

The English Indices of Deprivation 2025

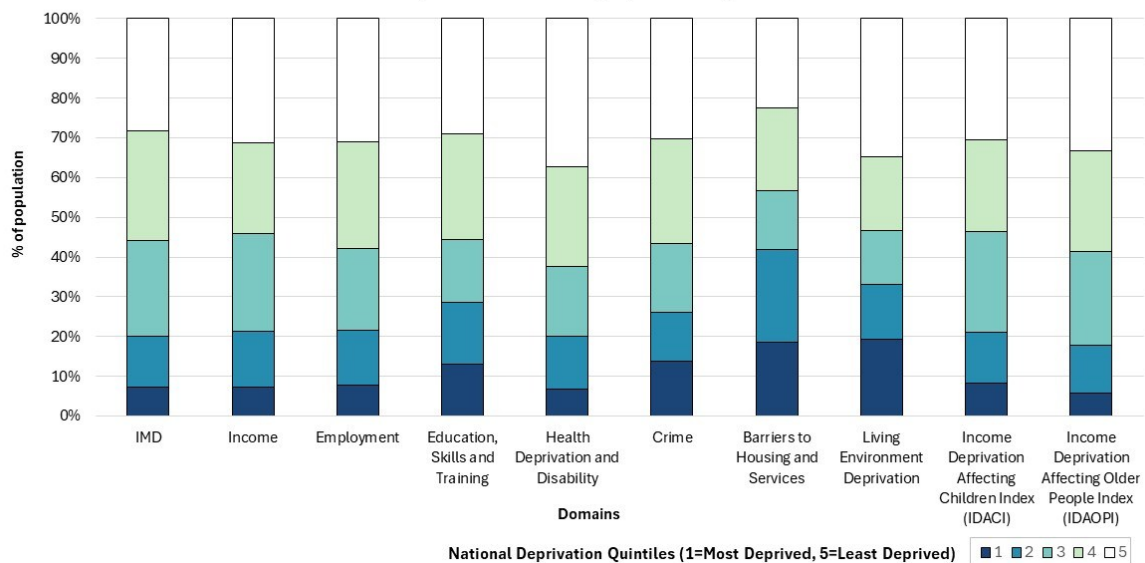
Gloucestershire County Summary

Gloucestershire is amongst the least deprived 20% of local authorities in England and ranks as the 124th most deprived of the 153 Upper Tier Local Authorities*

Gloucestershire is home to the **5th least deprived LSOA in England** for: **'Living Environment'** (Cleeve St Michael's 1, Tewkesbury)

Gloucestershire is home to an LSOA in the **0.3% most deprived** in England for **'Health Deprivation and Disability'** and **'Crime'** (Westgate 5, Gloucester), also **'Barriers to Housing and Services'** (Dymock, Forest of Dean)

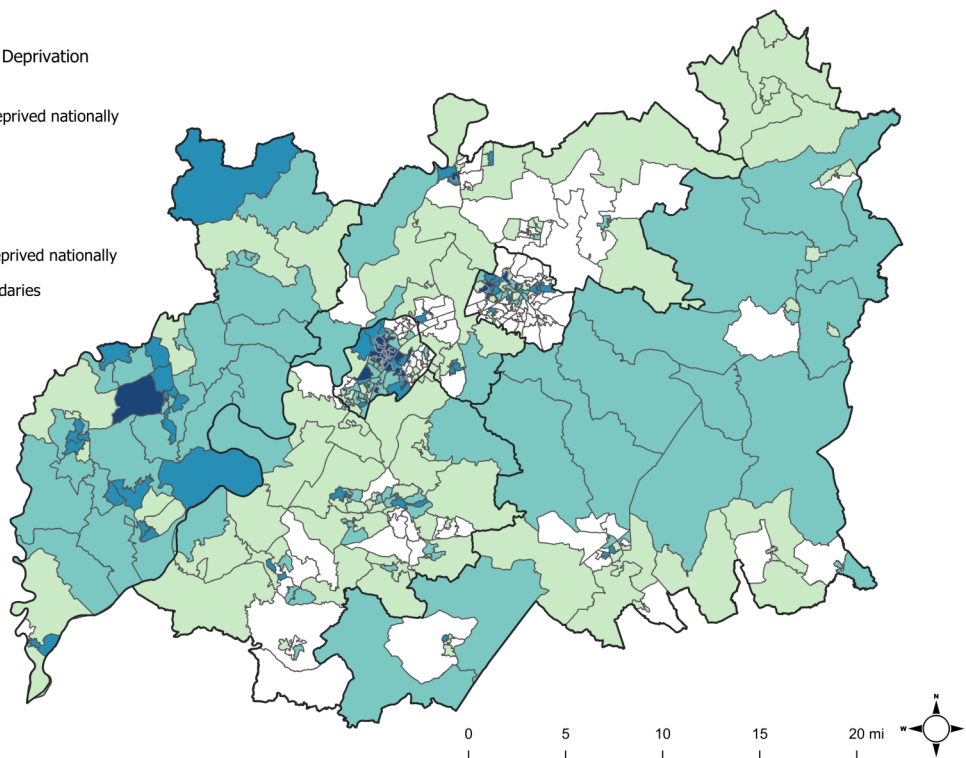
Gloucestershire Indices of Deprivation 2025 Domains by National Quintile
