Forest of Dean District Summary

Forest of Dean is the most deprived district/borough in Gloucestershire and ranks as the 121st most deprived of the 296 districts in England*

Forest of Dean is home to the **most deprived LSOA** in the county for: **'Barriers to Housing and Services'** (Dymock, which is the 91st most deprived LSOA of the 33,755 LSOAs in England)

46% of the population of Forest of Dean live in areas of **average deprivation** (middle national quintile of the Index of Multiple Deprivation)


