Proposed No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Line) Restrictions



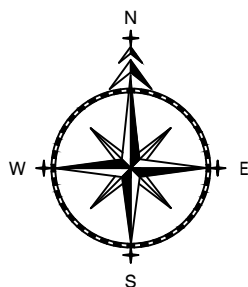
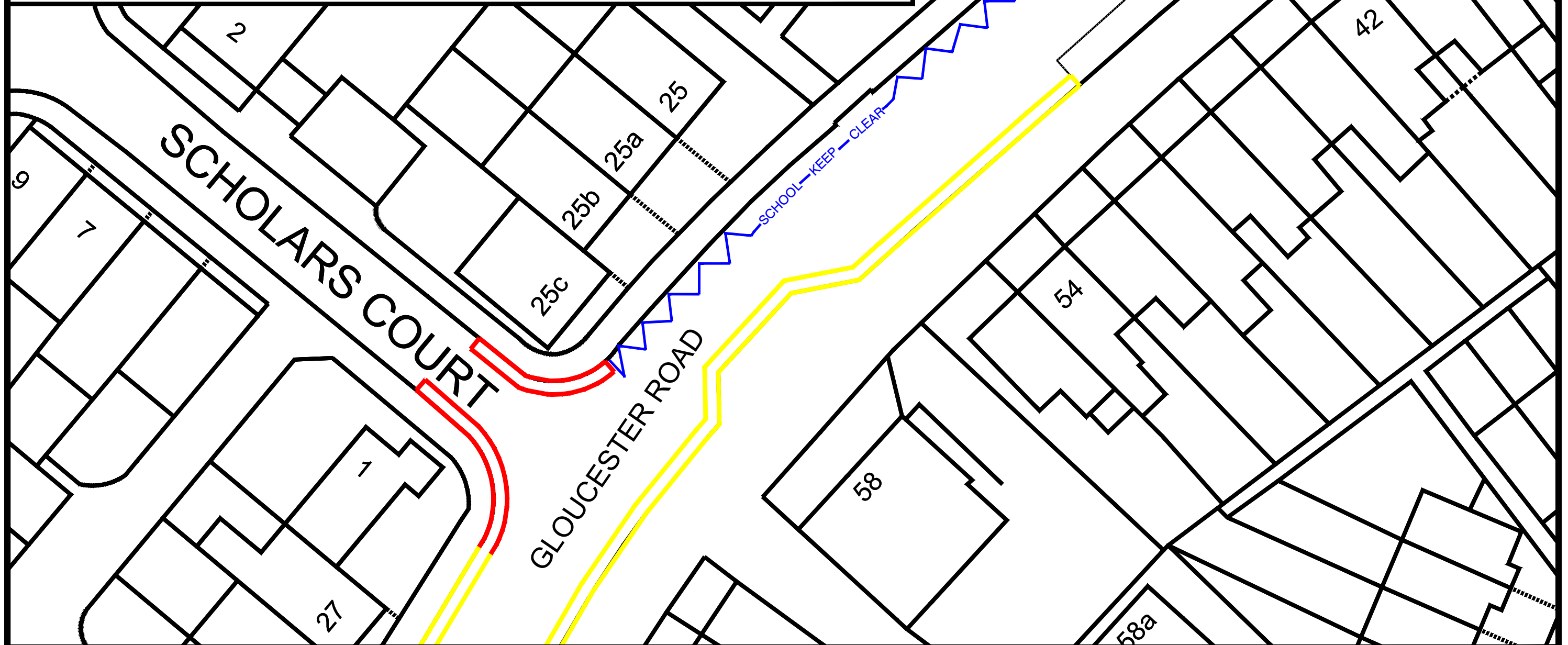
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Existing No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Line) Restrictions

I write on behalf of Gloucestershire County Council to advise you that a potential Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) scheme, regarding parking restrictions on your road, is being investigated. This is as a result of concerns raised by the police & local representatives regarding inappropriate parking during school drop off/pick up times.

Officers visited the site in June 2022 to conduct an assessment. As a result of this assessment, I attach an **initial proposal drawing** which outlines potential alterations, which could be made to the current parking restrictions arrangement on your road. These are primarily in order to improve road safety and amenity for school children, prevent parking close to junctions and where it causes obstructions for vehicles and cyclists, as well as improving pedestrian sight lines in the area concerned. The proposals have been supported by your County Councillor.

You are receiving this letter for information as a resident/business in the vicinity of the scheme area.

In order to ensure that we pursue a scheme that is supported by the majority of residents in the area, please would you issue any comments in support or in objection to the proposals using the email address OR postal address found at the top of this letter.

To assist with administration, please do ensure to state the road on which you reside and specify the road on which the proposals you are commenting on are based as part of your response.

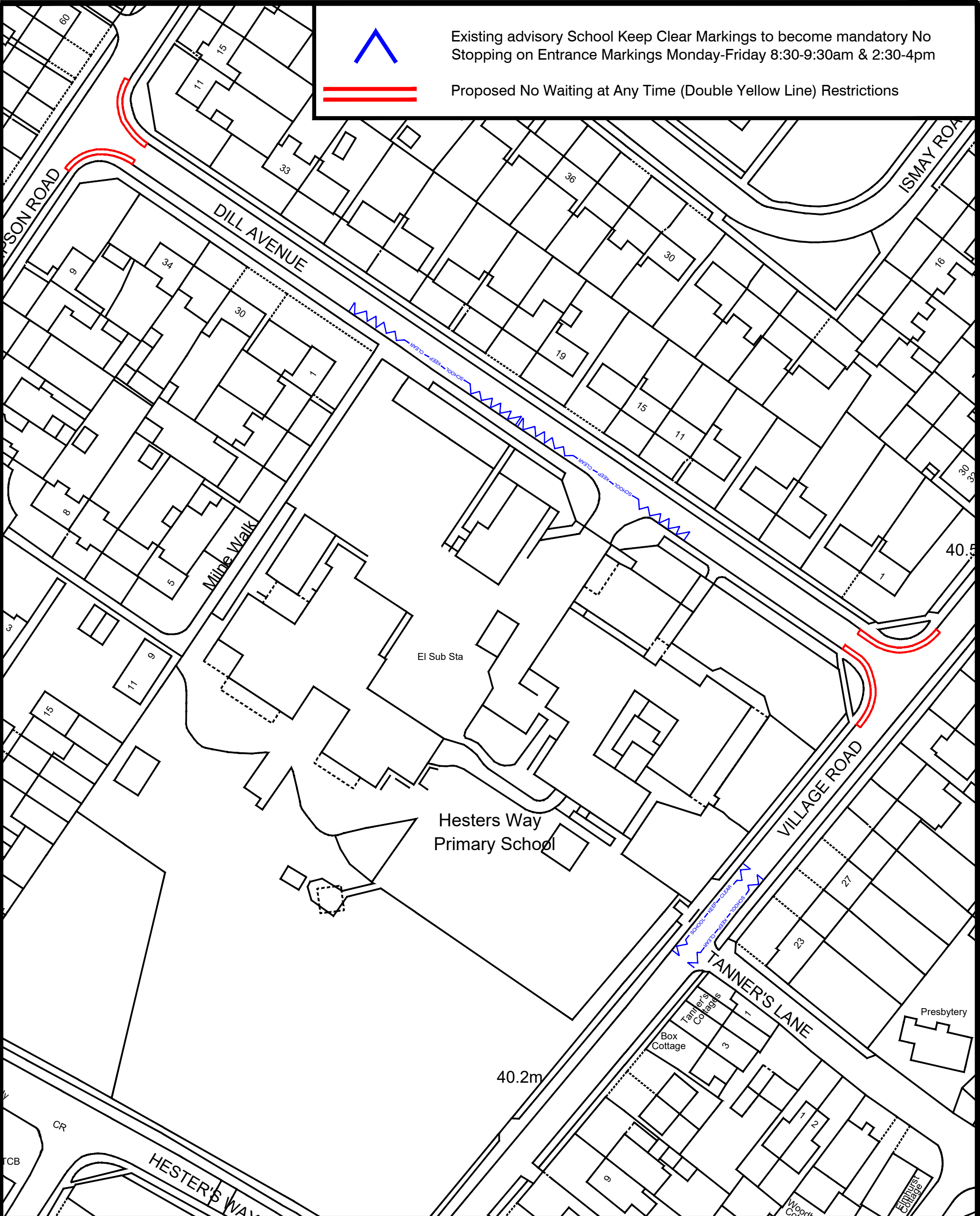
Your responses will then be collated and closely considered upon the close of the consultation process when a decision on whether to progress, alter or cease the proposals will be made based on the feedback received.
