With a growing numbers of Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children in our schools, this free training opportunity from The Virtual School, will support and guide you in ways to set up your learning environment to support the needs of these young people. With the introductory training, comes a booklet to further develop your understanding in this area and offers opportunities to undertake activities to promote your own understanding of 'A Healing Classroom.'

1. Explain the impacts of trauma and toxic stress on students' wellbeing and learning.
2. Identify ways that trauma-informed practices, such as the Healing Classrooms Approach, work to support children's recovery.
3. Formulate strategies in teams to Prepare a Safe Place to Land in your own contexts.
4. Identify ways to use Healing Classrooms strategies to facilitate community building, relationship development and improving self-worth.
5. Consider strategies to Build a Community for Learning in your place of work.
