

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ON-STREET PARKING ORDER 2017
(B4225 THE VICARAGE BIBURY TO ARLINGTON PIKE, BIBURY) (COTSWOLD DISTRICT)
(EXPERIMENTAL VARIATION) ORDER NO. 1 2026**

Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.

1. The Gloucestershire County Council On-Street Parking Order 2017 ("the 2017 Order") shall be amended by the revocation of the existing sealed plan specified in the First Schedule to this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order and which is hereby replaced with the new sealed plan specified in the Second Schedule to this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.
2. The effect of this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is to experimentally introduce the restrictions set out in the Third Schedule to this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order and to experimentally suspend the restrictions set out in the Fourth Schedule to this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.

B4225 The Vicarage Bibury to Arlington Pike	On a section of the southern kerbline from a point approximately 31m west of its junction with The Street (B4225) in a westerly direction for approximately 52m

3. The remainder of the 2017 Order shall remain in full force and effect including any restrictions that have not been experimentally suspended by this Experimental Traffic Regulation Order
4. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Council may modify or suspend the operation of the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order or any provision of it if it appears essential (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order runs. This power shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct
5. The Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is Experimental and may continue in force for a period of 18 months up to 17th November 2027. In due course the Council will consider whether the provisions of the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order should continue in force indefinitely

This Experimental Traffic Regulation Order shall come into effect on the 18th May 2026 and may be cited as "The Gloucestershire County Council On-Street Parking Order 2017 (B4225 THE VICARAGE BIBURY TO ARLINGTON PIKE, BIBURY) (COTSWOLD DISTRICT) (EXPERIMENTAL VARIATION) ORDER NO. 1 2026"
