## What is Family Link Plus?

Families in Gloucestershire caring for their disabled child benefit from short breaks. Not only for the family to take a breather and attend to important tasks, but also for the children to have access to exciting opportunities and activities they might otherwise have missed out on.

**FAMILY LINK PLUS** has been providing this valued service for children and young people aged 0-18 for over 25 years in Gloucestershire. It sits within fostering in Children's Services and is fully regulated.

## What do we mean by short breaks?

Short breaks come in all shapes and sizes! They take place within the child's home, in your own home, or in the local community and vary in duration and activity.

- **Day care** – regular breaks that range from an hour, to several hours per month. This can be during the week, at weekends, during school holidays or term time.
- **Overnight stays** – these take place at your home and range from one to several nights per month.
- **Community-based outings** – educational and recreational activities in a wide variety of locations across Gloucestershire.

These breaks help family carers to continue to care for their child, and they support the children's social and emotional development through new experiences, friendships, and skills.



## Who can access Family Link Plus short breaks?

**Family Link Plus** is available for children referred to us by the Disabled Children's Teams, or from the wider Children's Services. The children who meet the **Family Link Plus** criteria will generally have one or more of the following:

- Physical or sensory disabilities
- Profound or multiple learning disabilities
- Complex medical or health care needs
- Behaviours of concern

## Would you make a good Family Link Plus carer?

The kind of person we are looking for can say yes to these questions:

- Have a positive attitude
- Like spending time with children
- Enjoy new experiences and learning
- Have patience and commitment

If you have experience of caring for a disabled child or vulnerable adults, you might have valuable skills that will help you understand the needs of our children. ## What support is offered to Family Link Plus Carers?

- Thorough assessment process including extensive training
- Competitive hourly rates of pay
- Travel expenses
- Ongoing professional support and supervision from your named supervising social worker
- Family Support Worker to support you with the care needs of the children
- 24-hour support, including out of hours
- Regular support meetings with other carers
- Carer appreciation and engagement events
- Carer Membership to The Fostering Network
- Access to a Fostering buddy during your assessment and beyond
- Refer a Friend – £500 paid to you in vouchers for any friend or family member who is approved as a Foster Carer
- Access to 'Fostering Champions' – experienced foster carers who support new carers at every step of the journey
