


Lydney Cycle Improvements - Red Link Urban



The urban section of the Red Link runs through the town centre along High Street, Hill Street, and Newerne Street.

The existing building lines mean it is not feasible to provide a dedicated cycle facility along the length of the route, however removal of the centre line road marking will allow advisory up hill cycle lanes to be installed on High Street and Hill Street. These lanes will provide space for cyclists when climbing the hill at lower speeds than passing motorised traffic.

Centre line removal and other road marking alterations throughout the remainder of the route will give result in reduced vehicle speeds, allowing cyclists to ride more comfortably with motorised traffic.

Link Length:

850m

Anticipated usage: Commuting, utility and leisure cycling/walking

Proposed facility: On-carriageway up hill advisory cycle lanes (High Street and Hill Street)
