St Ann Way to Cole Avenue, Gloucester Walking and Cycling Improvements

Gloucestershire County Council is developing proposals for new walking and cycling improvements between St Ann Way / Bristol Road and Cole Avenue, creating a safer, more accessible route for people travelling through Gloucester.

The route would link local communities with Gloucester City Centre, the Quays and Docks, schools, parks, leisure destinations and public transport links, while connecting to other existing and planned walking and cycling routes across the city.

The proposed route will travel along: Stroud Road, King Edward's Avenue, The Oval, Tuffley Park, Podsmead Place, Laburnum Road, Podsmead Road and Cole Avenue.

Proposed improvements include:

- New segregated cycleways
- Improved walking routes
- New and upgraded crossing facilities
- A new surfaced walking and cycling route through Tuffley Park
- Improved access to local schools, parks, leisure destinations and public transport links

The scheme forms part of the wider Gloucestershire Cycle Spine, helping to create safer and more inclusive travel options for people of all ages and abilities.
