

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH EUL 20
(UPTON ST LEONARDS PARISH) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has further extended the Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of public footpath EUL 20 from its junction with Public Footpath EUL 24 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 85439/14282 and then extends in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to a point at (OSGR) SO 85490/14213 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

The footpath falls in Upton St Leonards Parish in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;

The closure is necessary to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to an unsafe M5 footbridge.

This temporary closure Order came into force on the 30th March 2026 and was expected to end on the 9th September 2026. However, the works have still not been completed and the Secretary of State has granted an extension until 9th March 2028 or until the works are complete, whichever is earliest.

Alternative Route – Not available

Emergency and Pedestrian access to adjoining premises is to be maintained.



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
