the parenting and home learning programmes.

We would like to invite you to attend a webinar on Wednesday 21 January 2026 10-12 where we will provide information about the Best Start Family Hub funding and the programmes we have selected to deliver across Gloucestershire.

Early Years Inclusion Champion Award

We are excited to announce the launch of our Early Years Inclusion Champion Award!

This award will acknowledge and celebrate Early Years Providers that deliver high quality inclusive practice to all children, including those with SEND.

We know that many of you are already doing this, and we would therefore encourage you to sign up to showcase your practice and receive recognition and financial reward.

To successfully gain the award, you must demonstrate that your setting meets the standards of inclusion as set out on the platform. There is no time limit on completion so you can work through this at your own pace.

All applications will be quality assured by the Early Years Inclusion Team and additional support/advice is available from this team throughout your journey. On successful completion, the award is valid for 3 years.

You should consider re-applying for this award after two years to ensure continuous Champion status.

Autumn term amendment payment – Early Years Entitlements

We need to inform you of an IT issue that has affected your autumn term amendment payment.

For children who became eligible for EYPP after the September actual payment, the rate applied is higher than the standard rate. To meet the published payment date, we were unable to correct the effected children in time.

After reviewing options, we have decided to process all the current claims.

However, this will result in an overpayment, which will be recovered from either your spring term funding or the autumn term deprivation payment, depending on which one is higher.

We believe this approach minimises disruption to you all, particularly at this time of year.

We will notify all affected providers of the estimated amount to be deducted within the next few days.

We will also issue a reminder of the reclaim amount before the next EY payment due in the New Year.

We apologise for any inconvenience and assure you that all possible solutions have been considered.

Total Communication Training in the Early Years - This training is provided in house at your setting.

You can now book Total Communication in the Early Years through GCC+. To do this you will need to log into your setting's GCC+ account. Go to the **search bar** on the **home page**, and type in Total Communications and **press the search key**.

You will then see the link for the Total Communications for you to book.

(Please note – if you search in the ‘training section’ or the ‘services’

section, you won't find it. It must be searched for in the home page search and the search key pressed). NB - If you just press enter, it won't find it.

Once you have booked and checked out your training, you will be contacted by an EY Inclusion Advisor to arrange the date and time for the delivery of your course. If you have not heard from us within 2 weeks, please contact the EY Admin Team: eyservice@gloucestershire.gov.uk.
