



SUPPORTING SUCCESSFUL REUNIFICATION: PRACTICE APPROACHES TO STRENGTHEN FAMILY OUTCOMES AND SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

By the end of this session, attendees will develop an understanding of the complexities of reunification and its impact on children's emotional wellbeing and school attendance. Participants will explore evidence-informed strategies to support successful transitions home, strengthen family functioning, and promote consistent school engagement.

At the end of this course, participants will:

- Understand the challenges of reunification
- Explore factors that influence successful outcomes for CYP who have experienced reunification
- Strengthen ways supporting professionals can help families through the processes and help for managing transitions
- The importance of promoting attendance during periods of change
- Recognise impact of collaborative multi-agency practices
