AN AGREEMENT ON THE TERMS CONTAINED THEREIN OR AT ALL

THIS AGREEMENT is made the day of 2010

BETWEEN

1. ("the Owner")
2. ("the Developer")
3. ("the Bondsman")
4. GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL of Shire Hall in the
City of Gloucester ("the Council")

WHEREAS:

- (1) The Owner is [the Registered Proprietor of the Land with freehold
Title Absolute under Title Number GR at H.M. Land
Registry][seised in fee simple absolute in possession] subject
only to [the entries on the registers therein][]
- (2) [By the Contract the Developer agreed to purchase the Land from
the Owner upon the terms and conditions therein mentioned]
- (3) [By the Legal Charge the Owner charged the Land to the
Chargee to secure repayment to the Chargee of the monies
therein mentioned]
- (4) The Owner proposes to carry out the Development on the Land
- (5) The Council is

- (a) a Local Planning Authority as defined in the Act and the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of planning obligations imposed pursuant to the provisions of Section 106 of the Act and
- (b) **the Highway Authority for Gloucestershire and is of the opinion that the obligations herein are necessary to address the consequences of the development**
- (c) satisfied that entry into this Agreement is of benefit to the public

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

Definitions and Interpretation

1.(a) It is hereby agreed by the parties that in this Agreement the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

'First Occupied'	means the date when either the Business Area becomes liable for Business Rates or the Residential Area becomes liable for Council Tax or any replacement of either and 'First Occupation' shall be construed accordingly
'the Land'	means the land situate at Gloucestershire and shown for the

['the Legal Charge'	means a charge made the between the Owner (1) and the Chargee (2)]
Occupier	means any organisation or sole trader occupying business premises on the land
'Modal Share Target'	means the target modal share in the Travel Plan
'the Permission'	means planning consent granted pursuant to the Application
'the Plan'	means the plan annexed hereto
'the Residential Area'	means that part of the Development with Residential Dwellings constructed thereon
'Residential Dwelling	means any dwelling constructed on the Land
'the Residential Travel Plan'	means a Travel Plan in connection with the Residential Area
'the Residential Travel Plan	means the sum of Twenty Five Thousand
Deposit'	Pounds (£25,000)
'the Residential Travel Plan Payment'	means the sum of Twelve Thousand Pounds (£12,000)

‘the Travel Plan’ means a plan to deliver a modal shift away from the private car in favour of public transport and other means of travel including walking and cycling in respect of the Land and drawn up in accordance with the Travel Plan Framework as approved in writing by the Director in accordance with Clause 4(b) hereof and the definition includes any amendment or variation of the same pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement

‘Travel Plan Co-ordinator’ means a person or organisation appointed at the expense of the Owner and approved in writing by the Council to co-ordinate and implement either the Residential Travel Plan and/or the Business Travel Plan

‘the Travel Plan Framework’ means as set out in the First Schedule hereto

‘Travel Plan Monitoring Fee’ means the sum of Twenty Thousand Pounds (£20,000) to be used by the Council for the purpose of monitoring the Travel Plans

'the Residential Travel Plan' means a plan to deliver a modal shift away from the private car in favour of public transport and other means of travel including walking and cycling to and from the Residential Area and drawn up in accordance with the Travel Plan Framework and as approved in writing by the Director in accordance with Clause 4(b) hereof and the definition includes any amendment or variation of the same pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement

'the Travel Plan Deposit' means the sum of Pounds (£)

'the Travel Plan Framework' means as set out in the First Schedule hereto

- (b) The Development shall be deemed to be commenced on the Commencement Date
- (c) Where the context so admits
 - (i) words of the masculine gender shall incorporate the

feminine gender and words of the singular shall include the plural and vice versa [and where there is more than one covenantor all obligations of such covenantors shall be joint and several]

- (ii) where reference is made to a statutory provision this includes all prior and subsequent enactments amendments and modifications relating to that provision and any sub-ordinate legislation made under it
- (d) The expressions "the Council" "the Owner" "the Developer" and "the Bondsman" shall include their respective successors in title and assigns
- (e) All headings in this Agreement are for ease of reference only and are not part of the Agreement nor are they intended to be used as a guide to its interpretation
- (f) All payments in accordance with the terms of this Agreement shall be exclusive of any VAT payable in respect thereof

Statutory Provisions

- 2. The Owner the Developer and the Council hereby agree that
 - (a) the obligations on the part of the Owner hereinafter contained are planning obligations imposed pursuant to the provisions of Section 106 of the Act which are enforceable by the Council and
 - (b) inter alia this is an Agreement pursuant to Section 278 of the Highways Act 1980

[Contract

- 3.(a) The Owner hereby agrees with the Council that it concurs with the undertaking by the Developer of the obligations herein contained to the intent that [the Land] shall be subject in all respects to the terms conditions and obligations hereof
- (b) The Developer hereby agrees with the Council that its rights under the Contract shall be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions hereof and concurs with the giving by the Owner of the covenants and obligations on its part herein contained]

[Legal Charge

4. the Chargee hereby concurs with the giving by the [Developer][Owner] of the obligations in relation to the Land herein contained to the intent that the security created by the Legal Charge shall be subject in all respects to the terms conditions and obligations hereof]

The Travel Plan

5. The parties hereby agree and covenant with the other that:
- (a) prior to First Occupation the Owner will submit to the Director:-
- (i) the Business Travel Plan; and
 - (ii) the Residential Travel Plan
- both for his written approval (such approval not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed) to include the Travel Plan Targets and set at intervals of:-
- (aa) three years;
 - (bb) five years; and
 - (cc) ten years

- all timed from the date on which []
- (b) the Director shall provide his written comments on the documents submitted in accordance with sub-clause (a) of this Clause within 28 days of receipt of the same and confirm in so doing that it is approved (with or without amendment) or not approved and in the absence of a response in that period the document in question shall be deemed approved
 - (c) prior to the First Occupation the Owner shall appoint the Travel Plan Co-ordinator and provide the name and contact details of the appointed person to the Council in writing within seven (7) days of such appointment
 - (d) within one calendar month of a change of the Travel Plan Co-ordinator the Owner shall notify the Council in writing of that change and provide the Council with the name and contact details of the new Travel Plan Co-ordinator
 - (e) the Owner shall not occupy or allow or permit the occupation of any part of the Development prior to the implementation of those measures identified in the Travel Plan as capable of being implemented at that time (at the absolute discretion of the Director)
 - (f) the Owner shall fully implement the measures identified in the Travel Plan in accordance with the Implementation Timetable contained therein and shall maintain the same for as long as any part of the Development is occupied

- (g) the Owner shall use all reasonable endeavours (including funding of the Travel Plan) to achieve the Modal Share Target
- (h) the Owner shall implement monitor and review the Travel Plan at its own cost in accordance with the monitoring strategy as approved and shall procure that all Owners and/or Occupiers of the Business Area shall implement the same and co-ordinate with the Travel Plan Co-ordinator to enable him to liaise with the Director
- (i) the Council hereby agrees with the Owner that within twenty eight (28) days of receiving (to the Director's satisfaction) sufficient information to identify the Permission together with such evidence as the Director shall reasonably require of the achievement of each of the Travel Plan Targets the Director will repay to the Owner a proportion of the Business Travel Plan Deposit calculated in accordance with the table set out in the Second Schedule hereto together with interest on the amounts repaid at the Public Works Loan Board 2 to 3 year rate from time to time in force such rate being calculated on a daily basis from the date of payment until the date of repayment (net of tax if such deduction is required by the guidance in respect thereof issued by Her Majesty's Government at the date of such refund)

Residential Travel Plan

9. The Council hereto hereby agrees that if the Owner at the same time as submitting the Residential Travel Plan for written approval in

accordance with Clause [8] also serves written notice on the Council that it shall:-

- (a) fully implement the measures identified in the Residential Travel Plan in accordance with the Implementation Timetable contained therein and shall maintain the same for as long as any part of the Development is occupied; and
- (b) use all reasonable endeavours (including funding of the Residential Travel Plan) to achieve the Modal Share Target; and
- (c) implement monitor and review the Residential Travel Plan at its own cost in accordance with the monitoring strategy as approved

then the Council will:-

- (i) repay to the Owner the Residential Travel Plan Payment within twenty eight (28) days of receipt of the notice
- (ii) within twenty eight (28) days of receiving (to the Director's satisfaction) sufficient information to identify the Permission together with such evidence as the Director shall reasonably require of the achievement of each of the Residential Travel Plan Targets the Director will repay to the Owner a proportion of the Residential Travel Plan Deposit calculated in accordance with the table set out in the Third Schedule hereto together with interest on the amount repaid at the Public Works Loan Board 2 to 3 year rate from time to time in force such rate being calculated on a daily basis from the date of payment until the date of repayment (net of tax if such deduction is required by the

guidance in respect thereof issued by Her Majesty's Government
at the date of such refund)

Costs

6. The Owner hereby agrees with the Council that it will upon the execution hereof pay

(a) the Council's legal charges in the sum of (£)

Notices

7. Any notice to the Owner under this Agreement shall be in writing signed by the Director of Law and Administration for the time being of the Council unless otherwise herein provided and shall be deemed to be sufficiently served if sent to it by registered or recorded delivery post in the case of the Owner at its registered office and in the case of the Owner at the address stated at the beginning of this Agreement and any notice to the Council under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently served if sent by registered or recorded delivery post to the Council addressed to the Director of Law and Administration Gloucestershire County Council Shire Hall Gloucester

Non-Waiver

8. It is hereby agreed by the parties hereto that failure by the Council or the Director at any time to enforce the provisions of this Agreement or to require performance strictly or otherwise by the Owner of any of the conditions covenants agreements or obligations of this Agreement or any failure or delay by the Council or the Director to exercise any act right or remedy shall not be construed as a waiver of or as creating an estoppel in connection with any such condition covenant agreement or obligation and shall not affect the validity of this Agreement or any part thereof or the right of the Council to enforce any provision

General

9. The parties hereby agree that
- (a) this Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties in respect of the Permission and
 - (b) this Agreement supersedes and replaces all previous negotiations whether oral or written and
 - (c) none of the parties has relied on any express or implied statement warranty representation or undertaking given by or on behalf of another and no collateral agreement exists between the parties and
 - (d) nothing herein contained excludes the liability of any of the parties in relation to fraud

Consent to Registration and SDLT

10. The Owner hereby consents to the registration of this Deed as a Local Land Charge and a Notice on Title Number GR

11. Entry into this Deed does not constitute a transaction for a chargeable consideration for which Stamp Duty Land Tax is required and thus the Council hereby certifies that a Land Transaction Return is not applicable in accordance with Section 79(3) of the Finance Act 2003 Contract (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999

12. It is not intended that any third party shall have a right to enforce the terms of this Agreement pursuant to the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 even if the terms are expressed to be for their benefit and nor shall any such third party have a right of veto over any future variations of this Agreement

Effect of invalidity illegality or enforceability

13. If any provision in this Agreement shall be held to be invalid illegal or unenforceable the validity legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof shall not in any way be deemed thereby to be affected or impaired

Warranty

14. The Owner hereby warrants to the County Council that they have not leased mortgaged charged or otherwise created any interest in the Land at the date of this Agreement
