## BESPOKE ADVISER SUPPORT SESSIONS

Through effective support and challenge, advisers can work with your school to help you secure an ambitious vision, accurate self-evaluation and a clear direction for sustained, autonomous improvement. Activities could include:

## Headteacher network

A package of three meetings for headteachers spread across the year. This network provides an opportunity: to keep up to date with local and national guidance; to hear inputs from local and national experts; to share examples of successful practice and the findings of research; and for discussion, reflection, collaboration and networking around local priorities.

The autumn and summer meetings will be longer, in-person, sessions with an invitation for the chair of governors/trustees, or a nominated representative of the governing board, to attend alongside the headteacher. The spring meeting will be held on TEAMS, recognising different methods of audience engagement and providing access to national speakers not able to attend in-person.

## Governor network

A package of three virtual meetings for governors and trustees, spread across the year. This network will provide key local and national updates, and input from relevant keynote speakers, to support governors/trustees to undertake their role effectively. These meetings will be a mix of two governor/trustee-only and one joint event with headteachers.

## Virtual staff development sessions

A suite of pre-recorded staff development sessions on high profile topics to support your school's CPD programme. Each 1-hour session is delivered by an expert in the focus area and can be used for whole staff development or by individuals/groups, as appropriate. We will be consulting with schools about the topics to cover in 2025-26.

## SUBJECT LEADER NETWORKS

All our subject leader networks are held in person to maximise the opportunity for leaders to work with other leaders from across the county.

### Primary core subjects

three full-day meetings across the year:

### Secondary

two full-day meetings and one half-day meeting across the year:

- English
- Mathematics
- Science

For both experienced and new subject leaders, each network provides an opportunity:

- to build subject knowledge and confidence in leading the subject in your school
- to support you in developing your school's curriculum
- to keep up to date with local and national guidance
- to hear inputs from local experts
- to share examples of successful practice and the findings of research
- for discussion, reflection, collaboration and networking

All networks are led by subject specialists who collaborate closely with relevant subject hubs and draw on national expertise to ensure meetings are relevant and up to date.

## Headteacher recruitment

Support for governors/trustees recruiting a new or interim headteacher includes:

- Checklists and guidance
- Administrative support: placing advert provided; sending recruitment information to applicants; informing shortlisted/not shortlisted applicants; producing interview programme and distributing to candidates; requesting references
- Adviser can meet governors to explain the recruitment process and share example documents
- Governor trainer available to support with visioning and preparation of job description, person specification and advert
- Adviser to support shortlisting meeting
- Adviser to support with planning activities for interview programme and production of interview activity task sheets and feedback sheets
- Adviser to support day(s) of interview
- Adviser to de-brief unsuccessful candidates

## New headteacher induction programme

A rolling programme of support for new and acting primary headteachers during their first year in post, starting at whatever time of year they take up post. The programme includes six full-day in-person meetings (one per half-term): introductions to, and updates from, a variety of LA teams; generic/topical updates and information; and leadership development.
