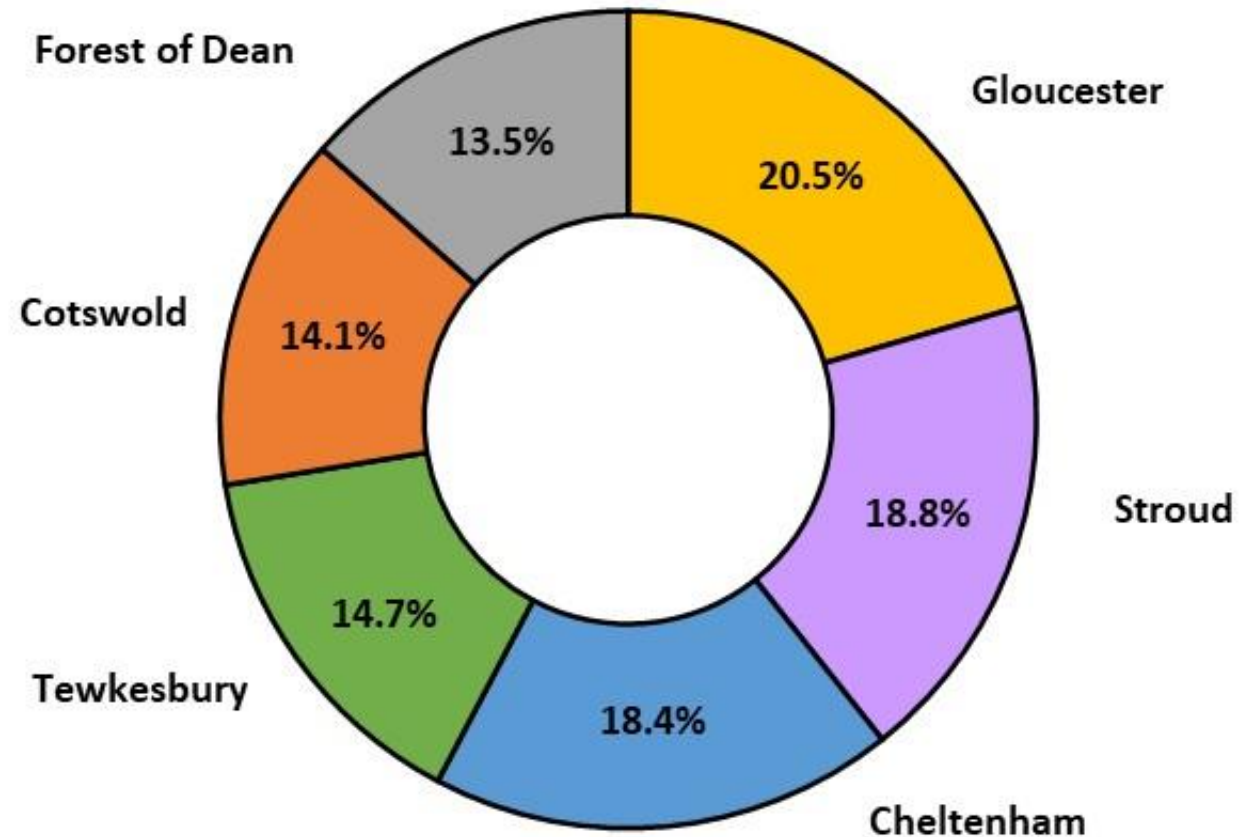

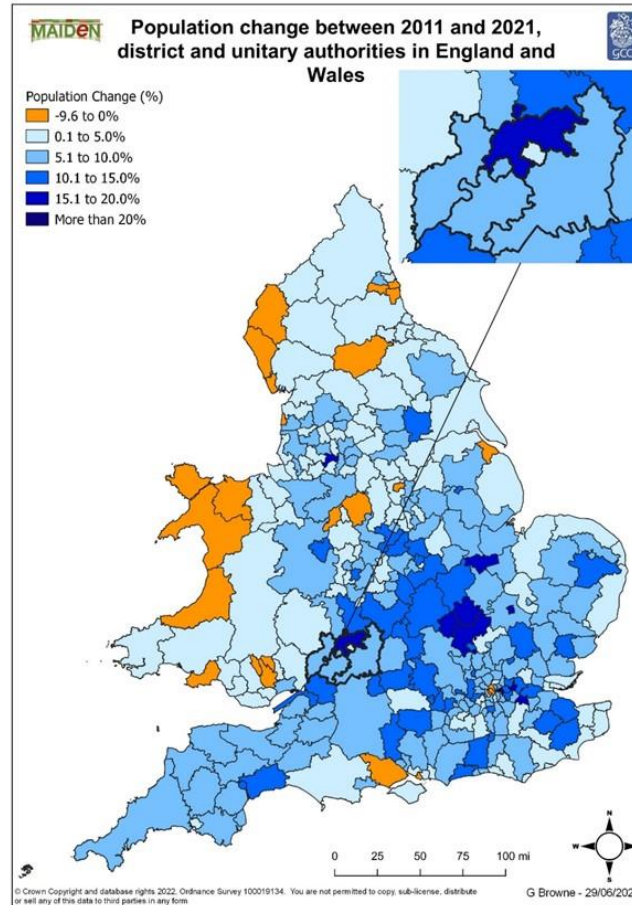

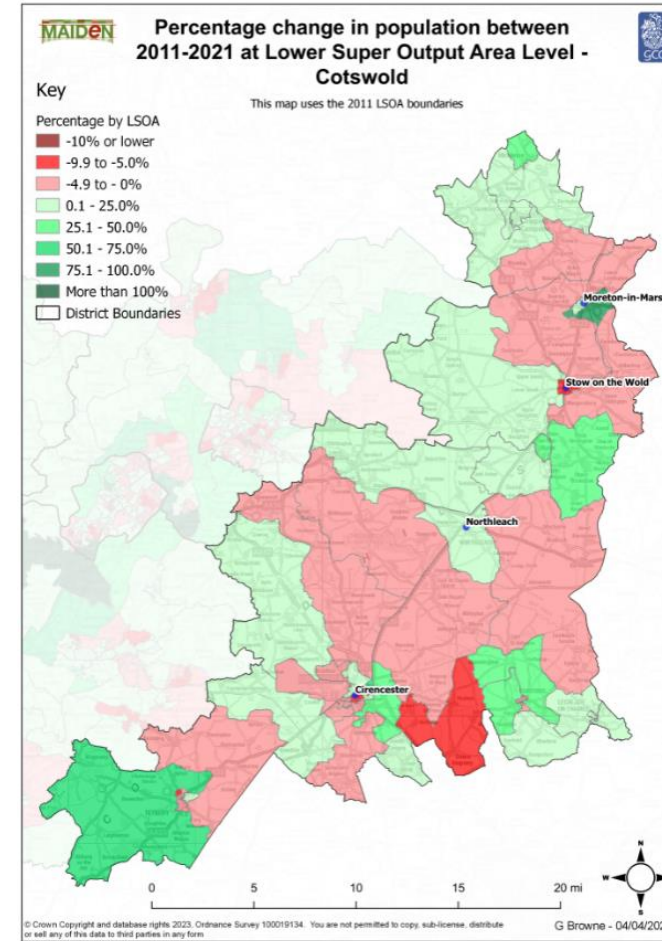

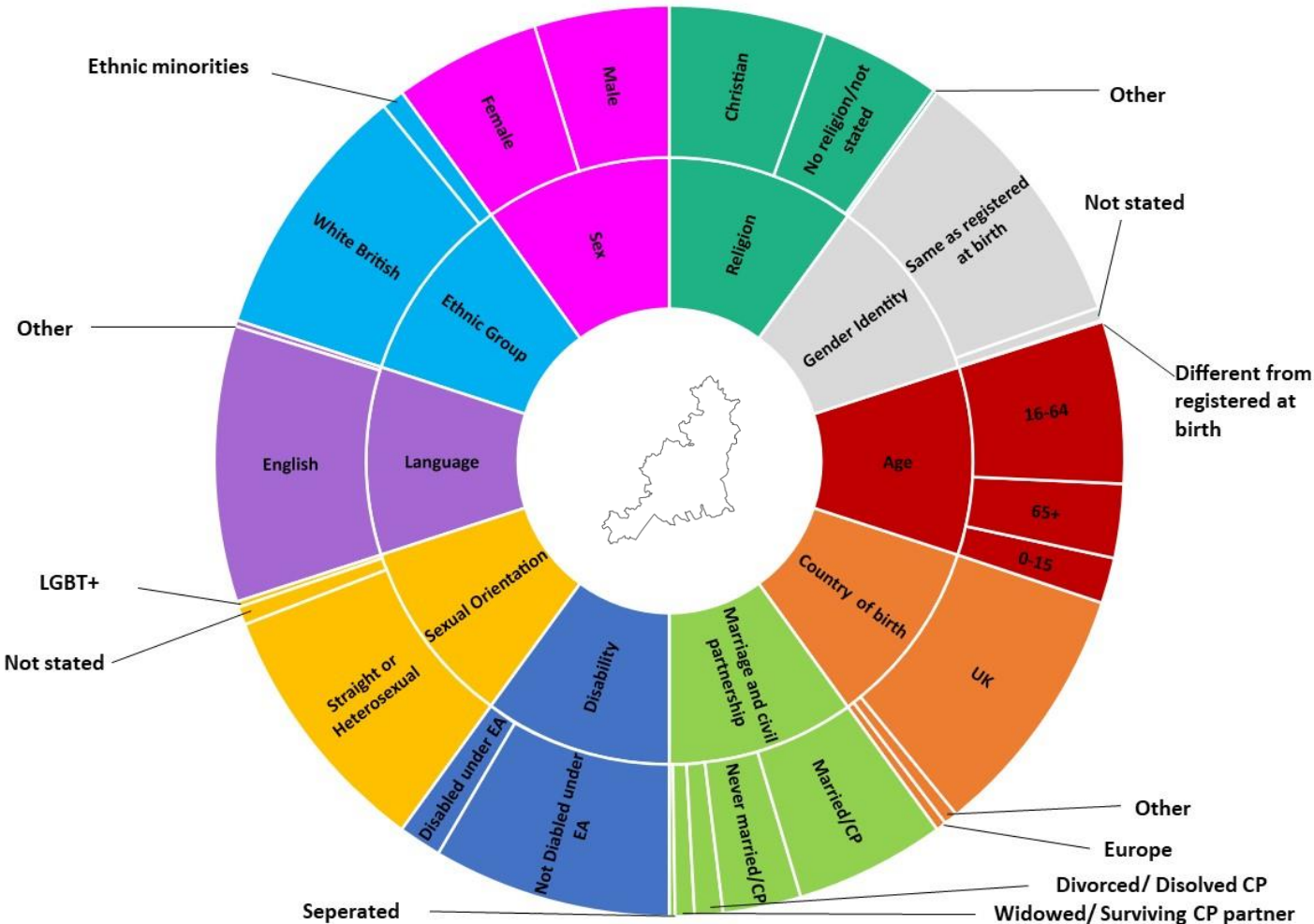

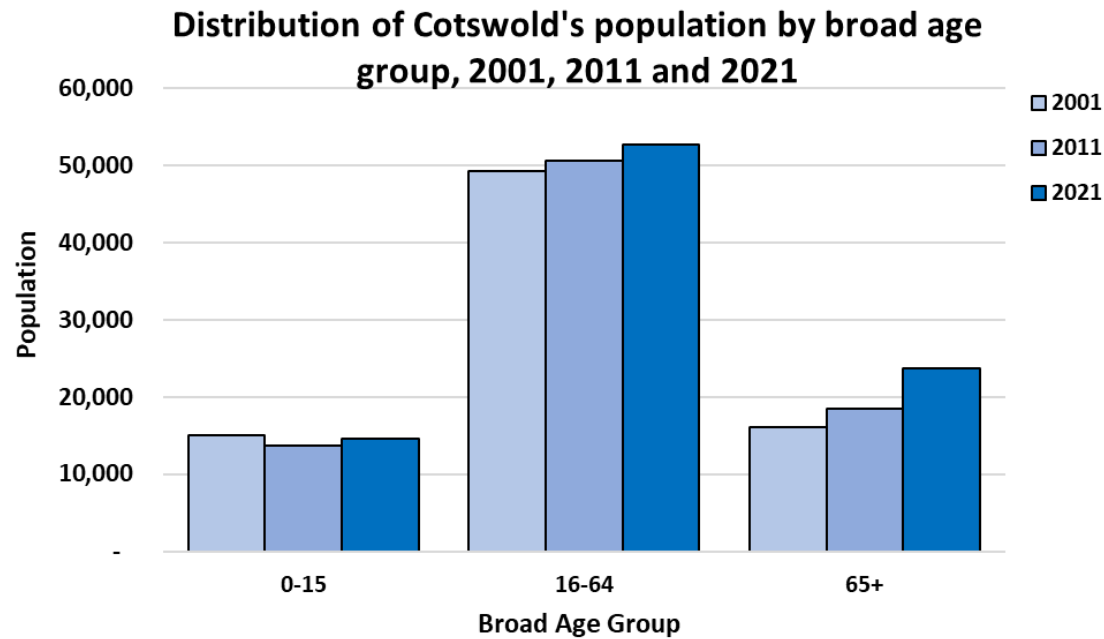

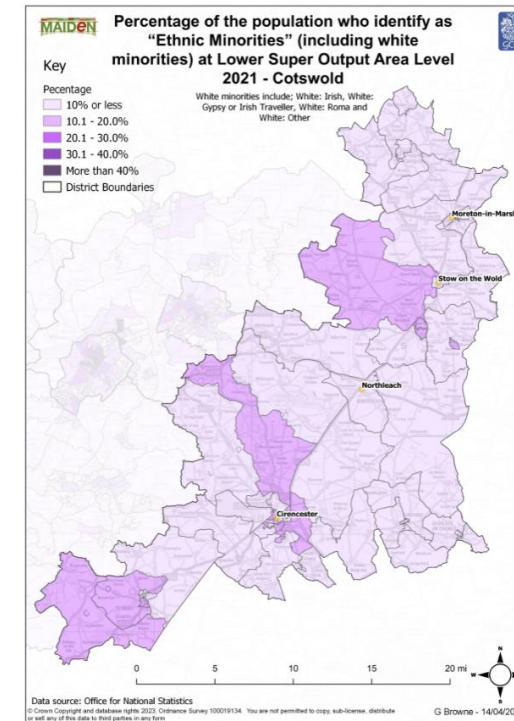
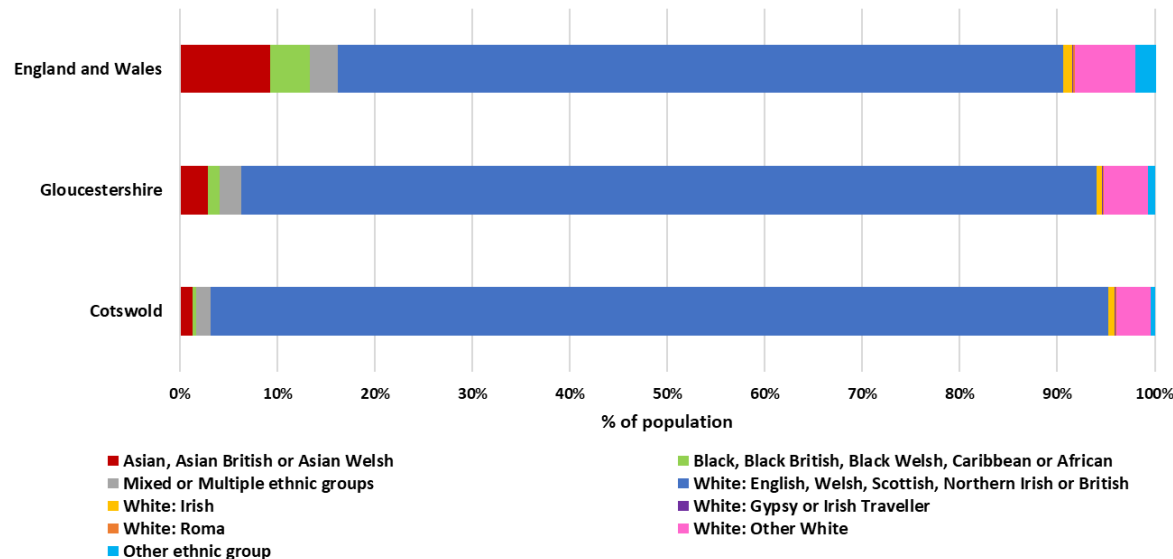
Ethnic groups

Percentage of population by ethnic group, 2021

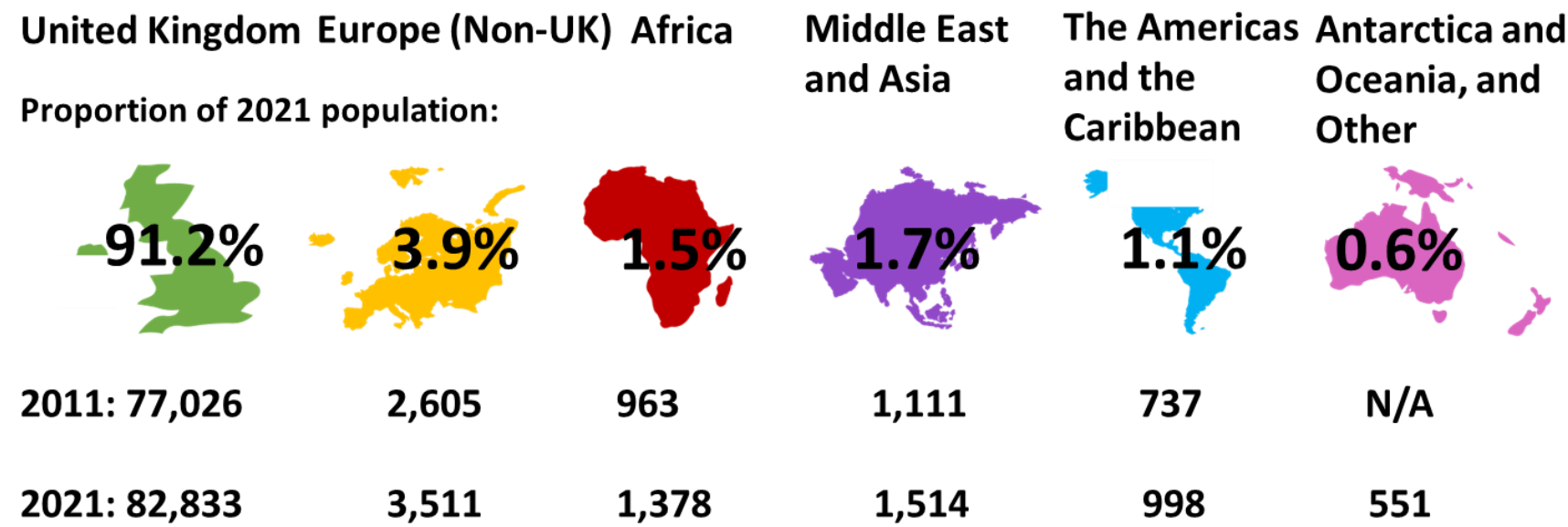


Country of birth

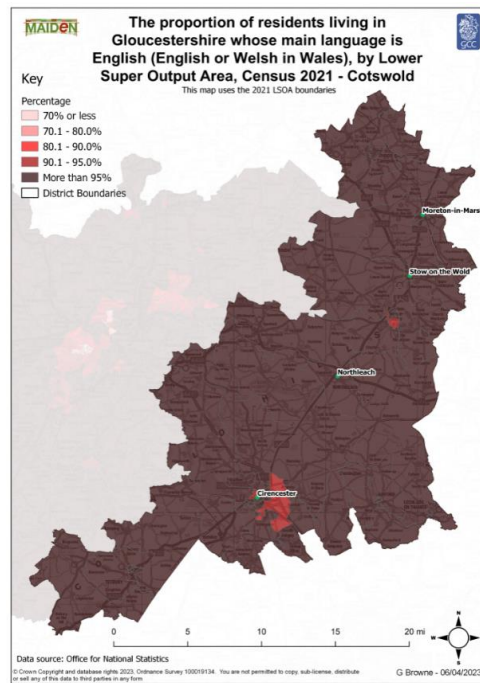

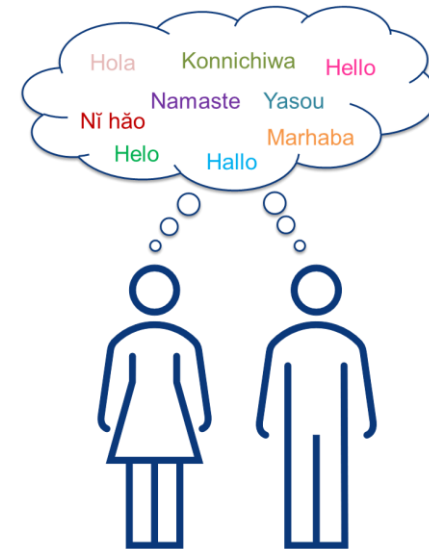
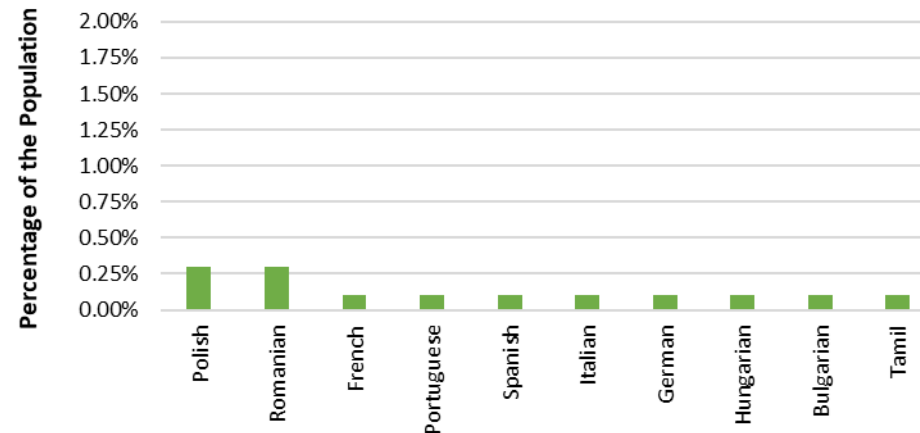

Top 10 languages that are not English (English or Welsh in Wales), 2021- Cotswold



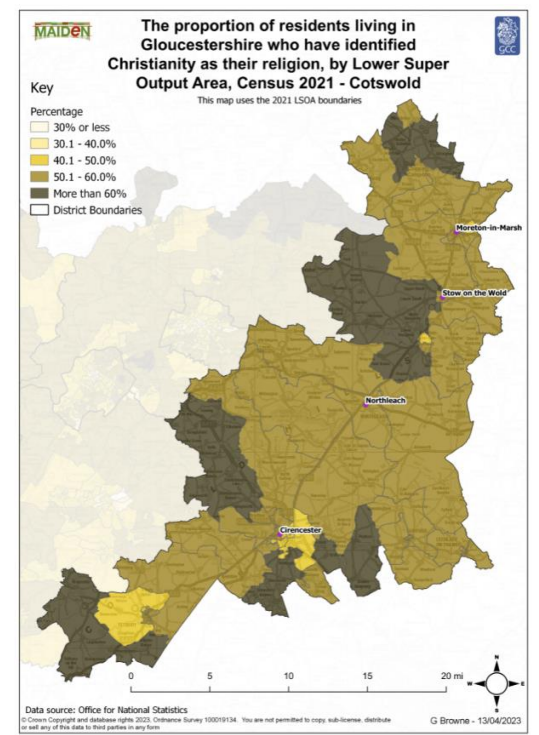
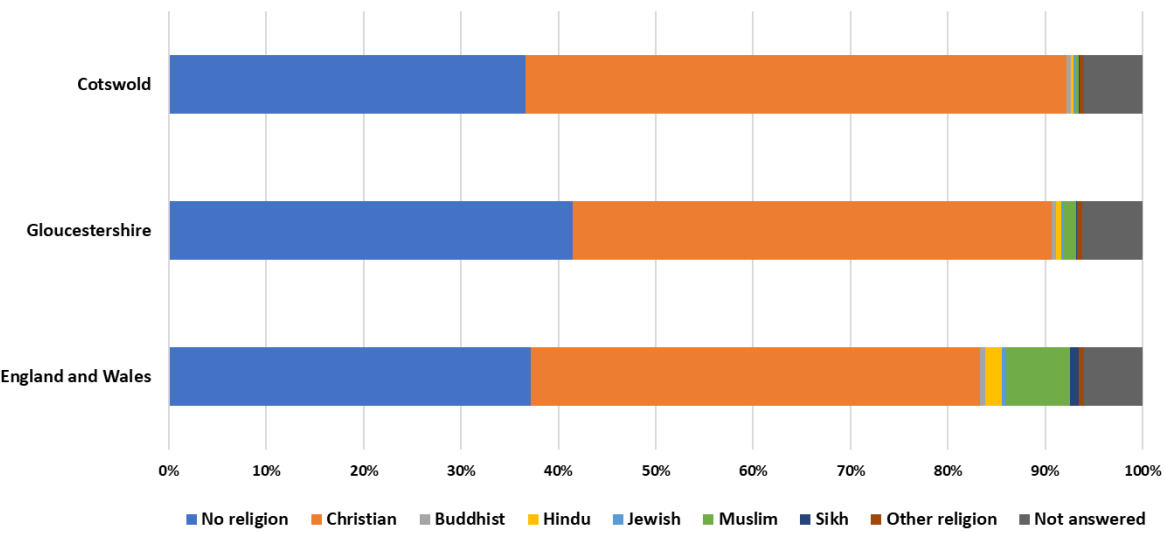
Religion

Proportion of Gloucestershire's population by religion



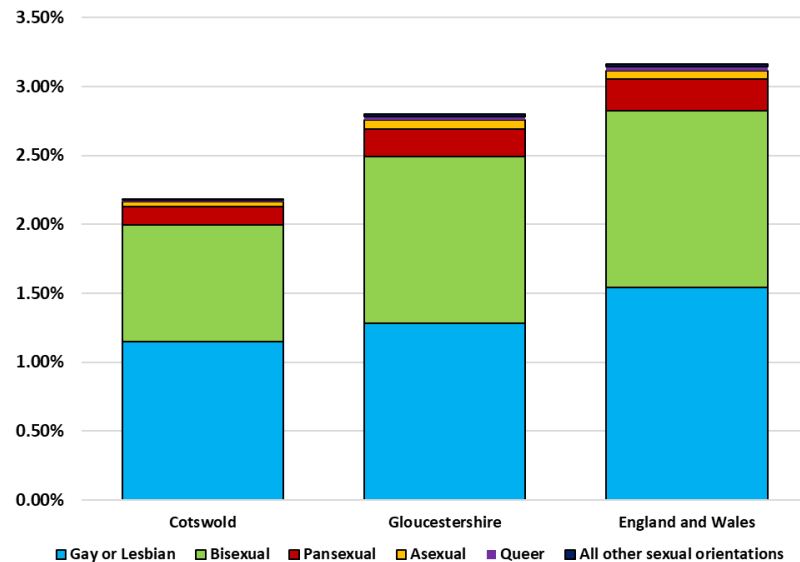
Sexual orientation and gender identity

0.3% of the population do not have the same gender identity as at birth

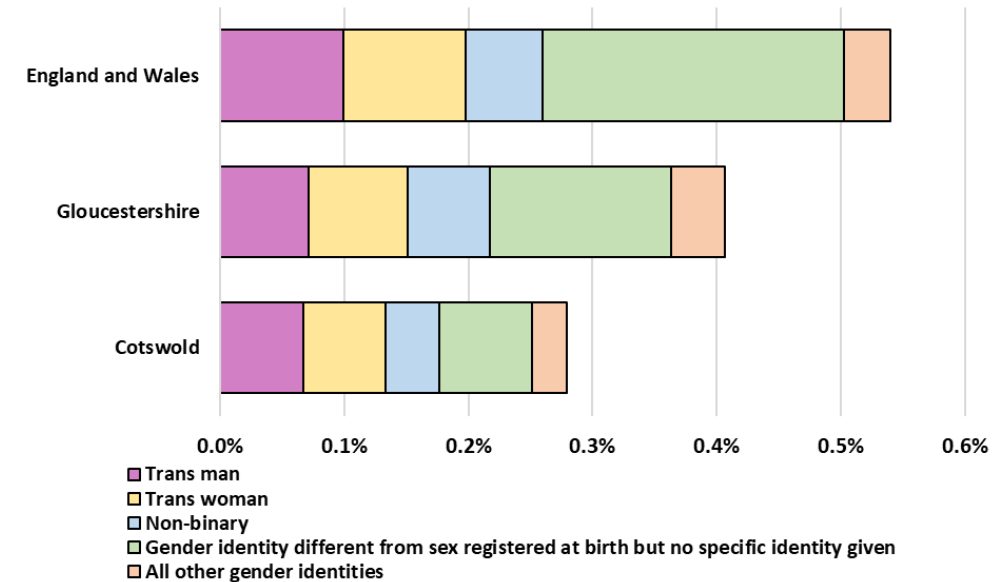

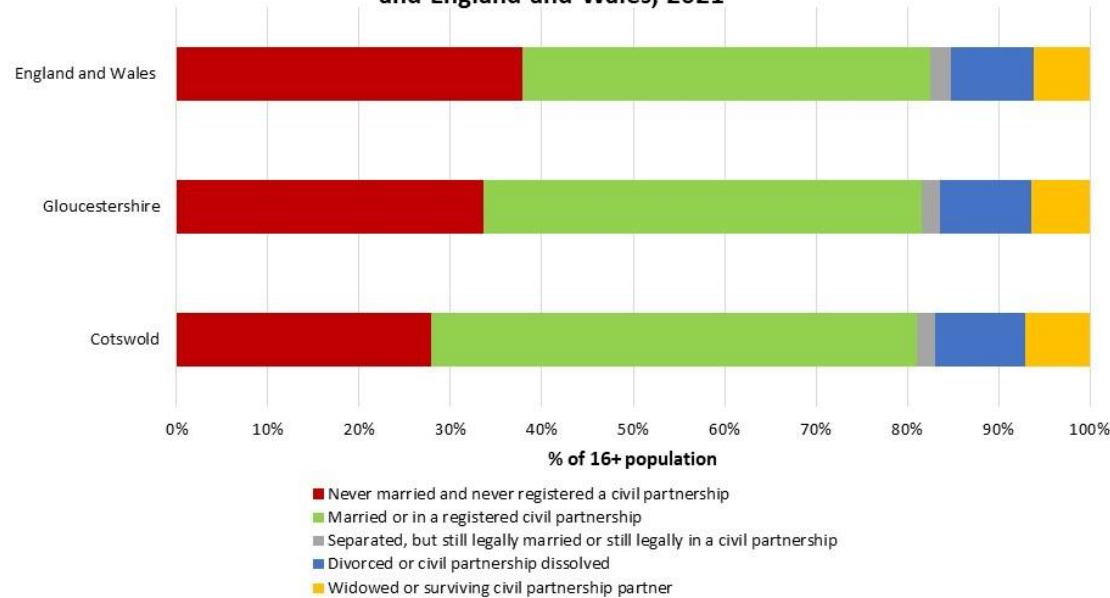

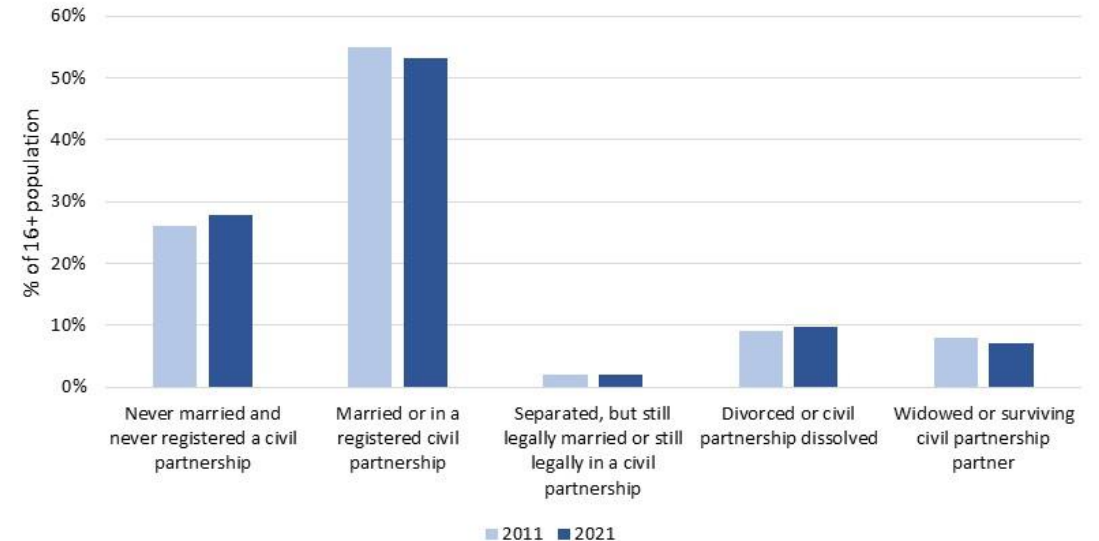

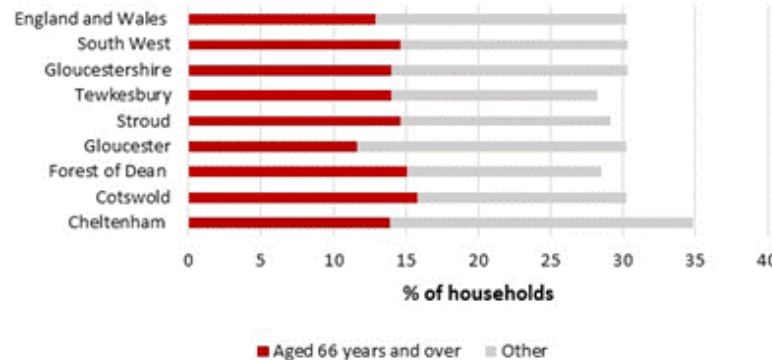

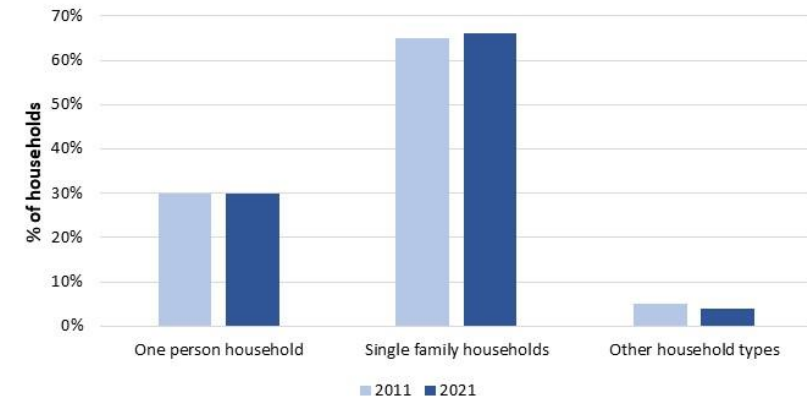

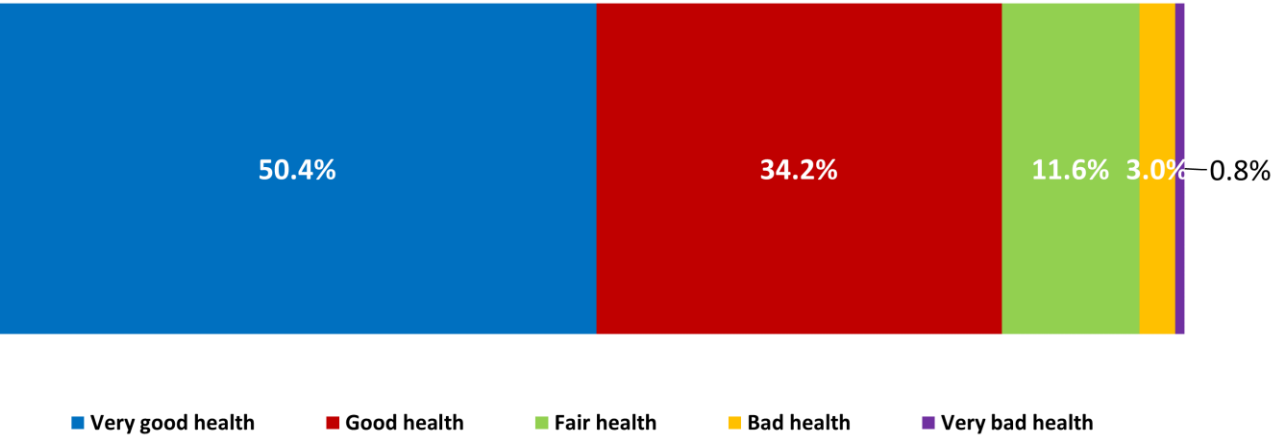

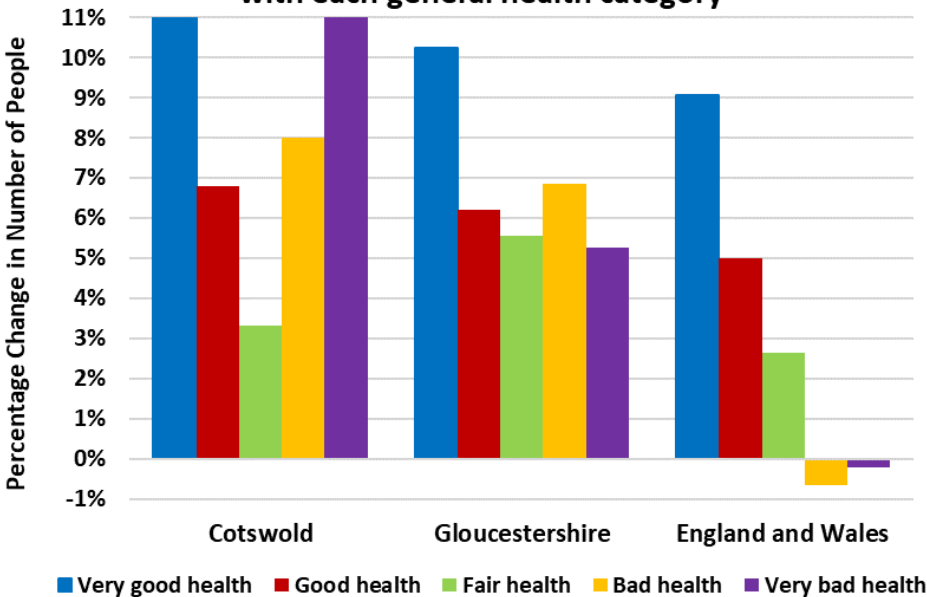

Disability

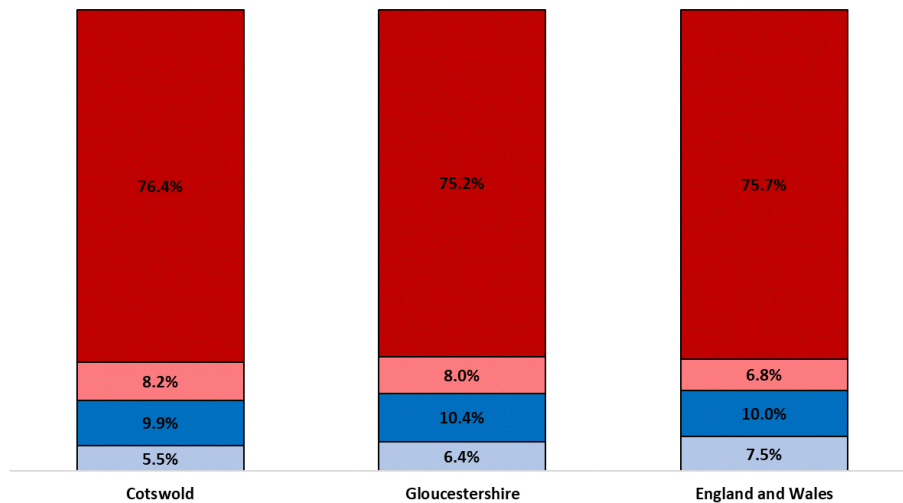
15.4% of the population are disabled under the Equality Act (2010)

8.2% not disabled but do have a long term physical or mental health condition(s)

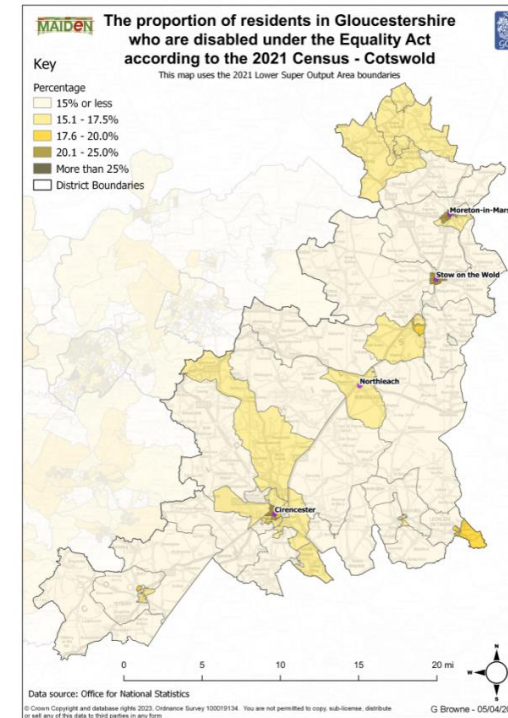


In a few LSOAs **1 in 4** people are classed as disabled

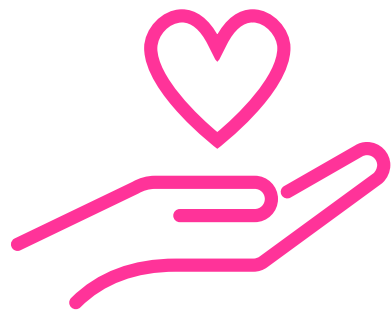

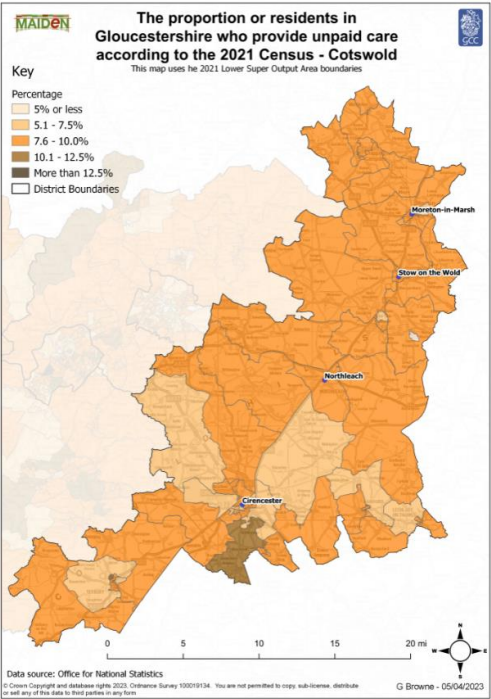
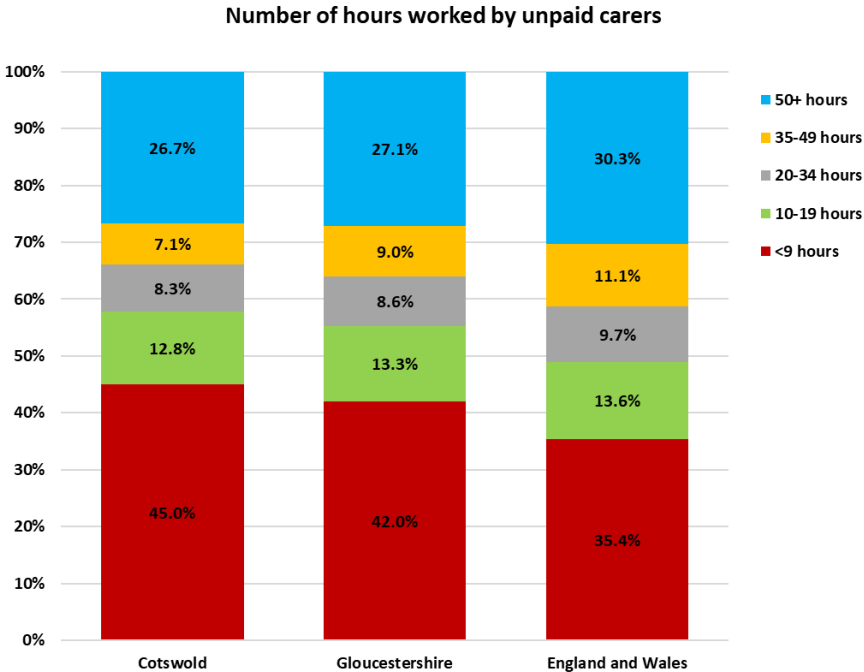


Most carers provide less than 9 hours or more than 50 hours care

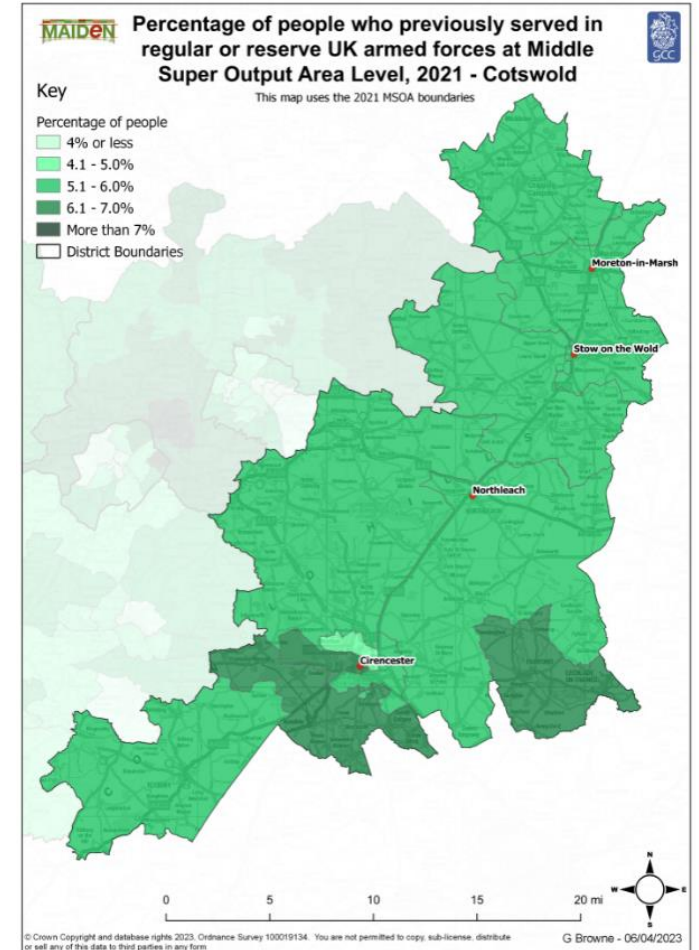

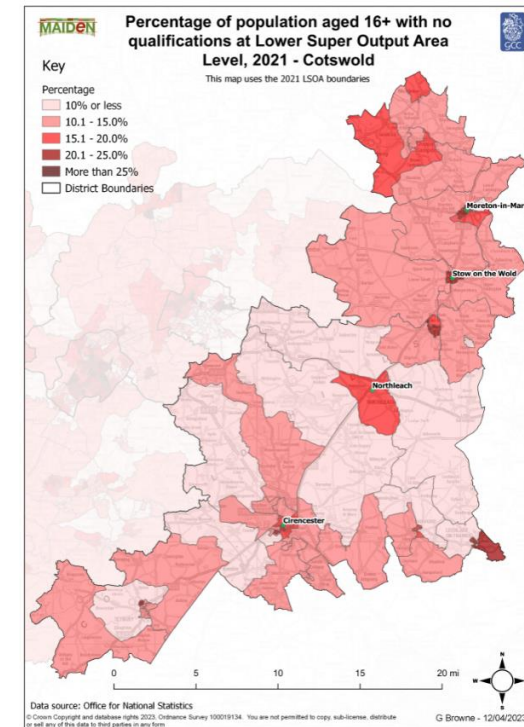
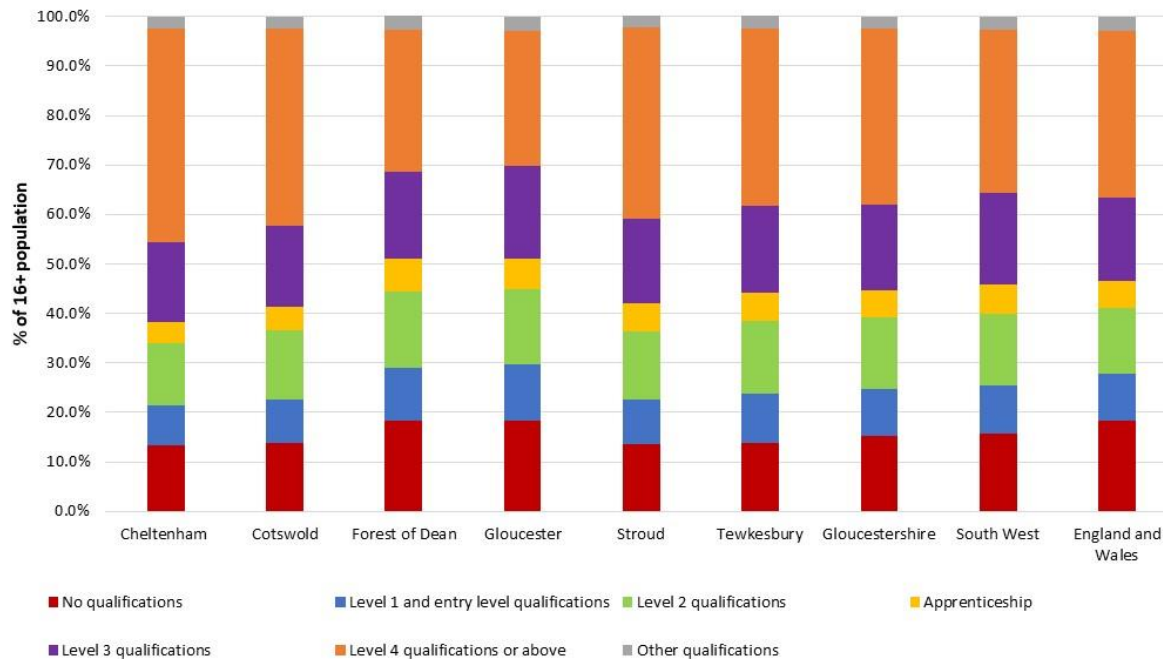

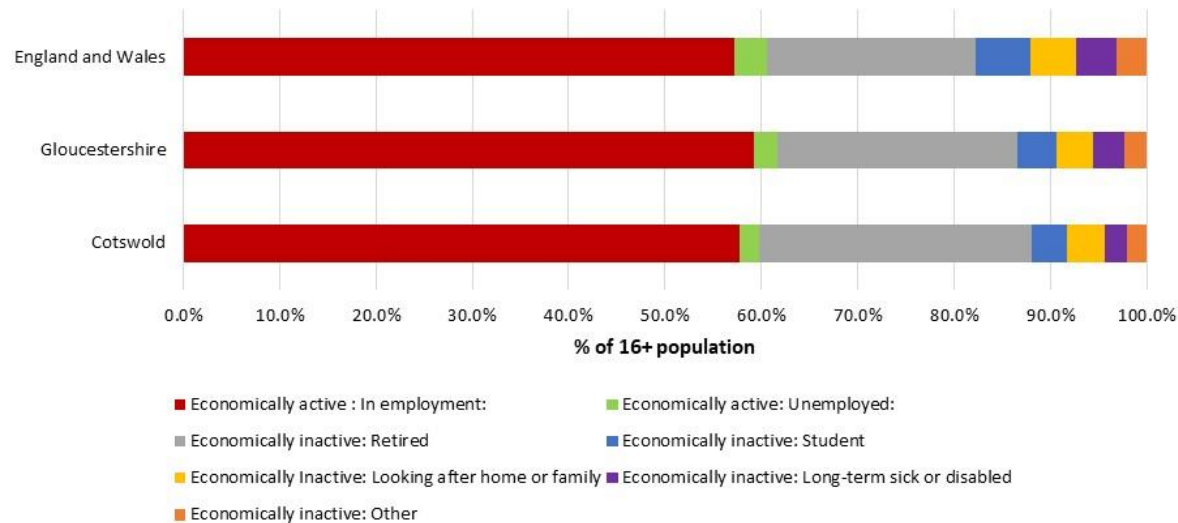

Change in the proportion of the 16+ population's economic activity status



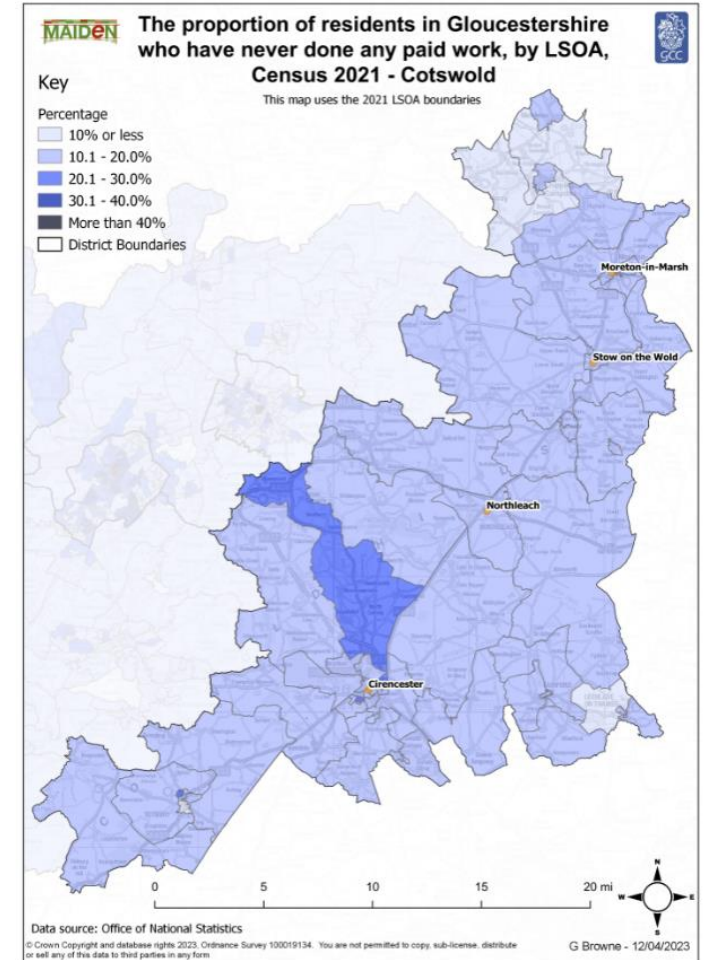
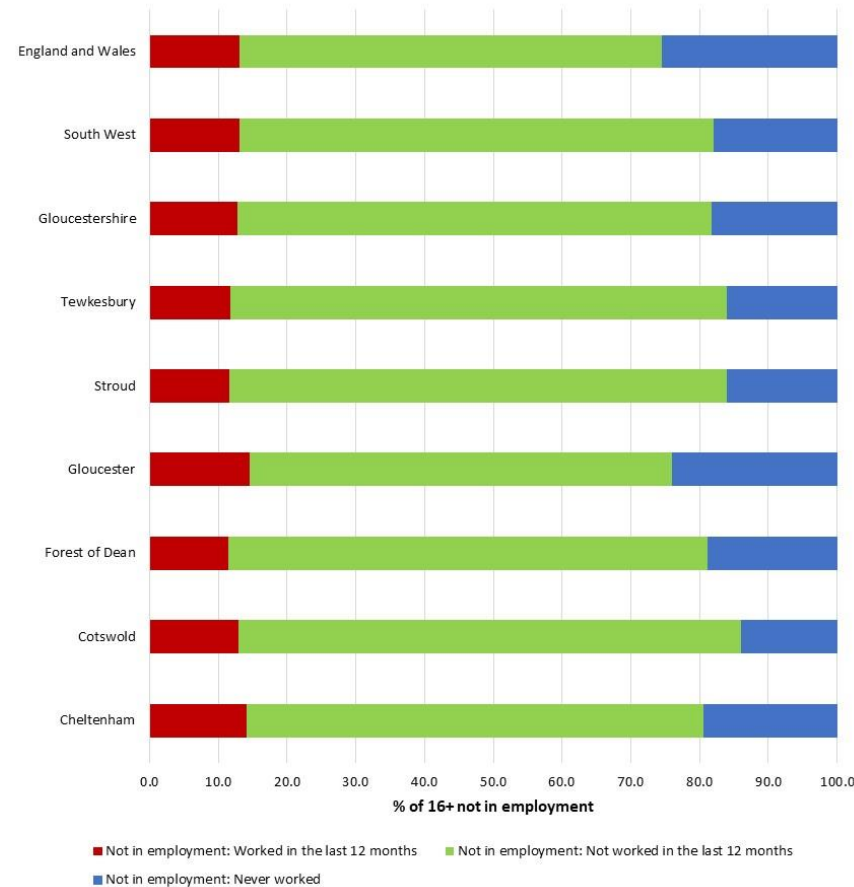

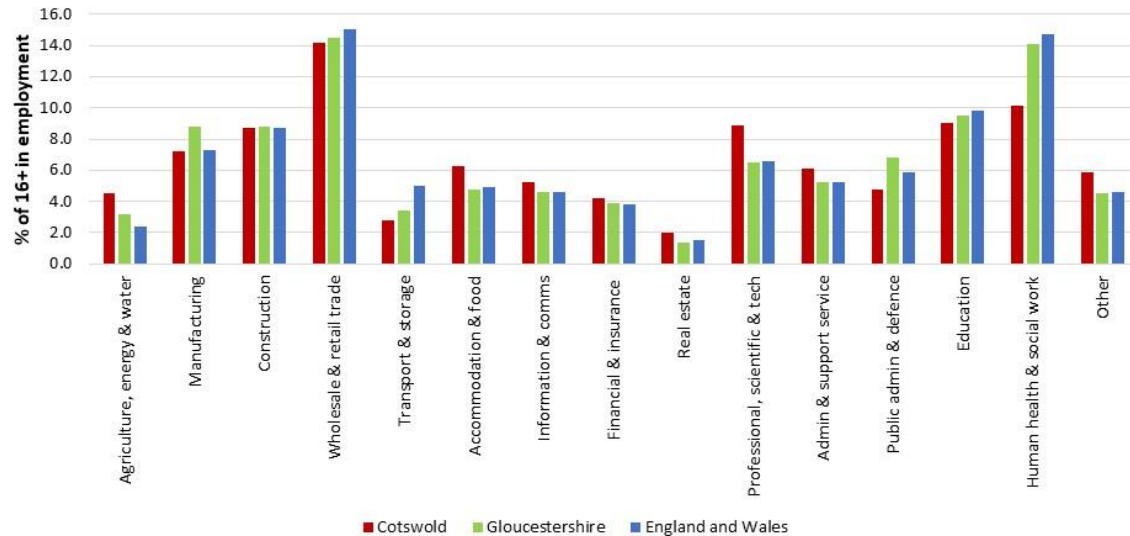

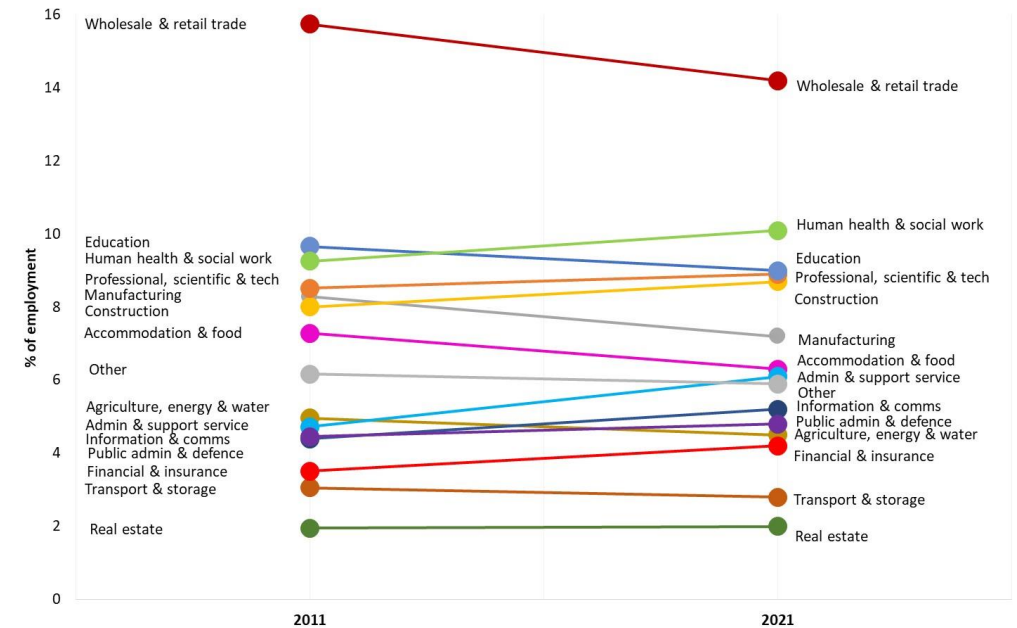

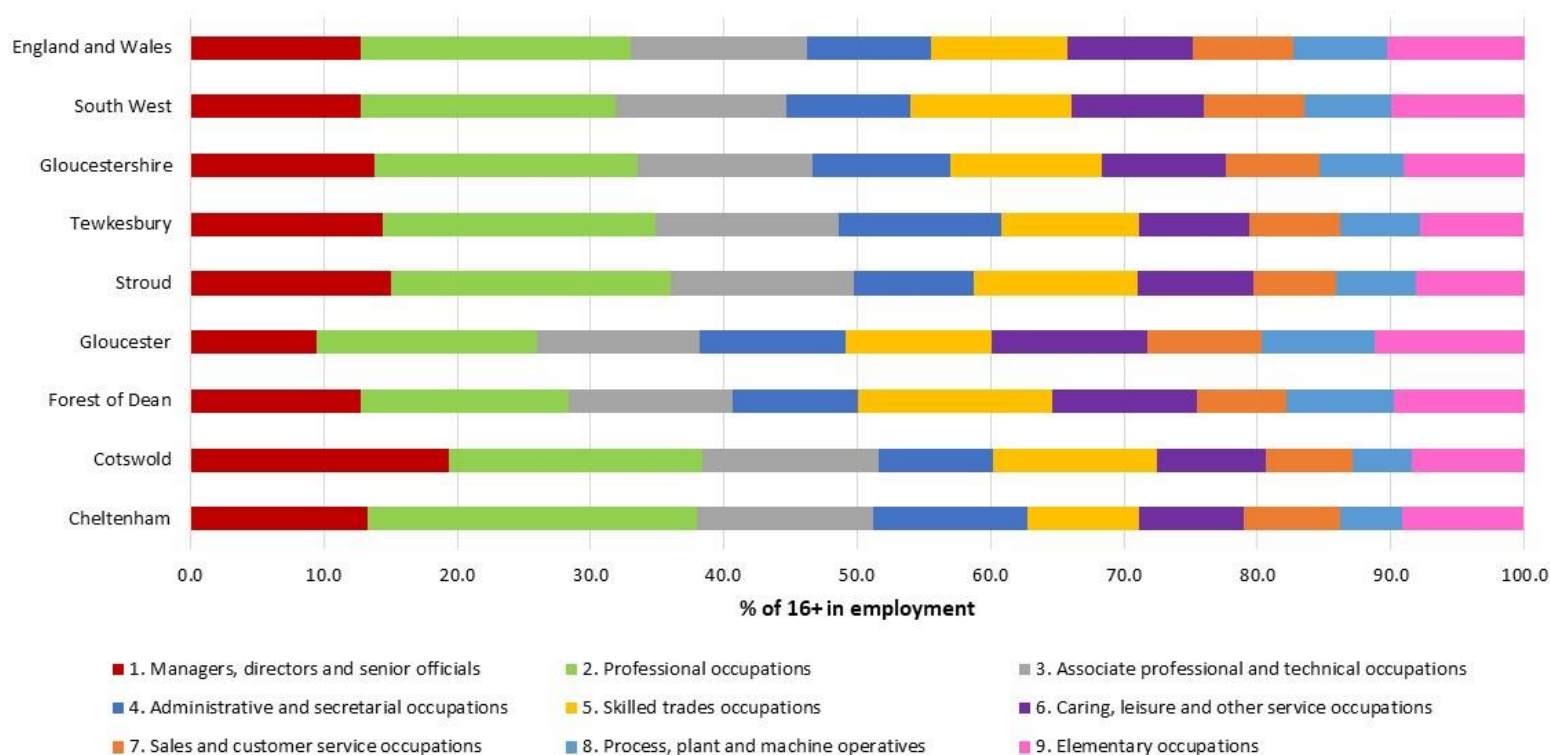

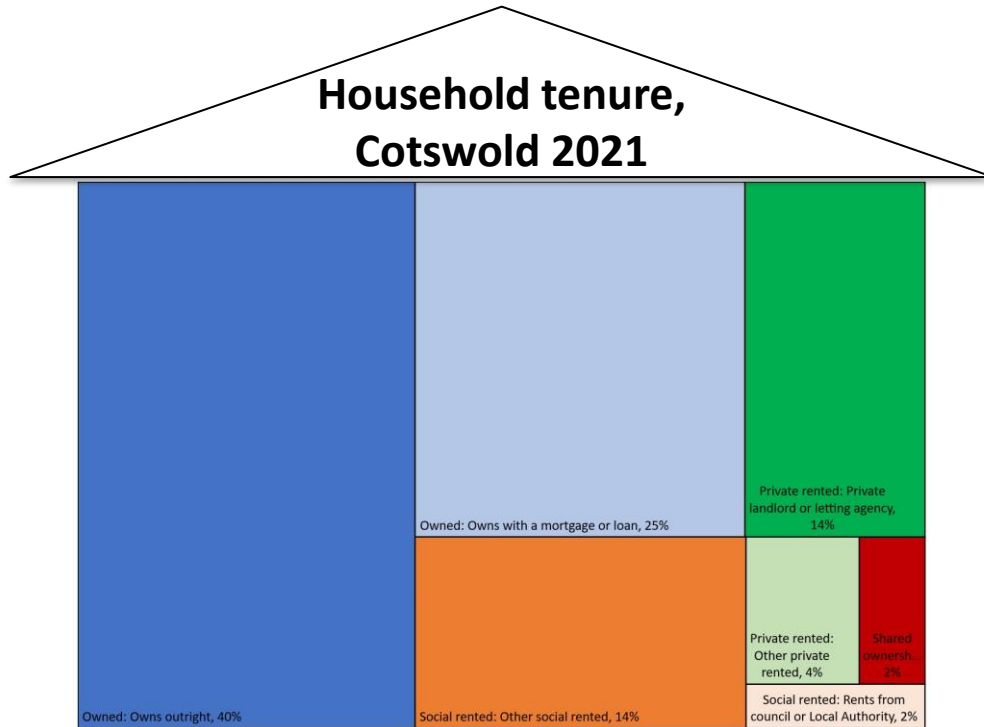

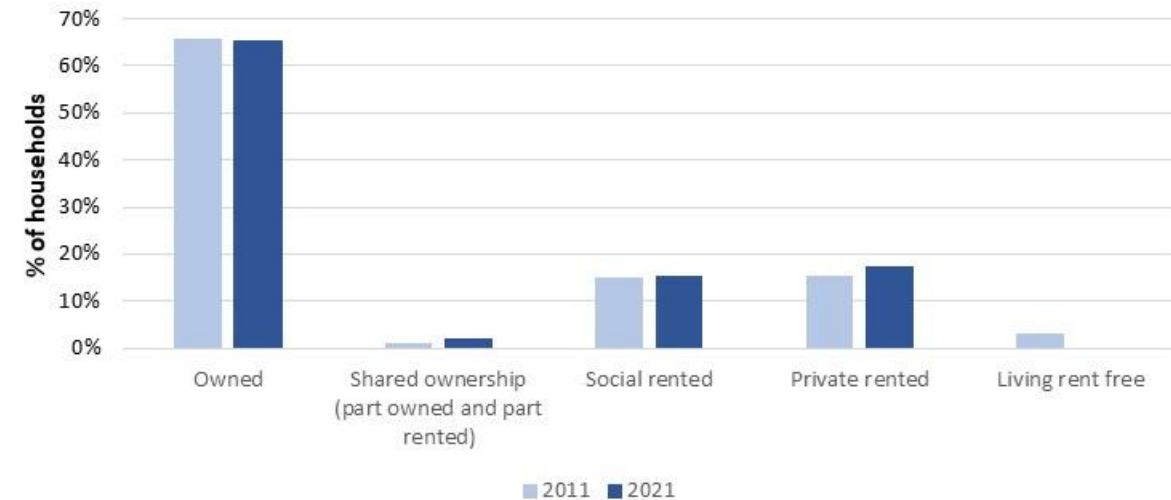

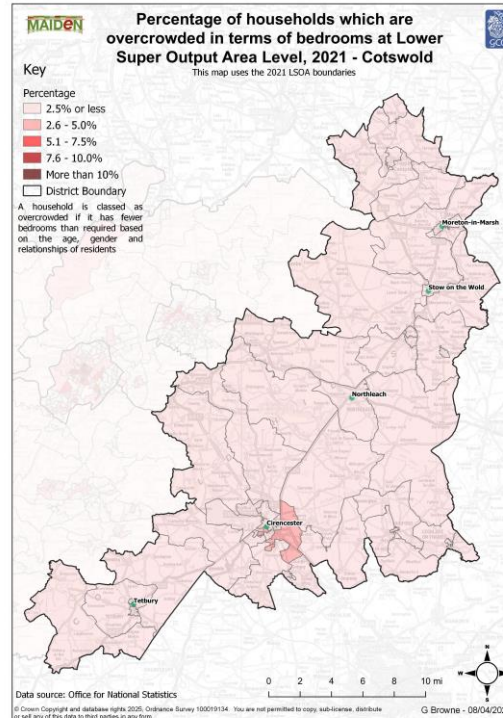

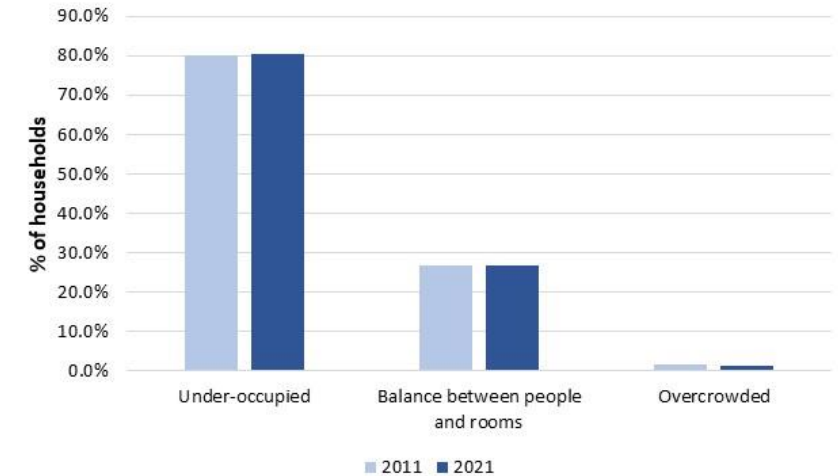

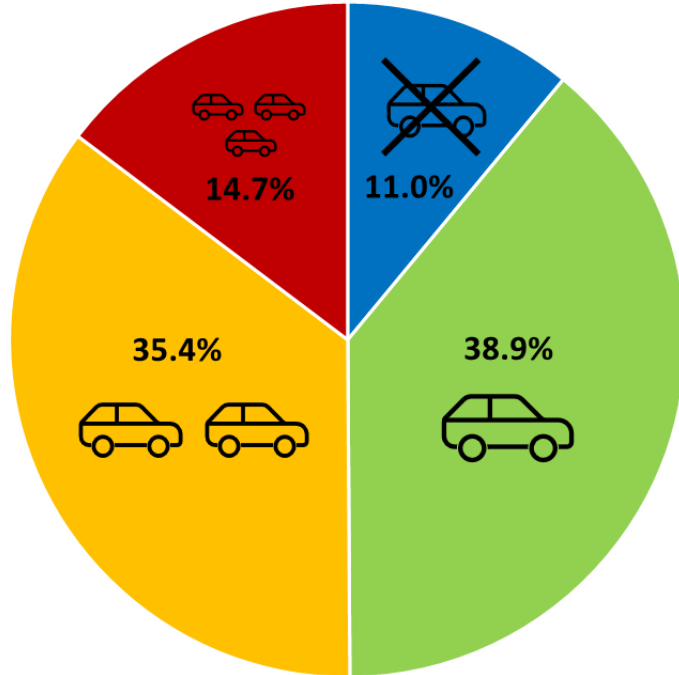

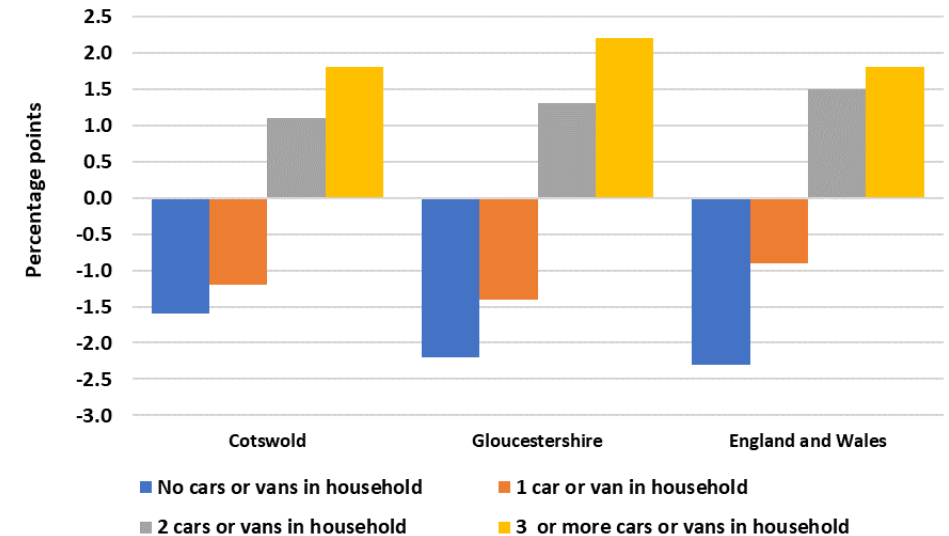

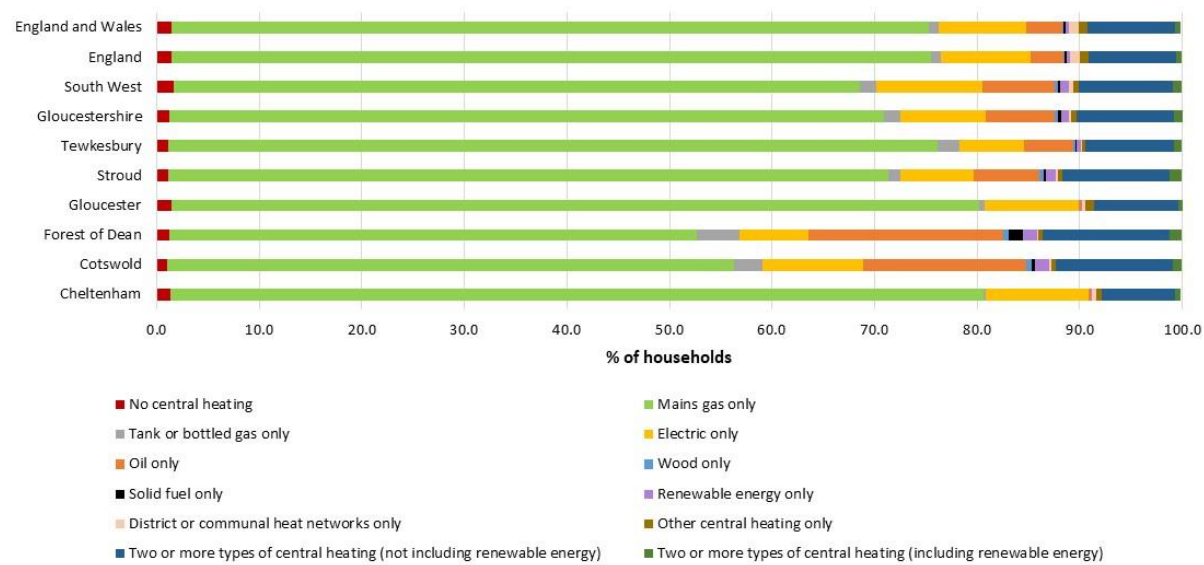

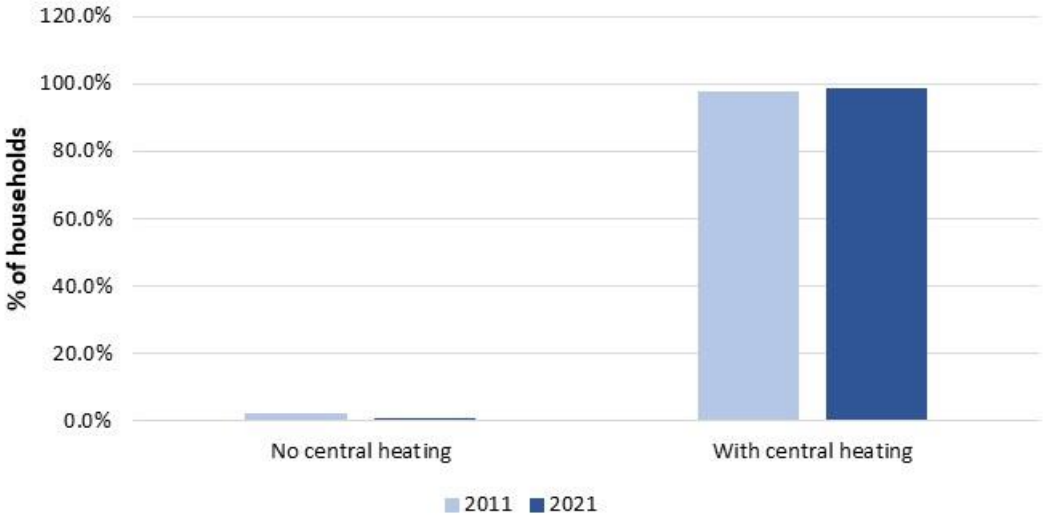

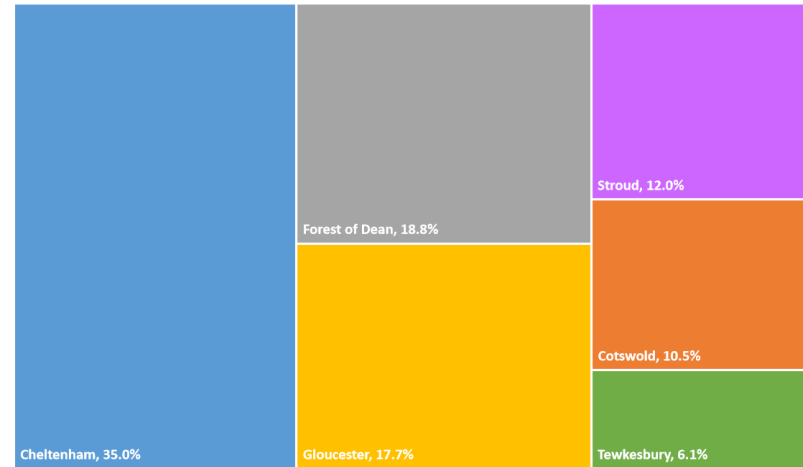

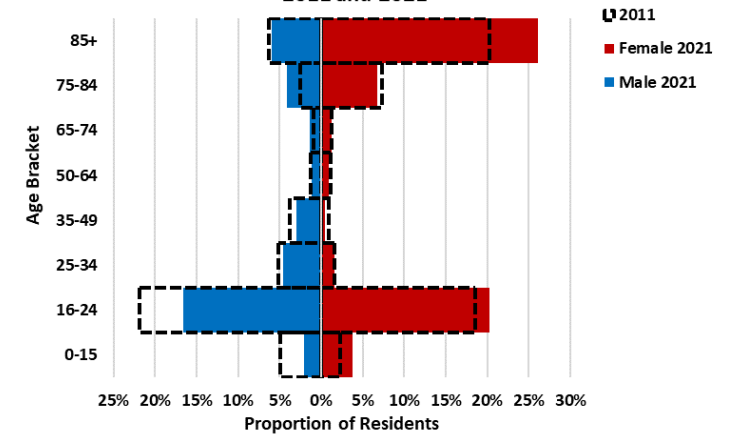


Non NHS/LA care home with nursing 31.5%
