

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS)

(BISHOPS CLEEVE; STOKE ORCHARD; TREDINGTON; HARDWICKE AND UCKINGTON)
ORDER 2005

The Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and Parts II and IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 2005 and may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council (Various Speed Limits) (Bishops Cleeve; Stoke Orchard; Tredington; Hardwicke and Uckington) Order 2005".
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in Schedule I to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along those lengths of roads described in Schedule II to this Order at a speed exceeding 40mph
4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of road described in Schedule III to this Order at a speed exceeding 50mph
5. The Orders referred to in Schedule IV to this Order are hereby revoked

Swan Lane (45343)	For its entire length
Archers Lane (47926)	For its entire length
Mill Lane (50334)	For its entire length
Banady Lane (40357)	For its entire length
Dean Lane (40356)	For its entire length
Amy Johnson Lane (50333)	For its entire length
Stoke Road (3/83)	From a point 675 metres east of its junction with the kerbline on the eastern side of Banady Lane (40357) to a point 76 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Swan Lane (45343)
Tredington Road (3/86)	From its junction with Stoke Road (3/83) to a point 290 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Swan Lane (45343)

Tredington

3/86	From a point 43 metres north of its junction with the centreline of the Fiddington Road (3/87) to a point 250 metres south east of its junction with the Bozzard Lane (40352)
Fiddington Road (3/87)	From its junction with the kerbline on the north eastern side of the 3/86 for a distance of 18 metres in a northerly direction
Bozzard Lane (40352)	From its junction with the kerbline on the north eastern side of the 3/86 for a distance of 121 metres in a north easterly direction

Hardwicke/ Uckington

3/84	From its junction with the centreline of the 45356 for a distance of 200 metres in a south easterly direction and From a point 700 metres west of its junction with the kerbline on the western side of Lowdilow Lane (40364) to its junction with the kerbline on the northern side of Tewkesbury Road (A4019)
50339 (Road to Church Farm)	For its entire length
Lowdilow Lane (40364)	For its entire length
45356	For its entire length

Bishops Cleeve

Kayte Lane (3/367)	From its junction with the centreline of Delabere Road (43187) for a distance of 400 metres in a generally southerly direction

Stoke Orchard/ Southam/ Tredington

Stoke Road (3/83)	From its western most side of its roundabout junction with the A435 (Bishops Cleeve bypass) to a point 210 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Banady Lane (40357)
3/86	From a point 290 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Swan Lane (45343) to a point 250 metres south east of its junction with Bozzard Lane (40352) and From a point 43 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Fiddington Road (3/87) to its junction with the kerbline on the eastern side of the A38

Kayte Lane (3/367)

From a point 400 metres south of its junction with Delabere Road (43187) to its junction with Southam Lane (3/85)
