

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(BATH ROAD, B4008) (PARISHES OF HARESFIELD AND STANDISH)
(STROUD DISTRICT)
ORDER 2026**

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on **the 2026** and may be cited as the "GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BATH ROAD, B4008) (PARISHES OF HARESFIELD AND STANDISH) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2026".

(ii) This Order affects a road within the Parishes of Haresfield & Standish within the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along the length of road described in The Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following part of the GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BATH ROAD A430/A38/B4008) (PARISHES OF HARDWICKE, HUNTS GROVE, HARESFIELD AND STANDISH) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2023 is hereby revoked:

The Schedule – 50mph Speed Limit to be introduced

Bath Road (B4008)	From its junction with Mount Farm Lane (401322) in a south-easterly direction to a point approximately 310 metres north of its junction with The Lane to Warren Farm (501136) to join up with the existing 50mph speed limit.
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The Schedule - 40mph Speed Limit

Road Name & Number	Description
Bath Road (B4008)	From its junction with Mount Farm Lane (41322) in a southerly direction to a point approximately 350m north of its junction with the Lane to Warren Farm (51136) to join up with the existing 50mph speed limit.
