

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(30MPH & 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)  
(CIRENCESTER ROAD, MINCHINHAMPTON) (STROUD DISTRICT)  
ORDER 2025**

The Gloucestershire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule hereby make the following Order:-

1. (i) This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and may be cited as the “GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (30MPH & 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (CIRENCESTER ROAD, MINCHINHAMPTON) (STROUD DISTRICT) ORDER 2025”.  
  
(ii) This Order affects roads within the Parish of Minchinhampton within the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.
2. In this Order –  
  
“Motor Vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
3. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 MPH.
4. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along that length of road described in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 MPH.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, the following part of an Order is to be revoked as specified in the sub-Articles that follow:

Cirencester Road, Minchinhampton	From a point 110 metres west of the centre point of its junction with Butt Street (3/270) to a point 204 metres east of the centre point of its junction with Besbury Park (45937)

**Schedule 3 – 40mph Speed Limit**

3/268 Cirencester Road	From a point 520 metres west of the centre point of its junction with road number 3/271 (Hyde Hill) for a distance of 755 metres in an easterly direction

**40mph Speed Limit to be Introduced**

Cirencester Road (C268)	From a point 344m east of the centre point of its junction with Besbury Park (45937) to a point 148m east of the centre point of its junction with the C271 Beeches Park to Junction with Cirencester Road (known as Hampton Road).
