


Lydney Cycle Improvement Scheme

Bulletin 2 – 29th November 2019


Griffiths have been appointed by Gloucestershire County Council to carry out the Lydney Cycle Improvement Scheme. We will construct an integrated cycleway network made up of five individual links aiming to improve connectivity for cyclists and pedestrians throughout Lydney and the surrounding areas. The scheme will provide safe, easy to ride routes suitable for utility, leisure and commuting.



Lydney Cycle Improvement Scheme Routes

Progress So Far...

Red Link



The works from Aylburton toward Lydney, as far as Taurus Crafts entrance, to widen the footway are completed to binder level, with only the final wearing course to be applied.



High Compliance



We have also completed to binder level the widening of the footway from the Town Hall to the Lydney Park Estate entrance. Work to install a retaining wall between the entrance to Lydney Park Estate and the A48 roundabout have been started.



Purple Link

We have started to construct the footway alongside the football club toward the abutments for the new footbridge.

Orange Link

The widening of the footpath outside the bus station toward High Street is completed and ready for the surface course.



Green Link

All the construction and widening works on the Green Link between High Street and the A48 are complete and ready for surfacing.

We have completed the widening works on the A48 between Church Road and the roundabout on the northern side.



Upcoming Works...

Red Link

We will be starting from the entrance with Taurus Crafts heading north toward the A48 roundabout to undertake the widening works. At the same time, we will continue building the retaining wall outside Lydney Park Estate, heading south toward the A48 roundabout, to allow us to continue our widening process there. We will also be working outside Greggs to realign kerbs and install drainage & bollards.

Orange Link

Works will be starting from the car park near the tennis courts toward the Blue Link to widen the existing footway and improve the route.

Green Link

We will be continuing to work on the A48 section of the Green Link to undertake kerb realignment and widening.

Purple Link

We will be continuing the construction of the footway along the Purple Link.

Blue Link

Work to upgrade and repair the existing Blue Link will be started over the upcoming week.
