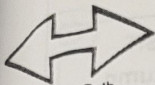

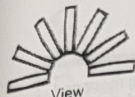

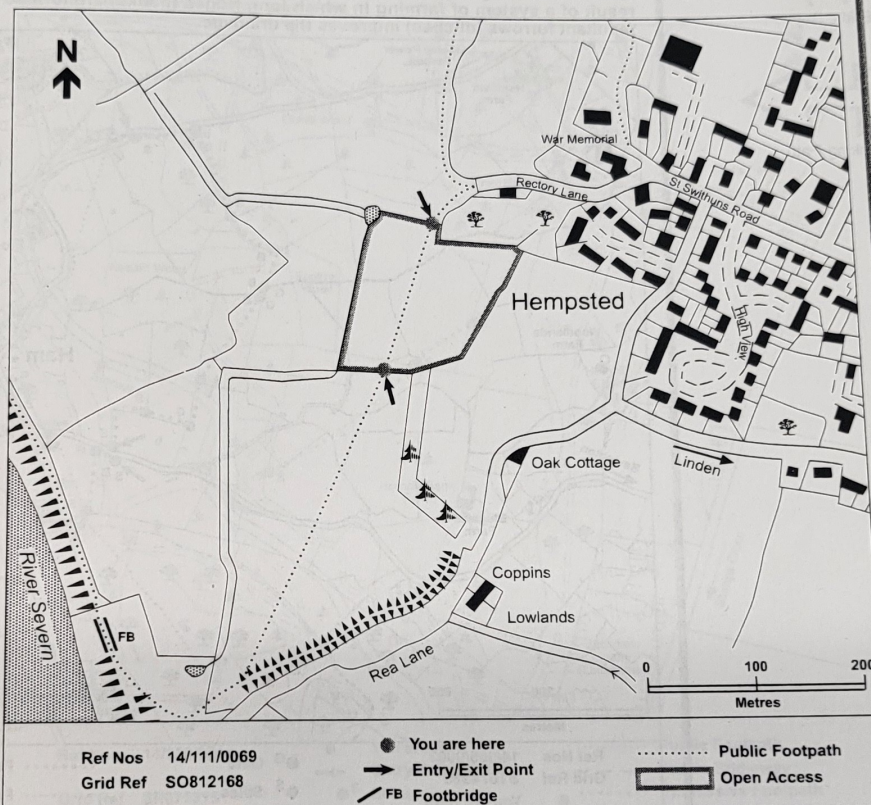

CONSERVATION WALKS

This area of permissive open access close to Hempstead is reached via the Glevum Way footpath and affords good views westward over the River Severn to the Forest of Dean. Please keep dogs on a lead when livestock are in the field.



This access has been provided under the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs' farm conservation schemes, which help farmers and land managers protect and improve the countryside, its wildlife and history. It is permissive access and no new rights of way are being created. Existing rights of way are not affected. Please follow the Country Code and observe any other requirements shown above. Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or other visitors and in particular keep dogs under control. This is working farmland so please take care; people using this site do so at their own risk.
