
Gloucestershire County Summary

Gloucestershire is amongst the least deprived 20% of local authorities in England and ranks as the 124th most deprived of the 153 Upper Tier Local Authorities*

Gloucestershire is home to the 5th least deprived LSOA in England for: 'Living Environment' (Cleeve St Michael's 1, Tewkesbury)


Gloucestershire is home to an LSOA in the 0.3% most deprived in England for 'Health Deprivation and Disability' and 'Crime' (Westgate 5, Gloucester), also 'Barriers to Housing and Services' (Dymock, Forest of Dean)
